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ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS INVOLVING FATALITIES JUNE 1977

This statement contains preliminary monthly details of the number of road fatalities and fatal road accidents that occurred in each State and Territory during the month of June 1977, together with comparable figures for some earlier periods. These details have been supplied by the police authorities. Figures for June 1977, and possibly for earlier months, may be revised in future issues of this statement as additional information is received, including advices for persons not previously reported as fatalities but who die within 30 days of the date of the accident from injuries received.

2. Table 1 includes seasonally adjusted figures for road accident fatalities in Australia. In the seasonal adjustment, account has been taken of normal seasonal factors, intra-month variations (arising from the number of Sundays, Mondays, Tuesdays, etc., in the month) and the influence of Easter and Australia Day which may in successive years, affect figures for different months. Because of the irregular nature of the data, caution should be exercised in interpreting month to month movements. Details of the methods used in seasonally adjusting this and other series are given in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators, 1976* (Reference No. 1.10).
