EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains the following data for statistical divisions, selected statistical subdivisions, statistical local areas, legal local government areas, and statistical districts in Queensland at 30 June 1986:

- the area at 30 June 1986;
- estimated resident population at 30 June 1981 and 1986; and
- estimated components of population change and average annual growth rates for the period 1 July 1981 to 30 June 1986.

Australian Standard Geographical Classification

2. Statistics on estimated resident population are presented according to the publication 'Australian

Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 3' (Catalogue No. 1216,0) which contains details of the spatial units and coding structure.

3. Legal local government areas (LGAs), as defined under the 'Local Government Act 1936-1987', are spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils, such as cities (C), towns (T), and shires (S).

4. Statistical local areas (SLAs) are the smallest types of spatial units in the ASGC for which population data are presented in this publication. They correspond either to legal local government areas (LGAs) or to suburbs in certain urban legal LGAs. Some legal LGAs are split into two or more parts, with each part forming a separate spatial unit. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In

aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.

5. Statistical subdivisions (SSDs) consist of one or more SLAs.

6. Statistical divisions, which consist of one or more SSDs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan, and Redcliffe, the Shire of Redland, and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture, Moreton, and Pine Rivers.

7. Statistical districts have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the legal LGA boundaries.

Population Estimates

8. The ABS releases Population Census figures on three different bases: the Census count at place of enumeration, the Census count at place of usual residence, and the estimated resident population.

9. The Census count at place of enumeration is based on enumeration of persons at their actual location on Census night.

10. The Census count at place of usual residence is based on the reported usual residence of all persons enumerated on Census night.

11. The estimated resident population (ERP) as contained in this publication, is the official ABS population estimate which is derived by making two further adjustments to the Census count at place of usual residence. The first is an adjustment for Census underenumeration as measured by the Post-enumeration Survey. Adjustments at the SLA level were calculated separately for Brisbane Statistical Division and Balance of State and took into account differences in underenumeration by age, sex, and birthplace (Australian-born/overseas-born). More detailed explanations of this process are available on request. The second adjustment is the addition of Australian residents temporarily overseas at Census date. This second adjustment is made down to SLA level and is obtained by analysis of the

passenger cards which all persons arriving in or departing from Australia must complete. This produces an accurate estimate of the usual resident population of Australia and of each State/Territory and SLA.

Boundary Changes Affecting Population

12. Where the boundary of a statistical area has changed since 1 July 1981, any change in the estimated resident population is reflected in the calculation of components of change and calculation of the average annual growth rate shown in Table 1. An adjusted estimate of the resident population at 30 June 1981 based on the 1986 boundary is shown in Table 4. The average annual growth rate based on this adjusted estimate of resident population is also shown in Table 4.

13. Areas shown are from information supplied by the Queensland Surveyor-General. The conventions followed in the rounding of areas are:

Statistical subdivisions and statistical local areas	- To the nearest square kilometre
Statistical divisions	- To the nearest 10 square kilometres
State total	- To the nearest 1,000 square kilometres

Methodology

14. The 'assumed net migration' figures shown represent the rounded difference between total increase and natural increase. Percentage average annual rates (r) of population growth were calculated using the formula:

$$r = \left[\frac{\frac{P86}{P81} - 1}{0.2} \right] \times 100$$

where P86 and P81 are the estimated resident populations at 30 June 1986 and 30 June 1981, respectively.

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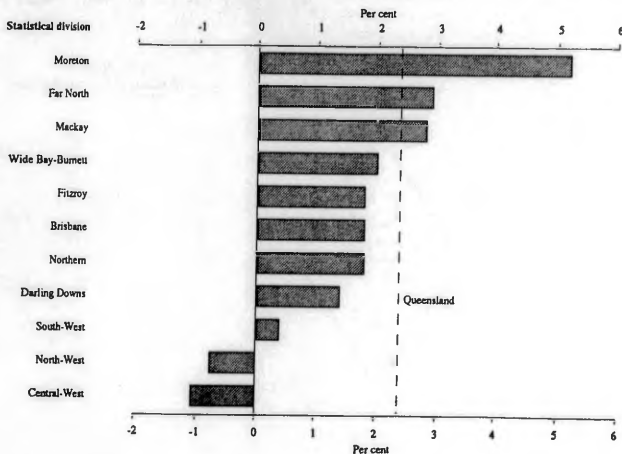
SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

The estimated resident population (ERP) of Queensland at 30 June 1986 was 2,624,600. The total increase of 279,400 since 30 June 1981 represents an average annual growth rate of 2.3 per cent.

Statistical Divisions

Average annual growth rates for Statistical Divisions for the period 30 June 1981 to 30 June 1986 are shown in Diagram 1.

The highest average annual growth of 5.2 per cent occurred in Moreton Statistical Division, which had an overall intercensal population rise of 89,350. The only other Statistical Divisions which experienced average annual growth rates above the Queensland rate were Far North (2.9 per cent) and Mackay (2.8 per cent). Both Central-West and North-West Statistical Divisions experienced negative average annual growth rates of -1.1 per cent and -0.8 per cent, respectively.

Statistical Districts

The Gold Coast Statistical District experienced the greatest percentage average annual growth between the two Census dates of 5.1 per cent, resulting in a total population increase of 46,320. The next highest average annual growth of 4.5 per cent occurred in the Sunshine Coast Statistical District.

Local Government and Statistical Local Areas

The highest average annual growth occurred in the local government areas of Nebo Shire (21.8 per cent), Albert Shire (11.1 per cent), Thuringowa City (10.9 per cent), and Peak Downs Shire (10.6 per cent).

Statistical local areas which experienced growth rates in excess of 10 per cent a year include Albert Shire Pt A (12.9 per cent), Fitzroy Shire Pt A (11.5 per cent), Thuringowa City Pt A (11.4 per cent), Moreton Shire Pt A (10.9 per cent), and Albert Shire Pt B (10.9 per cent).

NOTE: All the above growth rates are based on 1986 boundaries. (See paragraph 12 of the Explanatory Notes.)

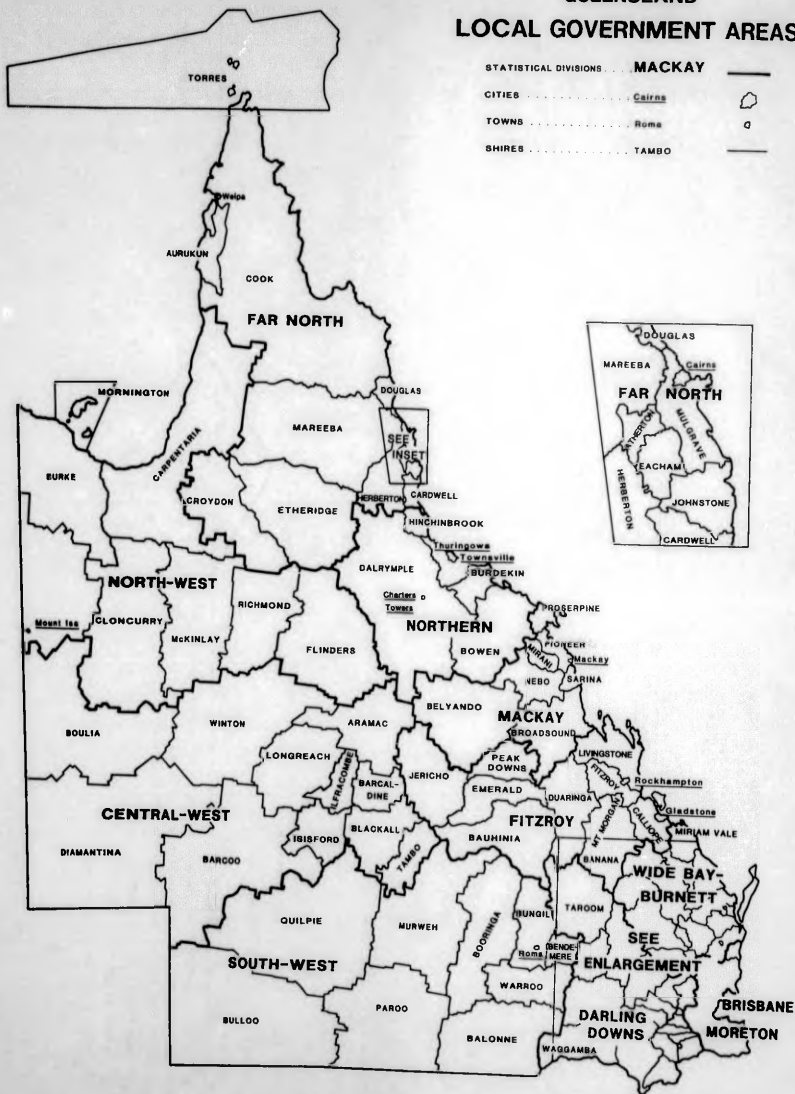

QUEENSLAND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS



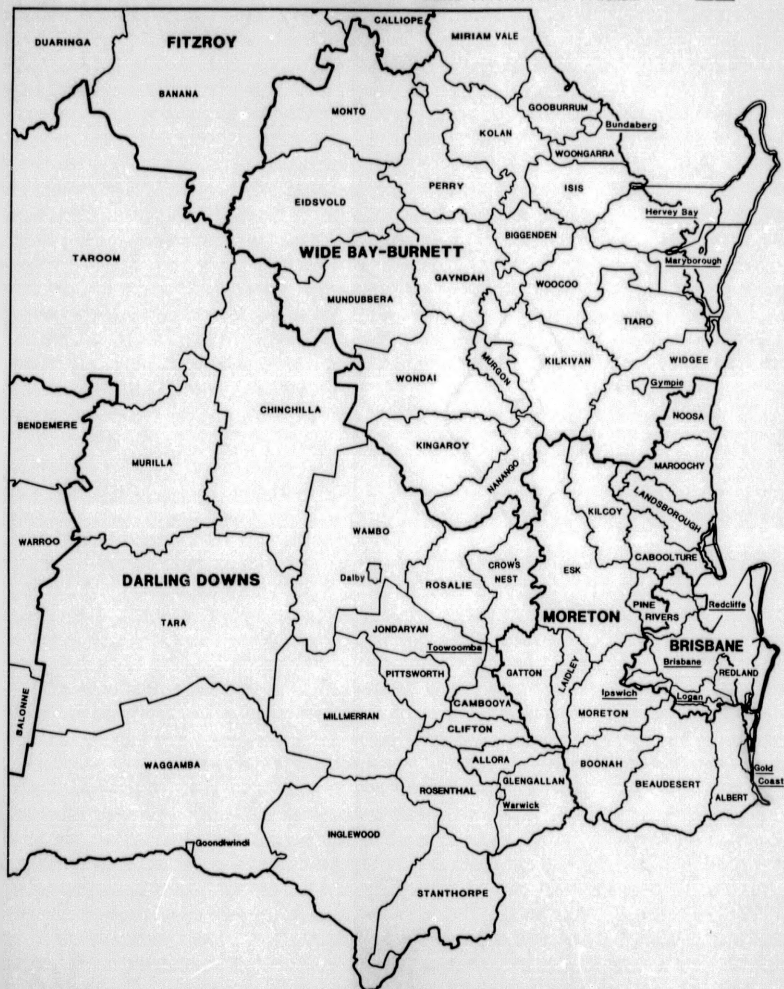
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
