Dr Lawrence W Green, Director of the Office of Health Information, Health Promotion and Physical Fitness and Sports Medicine in the US Department of Health and Human Resources (formerly Health, Education and Welfare) is responsible for coordinating US Federal Government involvement in health promotion and disease prevention.
