AUSTRALIAN DEMOGRAPHIC REVIEW - NUMBER 115

BIRTHS, YEAR 1959

This issue of the Review contains a summary of live birth statistics for Australia for the year 1959. Detailed tables will be published later in Demography Bulletin No. 77, 1959. Comparative statistics for years prior to those shown herein will be found in Demography Bulletin No. 76, 1958, and earlier issues. Stillbirths are excluded from tables contained in this Review.

Total Births: (Table 1)

The total number of 226,976 live births, (116,241 males and 110,735 females) registered in Australia during 1959 is the highest yet recorded. This is the eleventh consecutive annual increase registered since 1948.

Crude Birth Rate: (Table 2)

The crude birth rate (number of births per 1,000 of mean population) for 1959 was 22.56, slightly lower than the 1958 rate of 22.59.

Ex-nuptial Births: (Table 3)

Ex-nuptial births registered in 1959 numbered 10,687 and represented 4.71 per cent. of total live births.

Masculinity of Births: (Table 4)

The masculinity of births (the number of male births per 100 female births) for 1959 was 104.97.

Multiple Births: (Tables 5 and 6)

Particulars for multiple births (twins and triplets) are shown in Tables 5 and 6.

Issue, Age Group of Mother and Duration of Marriage: (Tables 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11)

Mothers of nuptial first births (i.e., no previous issue) numbered 66,717 or 31.2 per cent. of total nuptial confinements, second births 57,598 or 26.9 per cent. and third births 41,623 or 19.5 per cent. Of the total of 66,717 nuptial confinements where no previous issue existed, 28,344 or 42.5 per cent. occurred in the first year of marriage, 18,397 or 27.6 per cent. in the second year and 7,785 or 11.7 per cent. in the third year.

Gross and Net Reproduction Rates: (Table 12)

Gross and net reproduction rates (for explanation of terms see Notes to table 12 on page 6) of 1.678 and 1.614 respectively for 1959 show a continuation of the increase recorded in these rates in recent years.

Relative and Average Ages of Parents: (Tables 13 and 14)

The relative ages of parents in respect of confinements resulting in one or more live births are shown in five year age groups in Table 13. The average age of fathers in 1959 was 31.2 years and of married mothers 27.8 years.

Occupation of Father: (Table 15)

The occupations of fathers according to broad groups of occupation are shown in Table 15.

Birthplace of Parents: (Table 16)

Details of the birthplace of parents according to European countries and major Continental groups are shown in Table 16.
