AUSTRALIAN DEMOGRAPHIC REVIEW NO. 143 : OVERSEA ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES, 1959 TO 1961

INTRODUCTION

1. To provide more specific information relating to overseas travellers than was shown in past publications under the general heading "permanent and long term movement", passenger lists and cards were revised in July, 1958. Results are now available for the three years 1959 to 1961.
2. The form of presentation of the tables in this Review has been changed from that of the former quarterly issues which showed total "permanent and long term movement" classified by nationality, country of last or intended future residence, and occupation (see issue No. 139). However the figures of total "permanent and long term movement" are directly comparable with those published in previous issues. Tables additional to those shown formerly are included in this issue and give particulars of country of birth, country of citizenship for persons of British nationality, and age (in groups) in conjunction with conjugal condition (for "permanent movement" only). Copies of tables Nos. 3 to 5 for the years 1959 and 1960 are available on request.
3. The new information relating to "permanent and long term movement" is based on the purpose of travel STATED by the overseas traveller in response to specific questions on the passenger form or card at the time of arrival in, or departure from, Australia. These statements of purpose of travel represent the traveller's intention at the time. Many travellers subsequently change their intentions and this must be borne in mind in interpreting the statistics and comparing arrivals and departures.
4. ALL THE STATISTICS CONTAINED HEREIN ARE BASED ON THE INFORMATION SUPPLIED BY THE OVERSEA TRAVELLER AT THE TIME OF ARRIVAL OR DEPARTURE.
5. Statistics of short term travellers in greater detail than previously published will be shown in separate issues of the Demographic Review, the first of which will be published shortly.
6. "Permanent and long term movement" relates to persons, other than Australian troops, who state they intend to reside for a period of one year or more - in Australia in the case of arrivals, and abroad in the case of departures. "Short term movement" relates to persons who intend residence for shorter periods, together with Australian troops irrespective of length of intended residence. Air crew and ships' crew are excluded.
7. Settler is a person who on arrival in Australia indicated that he came intending to settle.
8. Former Settlers: The category "Former Settlers" (see column 5 of Table 2) includes only those persons who, on departure from Australia, stated that they had come to Australia intending to settle, and had stayed for a period of twelve months or more. Persons who stated a period of less than twelve months are classified to "visitors departing, short-term movement".
