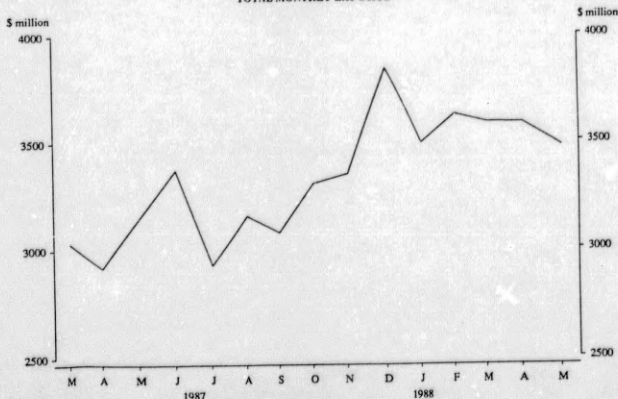
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CHANGE IN CLASSIFICATION: The international implementation of the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HCDCS) on 1 January 1988 and the introduction of a third revision of the Standard International Trade Classification from the same date have resulted in changes to the collection, presentation and interpretation of Australia's foreign trade statistics. Details regarding these changes are outlined in paragraphs 2 to 6 of the Explanatory Notes. Users should be aware of these changes when comparing data in this issue with those relating to periods prior to January 1988. To assist users in analysing movements in exports, commodity statistics presented in the Main Features and graphs are based on the classification used prior to January 1988.

MAIN FEATURES

TOTAL MONTHLY EXPORTS



Exports for May 1988 fell by \$111m to \$3,478m, a decrease of 3% compared with April 1988.

The major contributors to this decrease were metalliferous ores, down \$79m (17%) to \$394m; coal, down \$55m (15%) to \$323m and textile fibres, down \$54m (11%) to \$444m. Increases were recorded in cereals, up \$56m (44%) to \$183m and miscellaneous trade up \$35m (10%) to \$392m.

The principal markets for major export commodities for May 1988 were, for wool, (\$428m); Japan (21%), Italy (12%) and USSR (12%); for coal (\$317m); Japan (50%), Taiwan (7%) and the Republic of Korea (7%); for gold (\$256m); Japan (45%), Hong Kong (35%) and Singapore (12%) and for meat of bovine animals (\$185m); USA (57%), Japan (21%) and Canada (9%).

Exports for the eleven months ended May 1988 compared with the same period for the previous year rose by \$5,036m to \$37,445m, an increase of 16%. Increases were recorded in textile fibres, up \$1,698m (49%) to \$5,177m; miscellaneous trade (mainly non-monetary gold), up \$1,020m (48%) to \$3,139m; manufactures of metal, up \$803m (28%) to \$3,653m; metalliferous ores, up \$350m (8%) to \$4,748m and petroleum and petroleum products, up \$338m (23%) to \$1,838m.

DISTRIBUTION OF EXPORTS BY MAJOR COMMODITIES

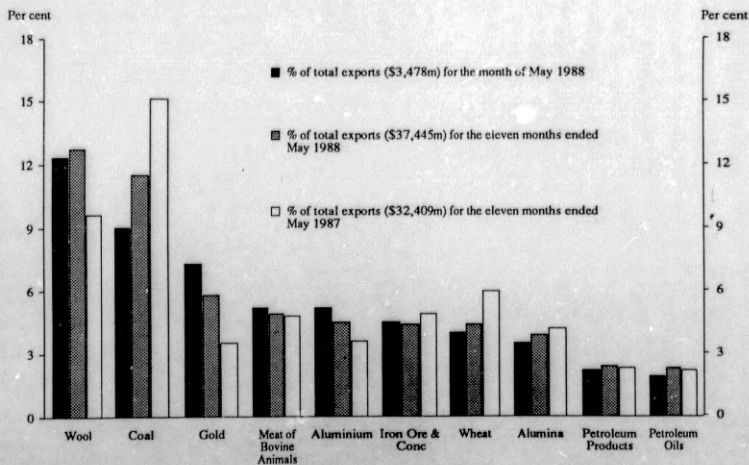

VALUE OF EXPORTS BY MAJOR SECTIONS OF THE AECC

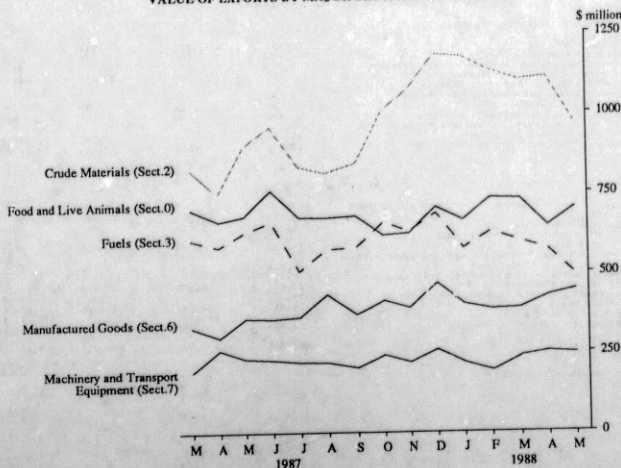

EXPLANATORY NOTES

A brief outline of the major definitions used in compiling the statistics in this publication is contained in the following explanatory notes and in table footnotes. For a more detailed description refer to the information paper 'Foreign Trade Statistics: An Overview (5481.0)'.

2. Export statistics contained in monthly, quarterly and annual publications for periods up to and including December 1987 were presented according to the codes and descriptions of the Australian Export Commodity Classification (AECC). This classification was based on the second revision of the United Nations Standard International Trade Classification (SITC Rev2) with some modifications to take account of Australia's trade.

3. From January 1988 export statistics in this publication are presented according to a new international version of SITC (ie SITC Rev3). SITC Rev3 has been developed by the U.N. to coincide with the introduction of a new international classification for describing goods for customs and other purposes, the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (the Harmonized System). The Harmonized System was adopted in January 1988 by most of the major trading nations of the world.

4. The third revision of SITC incorporates significant changes to the numbering system and overall structure to align it more closely with the Harmonized System. The changes between the second and third revision of SITC, and the adoption by the ABS of the complete international version of the classification, have resulted in a break in the statistical series published by the ABS.

5. To overcome that break in series and to assist users in the interpretation of the data, export commodity statistics for the period January to June 1988 are being shown in two separate series:

- the first shows exports data from January 1988 on a SITC Rev3 basis, see Tables 2A and 4A. Data on this basis for previous periods are not available; and

- the second shows exports data according to the SITC Rev2-based AECC, see Tables 2B and 4B. This series, produced by recompiling data from SITC Rev3 back to the codes of the AECC, will be maintained up to and including June 1988. From July 1988, this publication will show exports data only according to the codes and descriptors of SITC Rev3.

6. Users should be aware that the changes from AECC to SITC Rev3 are extensive and for many items prevent direct comparison. Accordingly, caution should be exercised in using the recompiled AECC data from January 1988 onwards and particular attention should be given to table footnotes. More information about the links between SITC Rev3 and AECC items may be obtained from the booklet 'Linkages Between SITC Rev3 and AECC/AICC Items Used in ABS Foreign Trade Output', available from the ABS.

7. The value of exports is the free on board (FOB) value of the goods expressed in Australian dollars.

8. In accordance with United Nations recommendations, total exports excludes transactions of non-merchandise trade. The monthly value of non-merchandise trade is shown in Table 1. Further information is available on microfiche MX07.

9. Exports are recorded statistically in the month the entries are lodged with the Australian Customs Service. Regular exporters or their agents may provide details of their export shipments on a periodic rather than an individual shipment basis by submitting weekly or monthly returns. These 'periodic returns' must be submitted to the Australian Customs Service within seven days of the end of the period in question covering all shipments during that period. All other exporters are required to report each individual shipment prior to the ship's departure. Approximately 90 per cent of monthly export values are recorded on periodic returns. The statistical month for Customs outports (usually ports other than those at which the main Customs office in each state is located) closes on the 21st of each month, whereas for mainports the statistical month is the calendar month.

10. Because of the way in which exports data are collected and processed approximately 40% of total export trade by value shown for a particular month reflects actual shipments in that month, while approximately 55% reflects actual shipments during the previous month with the remaining 5% by value being exported in earlier months. For individual commodities these percentages may vary considerably.

11. Restrictions are placed on the release of statistics for certain commodities for reasons of confidentiality. These restrictions do not affect total export figures, but they can affect statistics at all levels in country and commodity tables. Refer to table footnotes and the Appendix for specific details. The information paper Confidentiality and the Release of Foreign Trade and Shipping Statistics (5486.0) describes fully the confidentiality process.

12. Revisions to previously published data frequently occur due to continuing quality checks and statistics in this publication should be considered preliminary.

13. Country statistics shown in Tables 3 and 9 refer to the country to which the goods were consigned at the time of export.

14. Export statistics are also available on microfiche, special returns, and magnetic tape. A comprehensive series of information papers describe these services. For more information, please contact any ABS office.

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Appendix : Confidential Commodity Listing

Restrictions are placed on the release of statistics for certain commodities for reasons of confidentiality. Prior to the introduction of the Harmonized System on 1 January 1988, (see Explanatory Notes, paragraphs 1-6) confidentiality restrictions were applied at the item level of the Australian Export Commodity Classification (ARCC). Details of the commodities affected by those restrictions are contained in previous issues of this publication.

From 1 January 1988, restrictions have been applied at the item level of the Australian Harmonized Export Commodity Classification (AHCEC). The AHCEC items affected by the restrictions, together with the code of the SITC Rev3 item affected, the type of restriction and the period for which it applied are listed below. Confidentiality restrictions applying in 1987 were reviewed prior to January 1988, converted from the ARCC codes to the AHCEC codes and shown as having started in January 1988.

In Tables 2A, 4A and 5, commodities subject to a 'No Commodity Details' restriction are EXCLUDED from the relevant Sections and Divisions. In Table 4A they are INCLUDED in Division 98 and in Tables 2A and 5 they are INCLUDED in the total.
