



SURVEY OF WEEKLY EARNINGS AND HOURS, OCTOBER 1972

(Preliminary results)

Reference No. 6.28

This bulletin contains preliminary results of the survey of weekly earnings and hours conducted for the last pay-period in October 1972, together with results of earlier surveys for comparison. Preliminary estimates for October 1972 have been prepared for the major classifications on the basis of figures reported by 94 per cent of survey respondents. These preliminary figures for 1972 may differ from final figures which will be published in greater detail when the survey has been completed.

2. The figures in this bulletin are based on a stratified random sample of private employers subject to pay-roll tax (i.e. those paying more than \$400 a week in wages and salaries). Excluded from these results are employees of government and semi-government authorities; employees of religious, benevolent and other similar organisations exempt from pay-roll tax; employees in rural industry and in private domestic service; employees in the Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory; and waterside workers in casual employment.
3. The following definitions refer to terms used in the survey and in the tables of this bulletin.
4. Full-time employees are those employees who ordinarily work 30 hours or more a week and who received pay for the last pay-period in October. Part-time employees are those who ordinarily work less than 30 hours a week.
5. Adult employees include employees under 21 years of age paid at the adult rate for their occupation. Junior employees are all other employees under 21 years of age.
6. Other than managerial, etc. staff includes minor supervisory employees, leading hands, clerical and office staff as well as ordinary wages employees. It excludes managerial, executive, professional and higher supervisory staff who were not further defined.
7. Weekly earnings refers to gross earnings before taxation and other deductions have been made, for the last pay-period in October. It includes overtime earnings, ordinary time earnings, shift allowances, penalty rates, commission and similar payments, and paid leave taken during the pay-period. Retrospective payments are excluded. Overtime earnings refers to that part of gross weekly earnings for hours paid for in excess of award, standard or agreed hours of work. Ordinary time earnings refers to that part of gross weekly earnings for award, standard or agreed hours of work.
8. Weekly man-hours paid for refers to the sum of man-hours for which payment was made. It includes overtime hours, ordinary time hours, paid stand-by or reporting time and paid leave taken in the pay-period. For employees absent for part of the pay-period only man-hours actually paid for are included. Overtime hours refers to hours in excess of award, standard or agreed hours of work. Ordinary time hours refers to award, standard or agreed hours of work.

10. The estimated average weekly earnings in the tables below are rounded to the nearest 10 cents, and those of average weekly hours paid for to the first decimal place. Any discrepancies between totals and sums of components in tables are due to rounding.
