PRE-SCHOOLS AND CHILD CARE CENTRES, QUEENSLAND, 1985

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Explanatory Notes

This publication includes details of centres providing pre-school and child care services. Child care involves regular full-day care during working hours and also occasional or emergency care. Details of home-based services (family day care schemes) and services specifically set up for the care of children before and after school and during school holidays are excluded.

All centres included are classified into four major categories as follows:
(free)

Category 1. Government

- (a) Department of Education pre-schools
(From January 1985 pre-schools previously administered by the Queensland Department of Community Services, are within jurisdiction of the Director-General of Education.)
- (b) Day care centres controlled by other government departments and instrumentalities
- (c) Day care centres operated by local government authorities

Explanatory Notes (continued)

Category 2. Government assisted

- (d) Crèche and Kindergarten Association branch centres
- (e) Kindertartens affiliated with the Crèche and Kindertartens Association
- (f) Non-profit organisations receiving special grants from the Queensland Department of Education and also centres funded directly by the Office of Child Care within the Commonwealth Department of Community Services

Category 3. Non-profit

- (g) Centres controlled by non-profit organisations which raise money through public donation and/or have free use of community facilities, e.g. church halls

Category 4. Private

- (h) Establishments operating on a profit-making basis

With the exception of some non-profit centres which cater for physically or mentally handicapped children, all centres included in items (c) to (h) above are licensed under the Queensland Department of Children's Services (Day Care Centres) Regulations of 1973.

Enrolments

The reference dates of 14 to 20 July 1985 for children enrolled or attending and 1 July 1985 for age of children, have been chosen to coincide with the schools census. Enrolments are divided into two categories: (a) children enrolled or attending on a regular basis; and (b) children attending on a casual basis, which are defined as follows:

(a) Children Enrolled or Attending on a Regular Basis

Children enrolled to attend regularly in one of the following pre-arranged formal day-groups or sessions, i.e. placements are specifically set aside for those children.

Day-groups

- (i) Five days a week (Monday to Friday)
- (ii) One, two, three, or four specified days a week
- (iii) Five specified days a fortnight, usually 2 days one week and 3 days the following week

Sessions

- (i) 4 hours or less a day (morning or afternoon)
 - (ii) 4 to 6 hours a day (usually 9.30 a.m. to 2.30 p.m.)
 - (iii) Full days of 6 to 8 hours a day
 - (iv) Full days of over 8 hours
- (b) Children Attending on a Casual Basis

Children not formally enrolled to attend regularly the centre in which they were placed during the week 14 to 20 July 1985. Their attendance is of a "casual", "occasional", or "emergency" nature, where, to satisfy regulations, only a few administrative details are recorded. Placements are not specifically set aside for these particular children.

Staff

The number employed during the week ended 20 July 1985. Unpaid or voluntary staff are counted separately.

Staff are shown in the position actually occupied rather than the position for which qualified, e.g. a qualified teacher employed as a teacher aide is shown as a teacher aide.

The following categories have been used for some tables in this publication:

Teaching staff

Qualified: Teachers (directors, supervisors)
Teaching assistants (aides)

Unqualified: Teachers and teaching assistants (engaged in this capacity without formal training)

Other qualified: Child care staff (nurses etc.)

Other unqualified: Child care staff (engaged in this capacity without formal training)
Domestic and other (administrative, clerical, cleaning, gardening)

For Department of Education centres, only teaching staff and domestic and other staff are included. Child care staff are not employed and staff at regional or head office are excluded. For staff teaching both school and pre-school children, pre-school teaching hours only are expressed as full-time equivalents.

Explanatory Notes (continued)

Staff Hours/Full-time Equivalent

Staff details in tables are generally shown as full-time plus full-time equivalent of part-time.

For teaching staff to be classified as full-time they must work at least 25 hours a week. Part-time staff are expressed as a full-time equivalent according to the proportion of 25 hours worked during the census week.

For child care, domestic, and other staff to be classified as full-time they must work at least 35 hours a week. Part-time staff are expressed as a full-time equivalent according to the proportion of 35 hours worked during the census week.

Child Care Centres

Government owned and Creche and Kindergarten Association establishments which are specifically designated as child care centres are included in this category. All other centres which meet one of the following conditions are also included:

- (a) centres operating for over 40 hours a week;
- (b) centres catering mainly for children under 3 years of age; and
- (c) centres catering mainly for children who attend on a casual basis.

The age limit in (b) above was lowered in 1981 from under 4 years of age to under 3 years of age in order to exclude centres providing pre-school/kindergarten facilities only.

Geographical Dissection

The numbers of centres and enrolments in each local authority area are shown in Table 10. For the Brisbane Statistical Division, figures are given for sectors and rings, into which suburbs have been grouped for statistical purposes. A map delineating these areas and a listing of the suburbs within each group are included on pages 22 and 23. Data for individual suburbs in Brisbane City are available, subject to the usual constraints of confidentiality. Similarly details by local authority area of enrolments by category of centre can be obtained on request.

Figures for statistical districts are given at the end of Table 10. To provide comparable statistics over time these districts have been defined around selected urban centres, with a population of 25,000 or more, experiencing urban growth beyond the local authority boundary. The districts are intended to contain the anticipated spread of the urban centre and associated smaller urban centres over the next 20 years.

Summary of Findings

The Queensland Department of Education entered the field of pre-school education in 1973, following an announcement by the Queensland Government that it was planned to introduce pre-school education for all children aged 4 to 5 years whose parents wished it.

At 1 August 1973, there was a total of 532 centres with 29,365 regular enrolments. Centres controlled by government authorities (Department of Education and Department of Community Services) at that time totalled 42 (7.9 per cent) with 1,315 regular enrolments (4.5 per cent). Since then, the Department of Education has taken the dominant role in pre-school education by catering for 29,997 regular enrolments or 44.6 per cent of all children attending pre-schools and child care centres in Queensland at July 1985.

Diagram 1 shows the number of centres by the category of centres. The total number of centres in 1976 was 743, of which 34.5 per cent were government, 34.0 per cent government assisted, 14.8 per cent non-profit, and 16.6 per cent private, while in 1985 there were 1,229 centres, of which 52.8 per cent were government, 31.7 per cent government assisted, 5.7 per cent non-profit, and 9.8 per cent private. The dramatic increase between 1976 and 1977 in the number of government centres continued the trend from 1973 when the Department of Education began establishing a State-wide network of pre-schools. Between 1973 and 1977 the increase in the number of government centres was 328 as opposed to 194 centres between 1977 and 1981, and 85 centres between 1981 and 1985.

Diagram 1 - All Centres: Number by Category of Centre, Queensland, 1976 to 1985

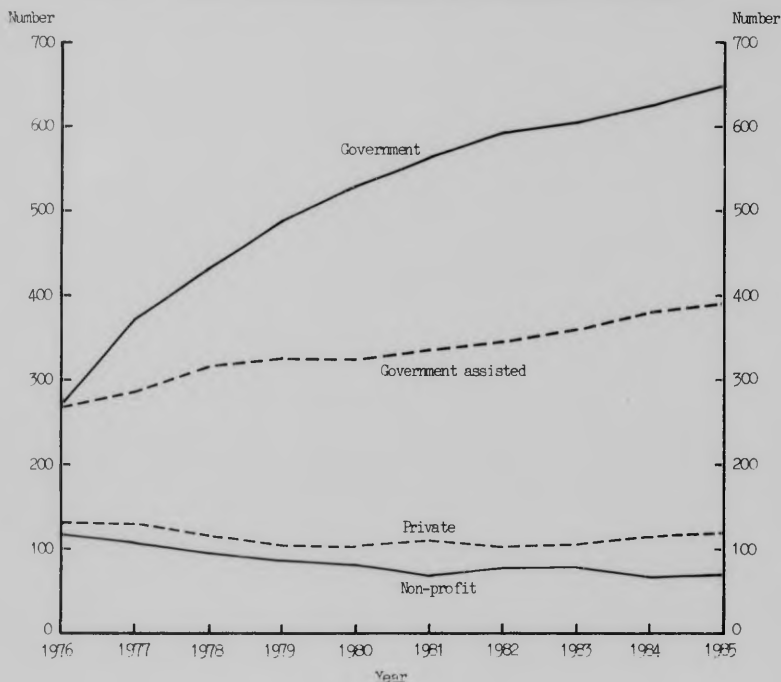


Diagram 2 - All Centres: Regular Enrolments by Category of Centre, Queensland, 1976 to 1985

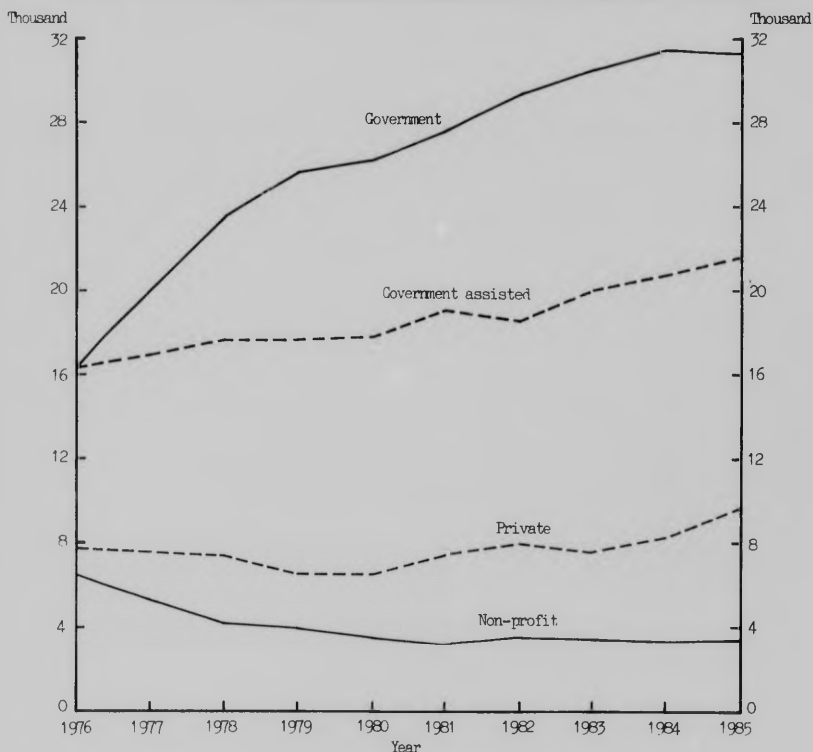


Diagram 2 shows the number of children regularly enrolled or attending each category of centre over the last 10 years. The upward trend in enrolments in the government category is consistent with the increase in the number of centres as illustrated in the previous diagram. In 1976 there were 272 government centres with 16,379 regular enrolments, while in 1985 there were 649 government centres with 31,232 regular enrolments. This represents an increase of 138.6 per cent in the number of centres and 90.7 per cent in the number of regular enrolments. It is also evident in Diagram 2 that enrolments at non-profit centres have decreased (by 47.0 per cent) in line with the fall in the number of centres (40.2 per cent) within this category. Government assisted centres show increases of 32.7 per cent in the number of regular enrolments and 45.5 per cent in the number of centres, while private centres show an increase of 24.7 per cent in the number of regular enrolments and a decrease of 8.4 per cent in the number of centres.

The average number of children attending all centres on a regular basis has decreased only slightly, from 59 in 1976 to 54 in 1985. Government, government assisted, and non-profit centres all show decreases in the average number of children attending while private centres show an increase from 59 in 1976 to 81 in 1985.

The ratio of children to teaching staff at all centres has fallen slightly from 21 in 1976 to 20 in 1985. There has, however, been a dramatic increase in this ratio at private centres from 26 in 1976 to 37 in 1985. However, the ratio of children to total staff at these private centres in 1976 and 1985 was only 13 and 16, respectively. The difference between the ratio of children to teaching staff and children to total staff is due to the relatively large number of child care and other staff employed at these centres.

Diagram 3 - All Centres: Teaching Staff by Category of Centre, Queensland, 1976 to 1985

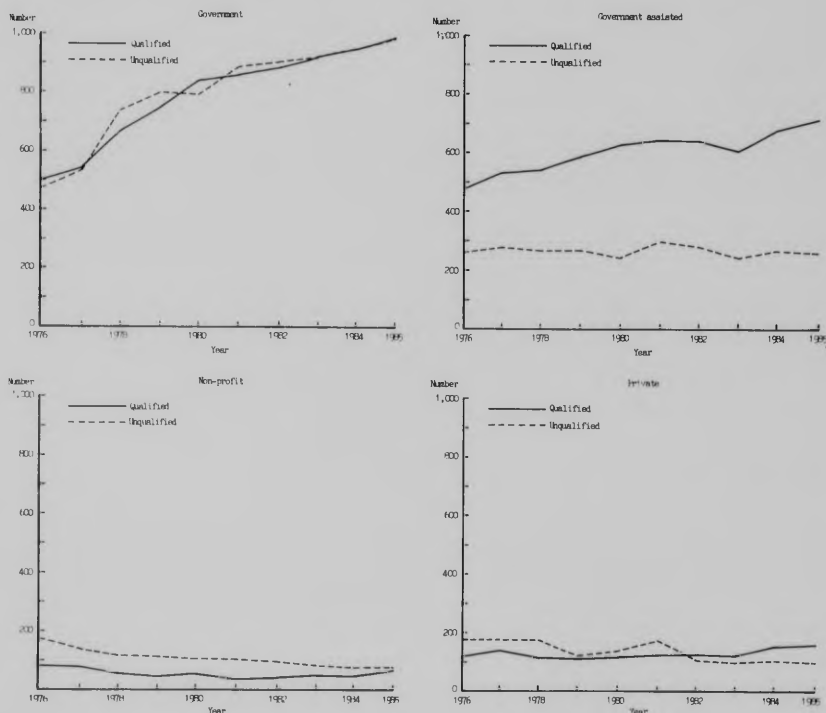


Diagram 3 shows the number of teaching staff (qualified and unqualified), including teachers and teacher aides, within each category of centre. The total number of teaching staff at government centres has increased from 973 in 1976 to 1,974 in 1985. This is consistent with the increase in the number of centres in this category, as illustrated in Diagram 1. The majority of government centres are controlled by the Department of Education and because teacher aides at Department of Education centres are classified as unqualified, the number of qualified teaching staff does not differ significantly from the number of unqualified teaching staff.

Government assisted centres had a total of 712 qualified and 258 unqualified teaching staff in 1985 at a total of 390 centres and non-profit centres had a total of 69 qualified and 79 unqualified teaching staff at a total of 70 centres.

Diagram 4 - All Centres: Regular Enrolments by Age and Sex, Queensland, 1976 to 1985

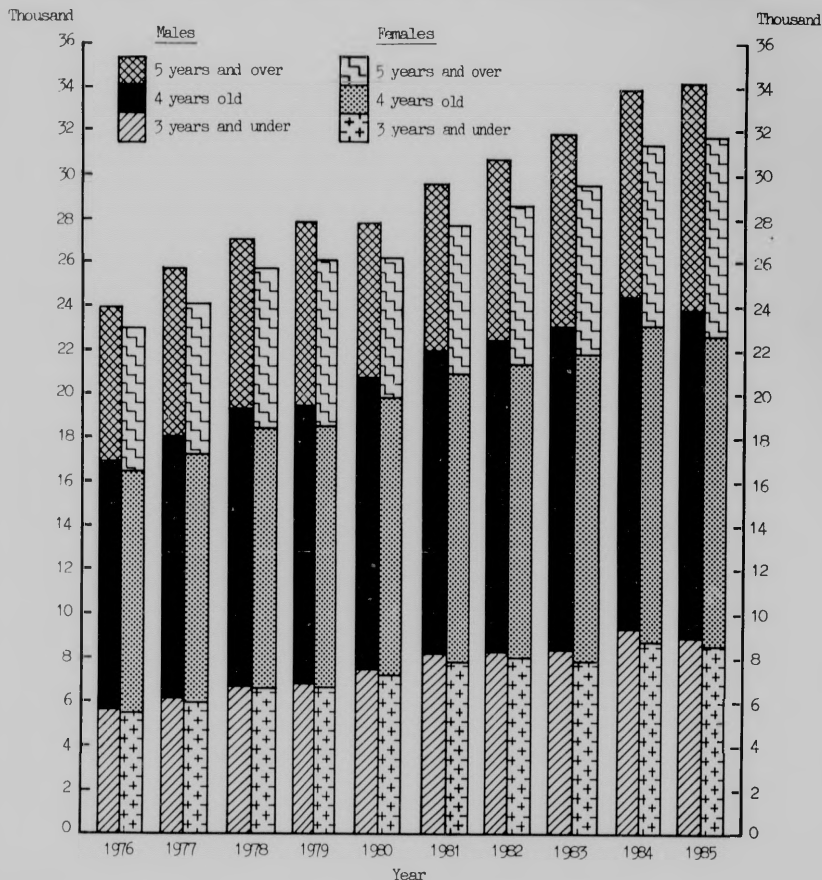


Diagram 4 shows the distribution of children enrolled or attending all centres on a regular basis by age and sex. In 1976, a total of 46,876 children were enrolled or attending on a regular basis, of which 23,909 (51.0 per cent) were male and 22,967 (49.0 per cent) were female. The figures for 1985 show very little movement in the male/female ratio with 65,920 children enrolled or attending on a regular basis, of which 34,149 (51.8 per cent) were male and 31,771 (48.2 per cent) were female. The total number of children enrolled or attending on a regular basis increased 40.6 per cent over the 10 year period. The increase over the same period for males and females was 42.8 per cent and 38.3 per cent, respectively.

Since the Department of Education entered the field of pre-school education in 1973, the total number of children enrolled or attending all centres on a regular basis has increased by 124.5 per cent from 29,365 in 1973 to 65,920 in 1985.
