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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains annual statistics on deaths for Victoria, supplementing those published in the national publication *Deaths, Australia* (3302.0). Similar publications are produced by most States.

2. In this publication, except for Table 5, death statistics for years 1980 to 1985 are presented on the basis of the State or Territory of usual residence of the deceased, regardless of where in Australia the death occurred or was registered.

3. Deaths of deceased persons usually resident in Australia which took place overseas are excluded. Deaths of deceased persons usually resident overseas which occurred in Australia are included in the State or Territory where the death occurred.

4. With the exception of Table 5, the statistics in this publication refer to deaths registered during the calendar year shown. There is usually an interval between the occurrence and registration of a death and, as a result of a delay in registration, some deaths occurring in one year are not registered until the following year or even later. However, 99 per cent of all deaths are usually registered within 6 months of occurrence.

5. The Expectation of Life and Life tables included in the 1984 *Deaths, Victoria* are not included in this issue due to the unavailability of the information at time of release. The information will be available upon request in early 1987.

6. Figures in this publication do not include fetal deaths. Statistics on fetal deaths are given in Table 1 of *Births, Victoria* (3305.2). Statistics on fetal deaths are also given in *Births, Australia* (3301.0) and *Perinatal Deaths, Australia* (3304.0).

Definitions

7. The *crude death rate* is the number of deaths registered per 1,000 of the mean estimated resident population.

The *age specific death rate* is the number of deaths at a specified age per 1,000 of the estimated resident population of that age as at 30 June. This rate is not used for deaths of children under one year of age. Instead, the *infant death rate* (deaths of children under one year of age per 1,000 live births) is used as a more appropriate measure.

The *masculinity ratio* is the number of male deaths per 100 female deaths.

Causes of death

8. From 1 January 1979, deaths have been classified according to the Ninth Revision of the World Health Organisation's *International Classification of Diseases, Injuries and Causes of Death*.

Local government areas

9. Victoria has been divided into 12 statistical divisions since 1974. This involves the splitting of three local government areas, namely the shires of Cranbourne, Healesville, and Pakenham which are partly in the East Central Statistical Division and partly in the Melbourne Statistical Division.

The unincorporated areas of Lady Julia Percy/Tower Hill Reserve and Victorian Bass Strait Islands are not included in this collection.

The designation of City (C), Town (T), Borough (B), or Shire (S) shown against the name of each local government area indicates its status at 30 June 1985.

Estimated resident population

10. The estimated resident population is the official population series and is compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. The estimated resident population figures provided in Table 9 are preliminary for the period ending 30 June 1985. A description of the conceptual basis of population estimates is contained in the *Information Paper: Population Estimates: An Outline of the New Conceptual Basis of ABS Population Estimates* (3216.0) and *Information Paper: Local Government Area Population Estimates, Victoria* (3205.2).

Additional statistics available

11. In some cases, the ABS can also make available information which is not published. This information may be made available in one or more of the following forms: microfiche, photocopy, data tape, computer printout, manually-extracted tabulation. Generally a charge is made for providing unpublished information. A list of tables that are produced annually is attached in Appendix A.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

Total deaths and crude death rates

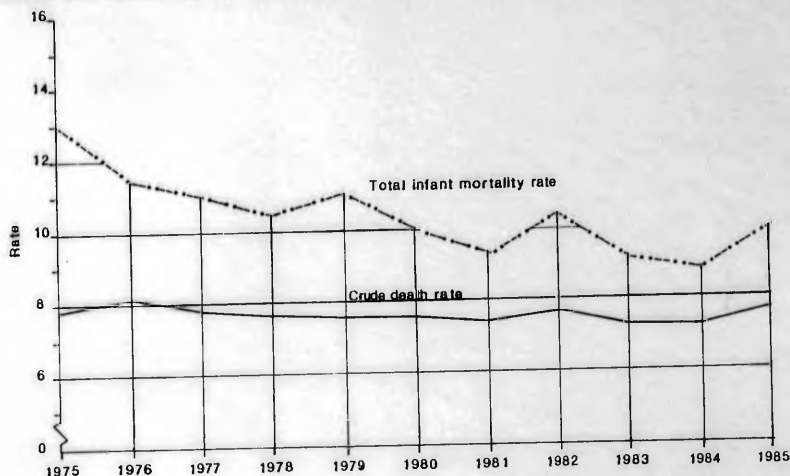
In 1985, there were 31,353 deaths of Victorian residents registered in Australia. This represents a significant increase of 6.2 per cent over the 29,532 deaths recorded in 1984.

The crude death rate increased from 7.2 in 1984 to 7.6 in 1985. By way of comparison, the crude death rate in 1980 was 7.5 and in 1975 it was 7.8.

While the crude death rate is consistently higher for males than for females (8.0 and 7.1, respectively, in 1985), the masculinity ratio has declined over the last five years from 120.8 in 1980 to 111.3 in 1985.

Age specific death rates

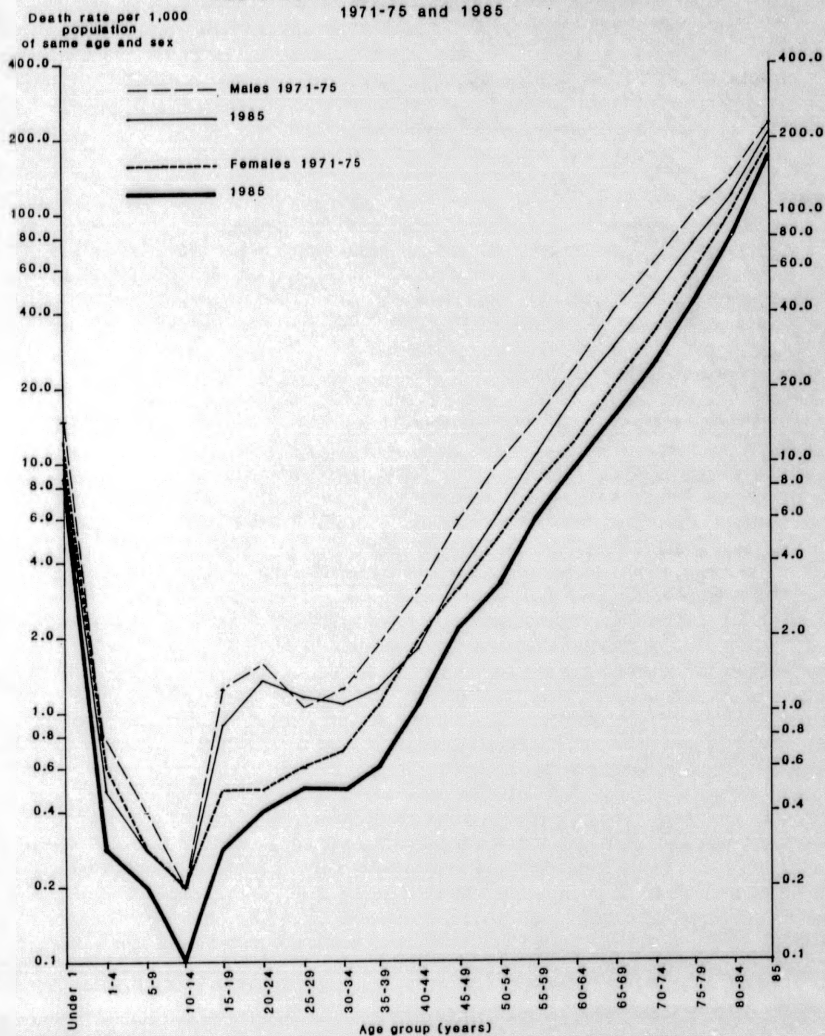
The consistently lower death rates for females than for males is reflected in all the groupings of the age specific death rates.

The difference in the death rates between the sexes is particularly evident in the 15 to 24 year age groups and significant in the age groups of 45 years and over. For the 15 to 24 year age groups the incidence of motor vehicle accidents and suicides (the highest causes of death in these age groups) was approximately three and one-half times greater for males than females, while for the 45 to 60 year age groups the incidence of ischaemic heart disease was five and one-half times greater for males.

For the age group under one year 10.7 deaths per 1,000 male births and 8.8 deaths per 1,000 female births were recorded for 1985, compared with 15.8 and 12.8, respectively, as the average annual infant mortality rate for the period 1971 to 1975.

The age specific death rate falls markedly to 0.2 for males and 0.1 for females in the age group 10 to 14 years. From that level, the rate increases gradually at first, then more rapidly with increasing age, and it is not until age group 55-59 years for males and age group 60-64 years for females that the rates have surpassed those for the age group under one year.

1971-75 and 1985

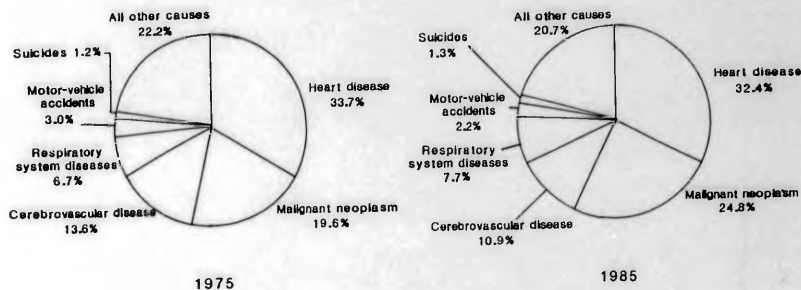
(a) Number of deaths at a specified age per 1,000 population of the same age and sex

Causes of death

As in previous years the main cause of death remains heart disease with 32.4 per cent of all deaths in 1985 (compared with 33.7 per cent in 1975). This is followed by deaths from malignant neoplasms (cancers) with 24.8 per cent (19.6 per cent in 1975), and cerebrovascular disease with 10.9 per cent (13.6 per cent in 1975). Accidents and other adverse effects accounted for 4 per cent of all deaths in Victoria (6.7 per cent in 1975).
