



LIVESTOCK PRODUCTS, AUSTRALIA OCTOBER 1987

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MAIN FEATURES

Red meat production for October 1987, in seasonally adjusted terms, increased by 17.0 per cent (32,024 tonnes) on the previous month's level and by 12.5 per cent (24,560 tonnes) on October 1986. In actual terms, red meat production for October 1987 increased by 14.9 per cent (30,232 tonnes) on September 1987 and by 7.0 per cent (15,165 tonnes) on October 1986, due mainly to increases in beef and mutton.

Whole milk intake by factories, in seasonally adjusted terms for September 1987 increased by 1.2 per cent (6 million litres) on the previous month's level and by 1.8 per cent (9 million litres) on September 1986. This represents an actual increase of 33.5 per cent (163 million litres) on August 1987 and 1.6 per cent (10 million litres) on September 1986. All states except New South Wales and Western Australia recorded increases over last month with Victoria being the main contributor.

September 1987 receipts of taxable wool by brokers and dealers, in seasonally adjusted terms were 69,734 tonnes which represents a decrease of 13.1 per cent (10,525 tonnes) on August 1987 and an increase of 7.6 per cent (4,905 tonnes) on September 1986. In actual terms September receipts of 132,236 tonnes, reflect increases of 30.1 per cent (30,585 tonnes) on August 1987 and 12.8 per cent (14,982 tonnes) on September 1986. All states recorded increases over the previous month.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains information (preliminary where indicated) on livestock slaughtering, meat production, exports of fresh, frozen and processed meat and stocks of frozen meat, whole milk intake by factories, market milk sales by factories and receipts of taxable wool by wool brokers and dealers.

Livestock slaughtering and meat production

2. The statistics on slaughtering and meat production are based on a monthly collection from abattoirs and other major slaughtering establishments and include estimates of animals slaughtered on farms and by country butchers and other small slaughtering establishments.

3. Care should be taken when using this information as the figures only relate to slaughtering for human consumption and do not include animals condemned or those killed for boiling down. Also, definitions of livestock categories may differ between States and within States, particularly with regard to calves.

4. Poultry slaughtering statistics have been compiled from returns supplied by commercial poultry slaughtering establishments. Producers in the Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory and the many very small producers are excluded from the collection; however, the statistics

represent a high level of coverage. The Queensland statistics are based on data collected by the Queensland Department of Primary Industries.

Milk

5. Tables 8 and 9 contain statistics collected by the Australian Dairy Corporation (ADC) on whole milk intake and market milk sales by factories.

Wool receipts

6. The statistics in Table 10 show the amount of taxable wool received by brokers and dealers from wool producers. It excludes wool received by brokers on which tax has already been paid by other dealers (private buyers) or brokers.

7. The information shown is on the basis of the State in which the wool has actually been received and does not necessarily reflect the production of wool in that State.

Seasonal adjustment

8. Details of seasonally adjusted figures for meat, milk and wool are shown in Tables 4, 8 and 10 respectively. Information on the methods used in seasonally adjusting these series is contained in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators, Australia* (1308.0).

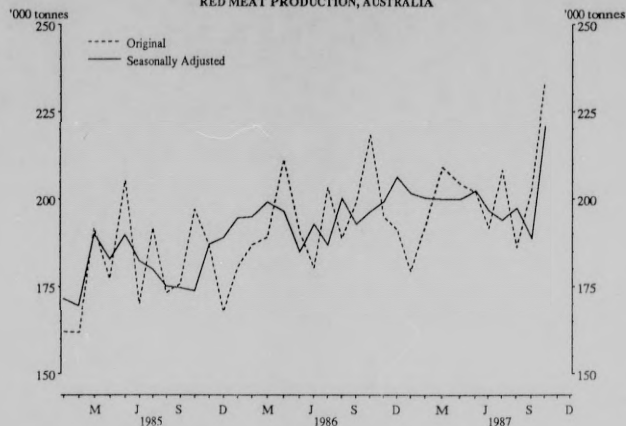

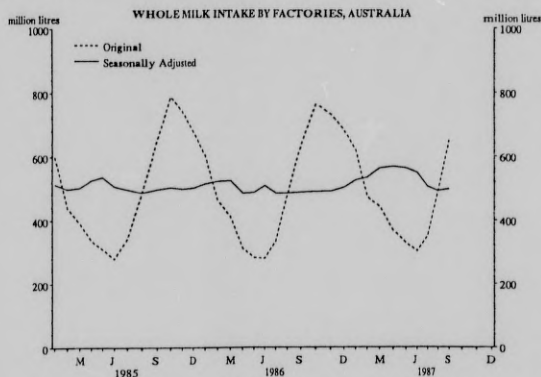
