



## SAND, GRAVEL AND QUARRY PRODUCTION, QUEENSLAND, HALF YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 1987

Main Features

A comparison of the final production figures for the years 1985-86 and 1986-87 reveals the following changes:

- Sand - Queensland, 8.1 per cent decrease; Brisbane Statistical Division (B.S.D.), 17.5 per cent decrease.
- Gravel - Queensland, 10.1 per cent decrease; B.S.D., 17.8 per cent decrease.
- Crushed and broken stone - Queensland, 7.2 per cent decrease; B.S.D., 12.1 per cent decrease.
- Non-crushed gravels - Queensland, 6.0 per cent increase; B.S.D., 14.7 per cent increase.

A similar comparison of final figures for the half year ended December 1986 and preliminary figures for the half year ended December 1987 is as follows:

- Sand - Queensland, 1.3 per cent increase; B.S.D., 20.6 per cent increase.
- Gravel - Queensland, 10.6 per cent decrease; B.S.D., 17.5 per cent increase.
- Crushed and broken stone - Queensland, 3.5 per cent decrease; B.S.D., 23.1 per cent decrease.
- Non-crushed gravels - Queensland, 1.4 per cent increase; B.S.D., 35.2 per cent decrease.

Explanatory Notes

This publication contains statistics of sand, gravel and quarry materials produced during the years 1984-85, 1985-86 and 1986-87 and the half years ended 31 December 1986, 30 June 1987 and 31 December 1987.
