Western Samoa - SDR per Tala

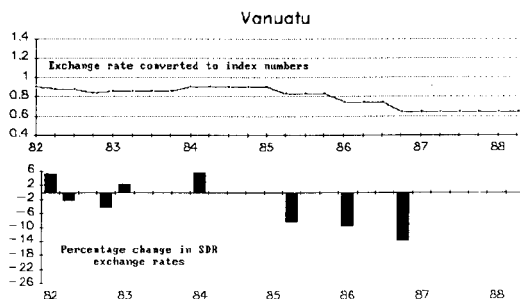

Vanuatu - SDR per Vatu

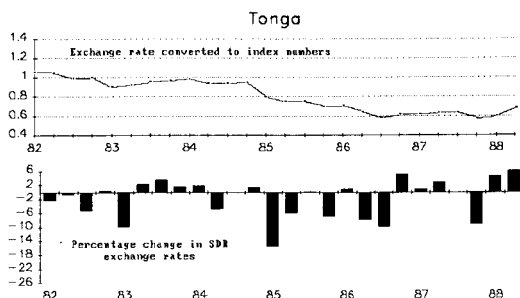

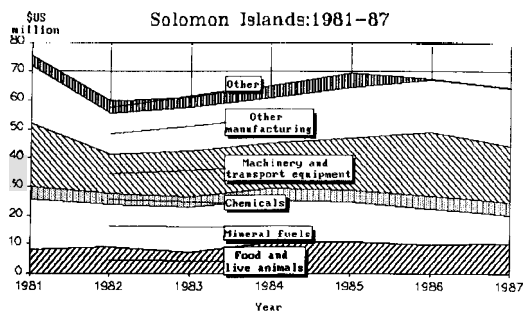
Papua New Guinea: 1981-86



Fiji: 1981-87



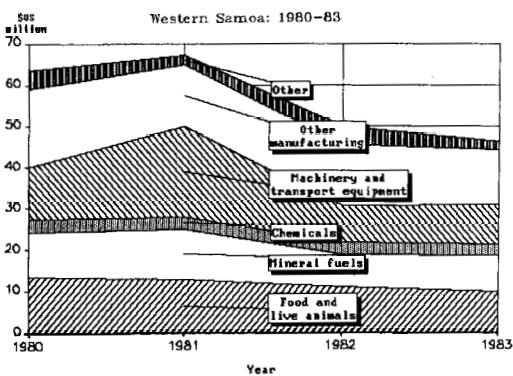
