EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bulletin presents details of the recorded usage of principal materials used in Australian manufacturing establishments derived from the 1974-75 manufacturing census.

2. The preceding publication in this series contained 1971-72 census data, however some information in respect of the intervening years may be available on request. Materials used data will be next collected in the 1977-78 manufacturing census.

3. As from the 1975-76 census only a limited range of data - employment and wages and salaries - has been collected from single establishment manufacturing enterprises with less than four persons employed. In line with the practice adopted for the main tables in other 1974-75 census publications, data in this bulletin exclude these small enterprises. However, while other 1974-75 census publications contain a link table relating to the small enterprises it is not possible to include such a table in this bulletin. In general the contribution of these small enterprises to the recorded usage at the individual material/industry level is insignificant and in most cases confidential.

4. Information is given for usage in both specified industry classes and "other industry" classes. Subject to the exclusion of small manufacturing enterprises (see paragraph 3 above) the figures for specified industry classes represent the total usage of the selected materials by manufacturing establishments which are classified to those industry classes. The figures for "other industries" relate to industry classes which individually used less than \$80,000 of the material concerned, industry classes for which details are confidential and industry classes for which details are incomplete. As a consequence, the information for "other industries" does not necessarily represent total usage by all the manufacturing establishments outside the industry classes specified.

5. The details are shown under two headings - Recorded Usage, and Purchased or Transferred In.

Recorded Usage

6. The information shown represents the recorded quantities of materials used during the year whether drawn from stocks of previous years or from current supplies. The figures cover materials purchased from other enterprises, materials transferred in from other establishments of the enterprise owning the using establishment and, where applicable, materials supplied by other enterprises for the production on commission of commodities for those enterprises, and materials of own production.

Purchased or Transferred In

7. The information shown represents the quantities and values of materials used during the year (whether drawn from stocks of previous years or from current supplies) which were purchased from other enterprises or were transferred in from other establishments of the enterprise owning the using establishment. Materials supplied by other enterprises for the production on commission of commodities for those enterprises and materials of own production, for which values are not available, are not included.

The values in respect of purchases represent the net landed cost into manufacturing establishments. Transfers in, for statistical purposes, are valued at prices commensurate with the prices that would have been paid if the establishment receiving the materials had been under separate ownership, i.e., at commercial prices.

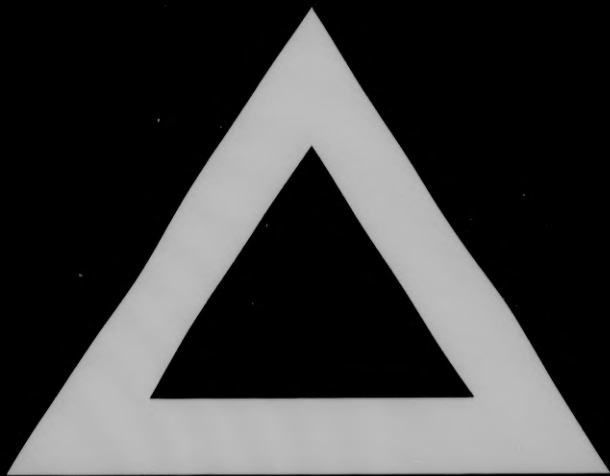
