



COMMERCIAL FINANCE, AUSTRALIA APRIL 1987

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MAIN FEATURES

Commercial Finance commitments made by significant lenders in April 1987 totalled \$7,066.0 million, up \$1,238.6 million (21.3%) on March 1987, but down \$400.7 million (5.4%) on April 1986.

Commitments under fixed loan arrangements totalled \$1,998.0 million in April 1987 up by \$185.3 million (10.2%) on March 1987. Revolving credit commitments increased by \$1,053.3 million (26.2%) on March 1987 to \$5,068.0 million.

There is a new table, Commercial Finance commitments, Australia by type of lender by industry (page 7).

NOTE: Prior to March 1987 Commercial finance commitments under fixed loan facilities for the category 'Trading Banks' were understated due to the inability of some trading banks to report commitments to individuals for business or investment purposes. These commitments are now available and have been included where appropriate in commercial finance commitments from March 1987. The effect of the inclusion of these commitments is not significant.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication presents statistics of commercial finance commitments made by significant lenders to government, private and public enterprises, and non-profit organisations as well as to individuals (for investment and business purposes). Please note that lease finance commitments are excluded (refer *Lease Finance, Australia*, 5644.0). For detailed information on scope and coverage of these statistics and definitions of data items, refer to the July 1986 issue of this publication.

Statistical period

2. While the statistics are described as being for calendar months, it should be noted that:

- (i) in the case of trading banks, the data relate to a month ending on the last Wednesday;
- (ii) in the case of other lenders, some have accounting periods which do not correspond exactly to a calendar month and their figures are used without adjustment.

Unpublished data

3. More detailed classifications of the data in this publication may be made available on request. Generally a charge is made for providing this information. Revisions

4. This publication incorporates revisions made to the previous statistics in the series.

Total credit limits at end of period

5. In principle, total credit limits at the end of period for revolving credit presented in Table 4 are derivable by adding new and increased lending commitments during the period less cancellations and reductions of credit limits during the period to the balance of credit limits at the end of the previous period. In practice, however, revisions and other adjustments such as the transfer of an existing fixed credit facility to a revolving credit facility will mean that such a derivation is inexact.
