POPULATION COUNT OF THE CANBERRA CITY DISTRICT, END JUNE 1973 (PRELIMINARY)

Preliminary results of the recent Population Count of Canberra City District show the population enumerated to be 166,089 persons consisting of 84,933 males and 81,156 females compared with 141,795 persons (72,340 males and 69,455 females) enumerated at the Census, 30 June 1971.

2. Persons having diplomatic immunity (diplomatic and home-based staff of diplomatic missions, and their families) are not included in these statistics. The number of such persons is approximately 1,400.
3. Figures contained in this statement are preliminary and subject to amendment. A statement showing final results including population by suburbs will be issued shortly (Reference No. 4.5).
4. Details of the population recorded in Canberra City District are shown in the following table.
