PREFACE

This Bulletin is one of a series for each State (Nos. 1-6) and for Australia (including the Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory) as a whole (No. 7) presenting details of tabulations showing classifications of all rural holdings by size of principal characteristics (viz. area of holdings, area of sown grasses and clovers and selected crops and numbers of main livestock) and by type of activity for the year 1955-60.

The tabulations included in these Bulletins have been prepared from information taken from the Agricultural, Pastoral and Dairying Census for the 1955-60 season (conducted on 31st March, 1960). Crop areas and land use data relate to the 1955-60 season, while numbers of livestock are as at 31st March, 1960.

Tabulations of this type (confined to classifications of holdings by size of principal characteristics) have, in the past, been undertaken at irregular intervals. Since the 1935-45 War, they have been prepared on a substantially uniform basis in all States for each of the years 1947-48, 1949-50, 1951-52 and 1953-54. The tabulations relating to size classification of holdings in this series of Bulletins are similar to, but less extensive than, those prepared in 1955-56; however, many of the tabulations on this occasion have been prepared on a Statistical Division basis for all States, whereas in 1955-56 only one or two key tables for some States were published by Statistical Divisions.

The 1955-60 tabulations classifying rural holdings according to type of activity in these Bulletins constitute the first detailed and systematic classifications of holdings in this manner undertaken uniformly throughout Australia. Previously some attempts to classify holdings along these lines had been made in some individual States, although, since the War, the only occasion was the very detailed classification undertaken in New South Wales for 1955-56. This was largely experimental and was the forerunner of the current classification.

Rural Holdings. - Although there are minor variations between States, a "rural holding" is defined briefly for the purposes of these statistics as a piece of land of large or more or less extent used for the production of agricultural products or for the raising of livestock and the production of livestock products. In cases where land owners or occupiers possess or work more than one holding, separate returns are required for each, except where the holdings are in close proximity and are worked as one, in which case one return only may be submitted covering the two or more holdings concerned. In some States separate returns are obtained for holdings wholly or partly share-farmed.

Land Utilization. - Because of definitional differences, statistics relating to land utilization in these Bulletins are not comparable in certain respects with those appearing in other publications. In this series of Bulletins, the following definitions apply.

- Area used for Fruit.** - This relates to the total bearing and non-bearing areas of orchards, plantations, vine and small fruits and edible nuts and olives.
- Area used for Crops (excluding Fruit).** - This relates, in general, to all crops other than fruit crops as listed in Table No. 5 of the publication "Primary Industries, - Part I, - Rural Industries, 1950-60". Except in Victoria, it excludes, however, areas of grasses and clovers cut for seed and hay (vii). For South Australia, Lucerne for grazing is excluded from crops (see also (ix)).
- Area lying Fallow.** - This relates only to land lying fallow during the whole or the greater part of the season. It excludes land under short or summer fallow.
- Area under Sown Grasses and Clovers.** - This relates to the area of sown grasses (including lucerne, popalium, ryegrasses, lupins, phalaris, shade, and, etc.) and clovers (subterranean and other types) whether grazed, cut for hay or silage or harvested for seed. Popalium is however, excluded for New South Wales only. Lucerne for grazing is included for South Australia.
- Balance of Holding.** - This is a balance item, and represents the area of land used for grazing, (other than sown grasses and clovers and crops fed off) the area occupied by buildings, etc. and the area of forested, non-wooded, etc. land not used for farming purposes.

In the case of Victoria, the areas shown in each of the above categories in these Bulletins are based on preliminary data which have been subject to some minor amendment since these tabulations were undertaken.

Livestock. - In the tabulations relating to livestock, the total number of sheep, beef cattle, dairy cattle or pigs belonging to or run on each holding is regarded as a flock or herd. For New South Wales the data shown for dairy cattle herds are, however, confined to those belonging to registered dairies and exclude small herds on other holdings.

Type of Activity. - The classifications used and the methods employed are described below.

- The Classification.** - Commercial holdings have been classified into the following types: -

Sheep - Cereal Grazing	Poultry
Sheep	Pigs
Cattle - Cereal	Sugar
Beef Cattle	Tobacco
Dairying	Other (One Main Purpose)
Vineyards	Multi-purpose
Fruit (Other than Vine)

In addition to "commercial" holdings, the annual census includes holdings in the following two categories which have not been classified by type of activity but are shown separately in the tabulations, viz.:-

Sub-Commercial: - Holdings operated on a part-time or small-scale basis (see below)

Unused, Special, etc.: - Holdings not used or used for intermittent grazing during the season, and holdings attached to prisons, hospitals, etc.

(iii) **Method Used:** - Holdings have been classified by type according to the principal activity on each holding. Because of the many holdings on which more than one type of activity occurs, it was necessary to adopt some objective measure of the relative importance of each activity and then to apply common-sense criteria in determining the principal activity.

Under Australian circumstances, it was decided that the most appropriate measure of the importance of each type of activity on a holding was gross cash receipts at the farm (i.e. after deducting marketing costs). Gross receipts were estimated by taking the area of crops and agribots of livestock reported on the annual census returns for 1950-51 and multiplying them by estimated values per bush or per livestock unit for each crop and type of livestock reported. To remove the effects of seasonal irregularities in 1950-51 in both yields and prices, the derived values were based (in the main) on the averages for the five years ended 1957-58. The principal exception to this rule was in estimating returns from sheep, for which wool prices for the single year 1957-58 were used, because it was considered that the level of prices for earlier years was too high in relation to the changed circumstances of the sheep industry. Generally, the values used were based on averages of both yield and price for each State (as a whole), but in some States important regional variations within the State were taken into account for some products.

Attention is drawn to the following particular cases where the general rules for classification outlined above have not been followed:-

In estimating gross receipts, *lotto crops* were ignored as being incidental to livestock production, except where they were obviously grown as main cash crops.

In the dairying industry, the main dairy holding is frequently operated in conjunction with a "dry run". In some cases these "dry runs" are not adjacent to the dairy holding and although the two holdings may be operated as a single enterprise, separate Agricultural, Dairying and Piggeries Returns may be lodged. If it had been possible, the correct procedure for two-type classification of "dry runs" would have been to combine their returns with those for the main dairy. For various reasons however this was not possible and "dry runs" were classified according to other activity, if any, on the "dry run". As a result in the tables showing classifications according to type of holding and size of dairy herds, some holdings with quite appreciable dairy herds (at 31st March, 1960) appear as "Unused, Special etc." (which included intermittent grazing) or as "Sub-commercial".

In States other than Queensland, if there were no sheep on a holding at 31st March, but details were shown on the return for sheep shown during the year, gross receipts from sheep were estimated on the basis of this information. This has had the effect of classifying as "Sheep" or "Sheep-Cereal Grain" in those States certain holdings with no sheep at 31st March (see Table 25). Information on sheep shown is not collected on the annual census form in Queensland and this procedure could not be followed in that State.

Holdings for which the total gross receipts for all products of the holding calculated as above amounted to less than £500 were treated as "sub-commercial". The criteria used in classifying the remaining ("commercial") holdings to type of activity were briefly as follows:-

- (a) Holdings running sheep and growing cereals for grain were classified as Sheep-Cereal Grain if the combined receipts from these activities amounted for 75 per cent. or more of the total receipts of the holding and provided receipts from sheep were no more than five times and not less than one-quarter of receipts from cereals for grain.
- (b) Holdings running dairy cattle and pigs were classified as Dairying if the combined receipts of these activities was more than half of total receipts of the holding.
- (c) Other holdings were classified to the activity (if any) which accounted for more than half of total receipts of the holdings.
- (d) If none of the criteria under (a), (b) or (c) was satisfied, the holding was classified as Multi-purpose.
