## Introduction

The working population may be classified according to two distinct concepts (i) the occupation which is personal to the individual, and (ii) the industry in which the individual carries on his occupation. Thus the occupation of a person is the kind of work that he or she personally performs; while industry is defined as any single branch of productive activity, trade or service.

Census Bulletin No. 29 issued on 16th August, 1963, contained particulars of the industries of the population; this bulletin shows particulars of the occupations of the population of each State and Territory of Australia as at the Census of 30th June, 1961. The figures are subject to revision in the light of further detailed cross-tabulations.

Occupations were not tabulated at the Census of 30th June, 1954 largely because of the difficulties previously experienced in preparing a satisfactory classification of occupations. The classification used for the 1961 Census, follows the principles and structure of the International Standard Classification of Occupations, but has been adapted to fit, as far as practicable, the known occupational structure of the Australian work force.

The figures in this bulletin are derived from the occupational descriptions reported on the Census Schedules classified according to the Australian classification. The major groups and the order in which they appear in the following pages is as follows: -
