AUSTRALIAN PRODUCTION STATISTICS

MONTHLY BULLETIN NO. 46

SEPTEMBER, 1952.

This Bulletin shows the monthly factory production in Australia of certain commodities. For the purpose of the accompanying statistics a "factory" is taken to be a manufacturing establishment in which four or more persons are employed or in which power other than hand is used. The commodities have been classified, mainly on the basis of value of production, as Major or Minor. Generally, certain annual figures and monthly totals for the latest fifteen months are given for the major items, whilst for those classified as minor, details of the last three months, together with the Monthly Average for the latest complete year are shown. Where significant revisions are made to minor items for recent months other than the three shown, the series affected will be published as for a major item for one issue only.

An index of contents is given on page 2.

Many of the items included here, particularly the major ones, are shown in greater detail in other publications of the Bureau.

The Bulletin is published as near as possible to the beginning of each month and the figures of the production of each of the commodities listed are given up to the latest available month. For each commodity the authority responsible for the present collection is indicated below or alongside the title. The names of these authorities are given in full on page 2. Figures up to 1949-50 inclusive are taken from the Government Statistician's annual factory returns wherever possible. It should be noted that in some cases returns are accepted from factories for periods other than those ending on June 30th each year.

The scope of the bulletin will be widened from time to time to include new information as it becomes available.

Two groups of commodities are reproduced in graphical form, each alternately, in issues of this Bulletin. The groups are as follows:-

- (i) Heat, Light and Power; Building Materials; Chemicals; Metals and Metal Industries.
- (ii) Food; Clothing and Miscellaneous Industries.

Group No. (i) is included in this issue.

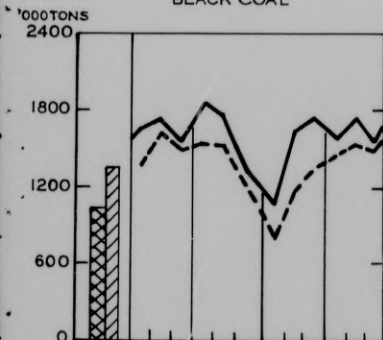
MONTHLY AVERAGE 1938-39



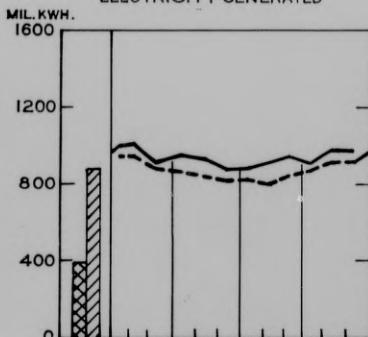

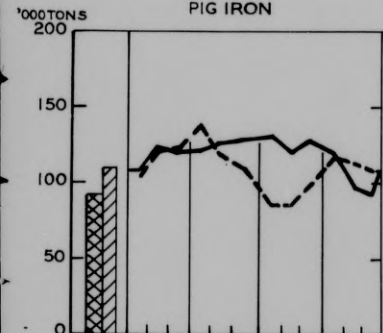

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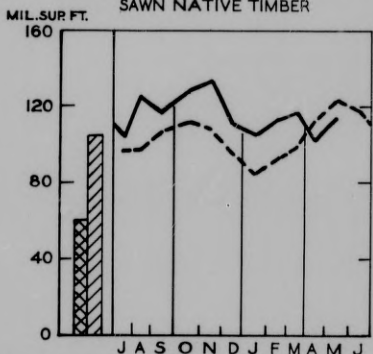

1938-39, 1950-51, 1951-52



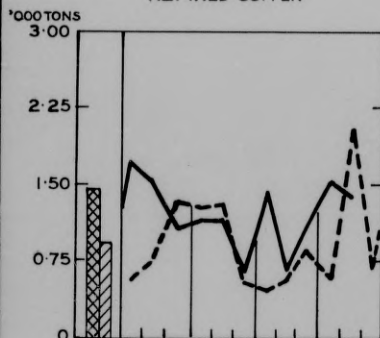
MONTHLY AVERAGE 1938-39



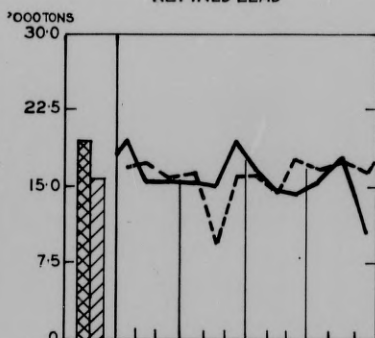

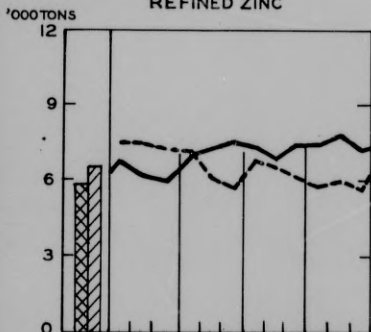
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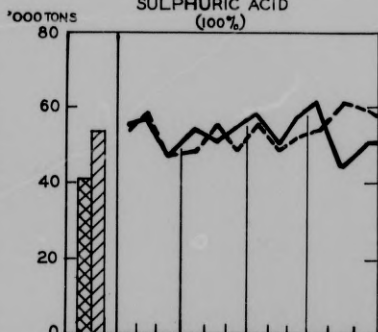
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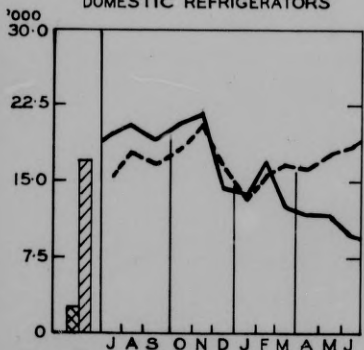
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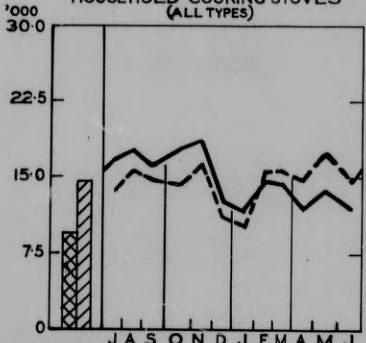
SULPHURIC ACID
