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ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS INVOLVING CASUALTIES : AUSTRALIA JUNE QUARTER 1978

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains details of road traffic accidents involving casualties which occurred in each State and Territory of Australia during the three months ended 30 June 1978.

2. Due to a continued lack of uniformity in road traffic accident reporting in the various States and Territories, the ABS ceased compiling detailed road traffic accident statistics at the national level from July 1978. This lack of uniformity has also contributed to the long delay between the release of the March quarter 1978 and June quarter 1978 issues of this publication. The June quarter 1978 will be the final issue in this format.

3. Currently the ABS compiles and publishes only broad aggregated data at the national level for number of accidents, including fatal accidents, and number of persons killed and injured in road traffic accidents.

4. Progress has recently been made in uniformity of some aspects of reporting road traffic accident data and the ABS is currently giving consideration to the recommencement of publication of a limited range of this type of data late in 1980.

Seasonally adjusted

5. Original and seasonally adjusted statistics of road traffic accidents involving casualties, persons killed and persons injured are shown in Table 1. Because of the irregular nature of the data caution should be exercised in interpreting quarter to quarter movements. Details of the methods used in seasonally adjusting these and other series are given in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators* (1308.0).

Scope

6. The scope of road traffic accidents is defined as those involving casualties relating to accidents which were reported to the police and which satisfy the following conditions -

- (a) That the accident occurred on any road, street, thoroughfare, etc., open to the public, including railway level crossing.
- (b) That it involved any road vehicle, i.e. motor car, tram, handbarrow, etc., (or other road user, such as an animal), which at the time of the accident was in motion.
- (c) That the accident resulted in -
 - (i) the death of any person within a period of 30 days of the accident; or
 - (ii) bodily injury to any person to an extent requiring surgical or medical treatment.

7. The statistics in this publication are compiled from accident reports which are prepared by police officers in the various States and Territories.

8. Investigations conducted by the ABS have revealed that, in spite of the requirement for accidents involving casualties to be reported to the police, some casualty accidents, for the most part involving less severe injuries, have not in fact been reported. However, in Western Australia, from August 1977, as a result of the introduction of a new road traffic accident report form,

casualty accidents and persons injured include cases, previously excluded, where the persons injured did not require surgical or medical attention. In addition, procedural changes adopted in recent years have led to a decrease in the number of accidents being included in the reporting system. Precise measurement of the extent to which these factors have influenced the statistics has not been possible, but they are likely to have operated to a varying degree in all States and Territories. This should be noted when using these statistics for the analysis of trends.

9. Due to a change of definition introduced by the Road Safety and Traffic Authority (ROSTA) whose functions include the collection and dissemination of road traffic accident statistics in Victoria, accidents occurring in that State since 1 January 1977 have been classified according to the initial event which led to the accident. This has meant that some accidents previously classified as collisions are now classified to 'other' non-collision accidents.

10. Due to procedural changes in the processing of road traffic accident data in Western Australia, it has not been possible to classify accidents, fatalities and injuries occurring in that State during the June quarter 1978, according to 'Class of vehicle' or 'Type of road user involved' and 'Features of roadway'. Precise classification of certain accidents, fatalities and injuries by 'Nature of accident' has also not been possible in Western Australia.

11. Details of road traffic accidents, classified according to 'Type of road user responsible' and 'Cause of accident', are not included in this publication. Investigations have shown that, because of the subjective nature of classification of accidents according to 'responsibility' and 'cause', it has not been possible to collect and classify statistics on the same basis for all States. Particulars of road traffic accidents classified according to 'Type of road user responsible' and 'Cause of accident' are shown only in statements for South Australia and Tasmania.

12. Australian totals of the number of accidents which involved vehicle damage only are not available as these details are not compiled in all States.
