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ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION AND AREA, QUEENSLAND, 1990

MAIN FEATURES

- The estimated resident population of Queensland at 30 June 1990 was 2,906,778 persons, a rise of 72,681 or 2.6 per cent since 30 June 1989. Although the 1990 increase was considerably below the record increase of 3.3 per cent in 1989, the 1990 figure was still comparable to the large population increases of the early 1980s.
- The Brisbane Statistical Division experienced the largest absolute increase (28,147 or 2.2 per cent). There was a lower absolute increase in the Moreton Statistical Division (23,854 or 4.9 per cent) with urban coastal areas experiencing a lower growth rate while hinterland areas maintained increasing growth rates.
- The Queensland part of the Gold Coast-Tweed Statistical District grew by 8,982 or 4.0 per cent. Significant growth also occurred in the Sunshine Coast Statistical District (5,278 or 5.1 per cent) and the Cairns Statistical District (2,516 or 3.1 per cent).
- Albert Shire recorded the largest absolute increase of any local government area with a rise of 9,616 or 7.4 per cent. Other significant absolute increases in south-east Queensland occurred in Logan City (6,098 or 4.3 per cent), Caboolture Shire (4,869 or 7.9 per cent), Brisbane City (4,699 or 0.6 per cent) and Redland Shire (4,496 or 6.0 per cent).
- Elsewhere in Queensland, significant growth occurred in the statistical divisions of Wide Bay-Burnett (6,121 or 3.4 per cent) and Far North (5,020 or 2.8 per cent). Small population declines occurred in the inland statistical divisions of Central-West (-103 or -0.8 per cent) and North-West (-65 or -0.2 per cent).
- In local government areas outside south-east Queensland, the largest increases occurred in the coastal areas of Hervey Bay City (2,073 or 8.9 per cent), Mulgrave Shire (1,978 or 4.1 per cent) and Thuringowa City (1,693 or 4.7 per cent).
- The increase in Peak Downs Shire of 20.6 per cent, due to coal mining activity, was among the highest annual growth rates in the State although the absolute increase was low.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Australian Standard Geographical Classification

The data in this publication are presented according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 9.

2. *Legal local government areas (LGAs)*, as defined under the *Local Government Act 1936-1989*, are spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils, such as cities (C), towns (T) and shires (S).

3. *Statistical local areas (SLAs)* are the smallest types of spatial units in the ASGC for which estimates of the resident population are presented. They correspond either to LGAs, as defined under the *Local Government Act 1936-1989*, or to suburbs in certain urban LGAs. Some LGAs are split into two or more parts, with each part forming a separate spatial unit. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.

4. *Statistical subdivisions (SSDs)* consist of one or more SLAs.

5. *Statistical divisions*, which are groupings of SLAs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan and Redcliffe, the Shire of Redland and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture, Moreton and Pine Rivers.

6. *Statistical districts* have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the LGA boundaries.

7. Areas shown are from information supplied by the Queensland Surveyor-General. The areas of SLAs in the Gold Coast and Townsville Statistical Districts are not available. The conventions followed in the rounding of areas are:

Statistical subdivisions and statistical local areas	- to the nearest square kilometre
Statistical divisions	- to the nearest 10 square kilometres
State total	- to the nearest 1,000 square kilometres

Population estimates

8. The ABS releases population census figures on three different bases: the census count at place of enumeration, the census count at place of usual residence and the estimated resident population. The census count at place of enumeration is based on the actual location of persons on census night. The census count at place of usual residence

is based on the reported usual residence of all persons enumerated on census night.

9. The *estimated resident population (ERP)* at 30 June 1986 for each SLA, is the official ABS population estimate, which is derived by making two further adjustments to the census count at place of usual residence. The first is an adjustment of census underenumeration as measured by the Post-enumeration Survey. Adjustments at the SLA level were calculated separately for Brisbane Statistical Division and Balance of State and took into account differences in underenumeration by age, sex and birthplace (Australian-born/overseas-born). More detailed explanations of this process are available on request. The second adjustment is the addition of Australian residents temporarily overseas at census date. This second adjustment is made down to SLA level and is obtained by analysis of the passenger cards which all persons arriving in or departing from Australia must complete. This produces an accurate estimate of the usual resident population of Australia and of each State/Territory and SLA.

10. For each geographical area, estimates of resident population for intercensal years are calculated by taking into account changes in a number of statistical variables which indicate population change. These include natural increase, pension and family allowance information, number of dwelling units, electoral enrolments, school enrolments and medicare registrations. A linear regression model is used to assist in making the estimates.

Reliability

11. Although estimates of resident population are shown to the nearest unit, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.
