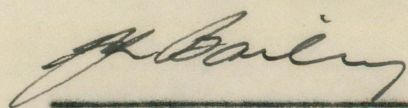

DESCRIPTION.

All that piece or parcel of land containing by admeasurement 1 acre a little more or less being part of the original 249,600 acre grant to the Australian Agricultural Company known as Warrah Estate within the County of Buckland.

Commencing at a point on the North Eastern side of a road 1 chain wide bearing and distant 133 degrees 46 minutes 560 $\frac{4}{10}$ links from the Southernmost corner of lot 64 Parish of Willow Tree thence on the North West by a line bearing 43 degrees 46 minutes 349 links to the Great Northern Railway land thence on the North East by the South Western side of the Great Northern Railway land being a fenced line bearing 134 degrees 21 minutes 287 $\frac{8}{10}$ links thence on the South East by a line bearing 223 degrees 46 minutes 346 $\frac{1}{10}$ links to the North Eastern side of the road one chain wide aforesaid thence on the South West by that side of that road being a fenced line bearing 313 degrees 46 minutes 287 $\frac{8}{10}$ links to the point of commencement.
