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Explanatory Notes

Introduction

This publication provides a list of sources for a wide range of economic and social statistics currently available from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) for small geographic areas (that is, areas smaller than State level) in Queensland.

Publications

2. Details of publications issued throughout Australia containing small area statistics are shown in the 'Catalogue of Small Area Statistics' (Catalogue No. 1108.0).

3. Current publications produced by the ABS are listed in the 'Catalogue of Publications' (Catalogue No. 1101.0) and those produced by the Queensland Office are listed in 'List of Publications' (Catalogue No. 1101.3). A 'Publications Advice' (Catalogue No. 1105.0) is issued on Tuesdays and Fridays which lists publications to be released in the next few days. These publications are available from any ABS Office.

4. It should be noted that most publications released since 1 January 1988 are priced. Copies of publications may be purchased over the counter from any Office of the ABS. Clients who wish to receive publications on a regular basis may use the ABS Publications Mailing list (PML) service. Some government users and libraries may be entitled to free issues of publications. 7. For practical reasons the ABS does not publish all the statistics and related information it has available.

8. Unpublished statistics are available, on request, for a range of topics in the form of computer printout, microfiche, magnetic tape, specially produced tables and/or electronic media such as AUSSTATS and TELESTATS. Where clerical resources are employed to access data, a charge will apply. Explanatory Notes (continued)

Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC)

9. The ASGC is a system for the classification of statistical units by geographical areas. Common types of statistical units so classified are households in Population Censuses and surveys and establishments (e.g. individual farms, mines, factories and shops) in economic censuses and surveys. Once these units have been classified (i.e. assigned ASGC codes) statistics about them can be compiled and published (subject to normal confidentiality restraints) for ASGC geographical areas. Listed below are the ASGC geographic areas, or 'spatial units', which are included in this catalogue.

10. A more comprehensive description of the classification and of the areas listed below may be found in 'Australian Standard Geographical Classification' (Catalogue No. 1216.0).

11. Census collection districts (CDs) are the smallest types of spatial units in the ASGC and the smallest area blocks of which all other ASGC spatial units are composed. They have been designed for use in Population Censuses and are defined (updated) for each Census. They cover in aggregate, the whole of Queensland without gaps or overlaps.

12. Statistical local areas (SLAs) serve as the smallest spatial units for the publication of economic, social and demographic statistics. They correspond either to legal local government areas (LGAs) or to suburbs in certain urban legal LGAs. Some legal LGAs are split into two or more parts, with each part forming a separate spatial unit. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.

13. Legal local governments areas (LGAs), as defined under the 'Local Government Act 1936-1987', are

spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils, such as cities (C), towns (T) and shires (S).

14. Statistical subdivisions (SSDs) consist of one or more SLAs.

15. Statistical divisions, which consist of one or more SSDs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan and Redcliffe, the Shire of Redland and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture, Moreton and Pine Rivers.

16. Statistical districts have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the legal LGA boundaries.

17. Statistical regions (SRs) consist of one or more SLAs and cover, in aggregate, the whole of Queensland without gaps or overlaps. They were designed primarily as sufficiently large regional type spatial units which are suitable for the presentation of both Population Census and labour force statistics within the frameworks for standard outputs from these collections. The minimum size of such regions, in terms of population, is 147,000.

18. Urban centres/rural localities consist of one or more adjoining whole CDs with urban characteristics and represent, in the case of rural localities, population clusters of between 200 and 999 people and, in the case of urban centres, population clusters of 1,000 or more people (including known holiday resorts of smaller size). Because of their nature they can and, sometimes, do straddle SLA, legal LGA, SSD and

other ASGC geographic area boundaries.

19. Statistical retail areas (SRAs) consist of one or more SLAs within SSDs and cover the whole of Queensland without gaps or overlaps. They

are defined (updated) for each census of retail establishments and used as the smallest type of spatial unit for the publication of retail and certain services industry statistics.
