EXPLANATORY NOTES

The Bulletin contains statistics of production in Australia of mine and factory products for which monthly figures are available. An alphabetical index of these products is given on page 2.

2. For each product annual totals for the last three complete financial years are shown in conjunction with (a) totals for the most recent six-monthly and three-monthly periods together with similar figures for the same periods, twelve months earlier and (b) monthly totals for each of the latest fourteen months (where available).
3. The annual totals for the years 1963-64 and 1964-65 are mostly derived from the annual factory returns collected by the Deputy Commonwealth Statistician in each State. It should be noted that in some cases, returns are accepted from factories for a year other than the normal financial year ending on 30th June.
4. The monthly figures are also based for the most part on returns collected by the Deputy Commonwealth Statisticians. Where another authority is the source, this is shown in a footnote. Monthly figures from July, 1965 onwards may be revised when the results of the Annual Factory Returns for 1965-66 become available.
5. For the purpose of factory statistics collections, a factory is taken to be a manufacturing establishment in which four or more persons are employed or in which power other than manual is used. Any production in small establishments not classified as factory is not included in the figures shown herein.
6. Further detail in respect of many of the items will be found on an annual basis in the Secondary Industries Bulletin and the Series of Manufacturing Industries Bulletins published by this Bureau and on a monthly basis, in the Monthly Production Summaries, also issued by this Bureau.
7. This bulletin contains data of monthly output of over 300 individual factory products. As monthly particulars of additional items are collected and become available for publication, they will be included in the bulletin. The items for which quantity of output is published herein are not, however, selected as representative of all factory output, and the tables should be read only as showing monthly trends in output of the individual items or groups of items listed.
8. Work is continuing in connection with the development of current monthly or quarterly indexes of factory production.
