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WHOLESALE PRICE (BASIC MATERIALS AND FOODSTUFFS) INDEXFEBRUARY, 1966

This bulletin contains particulars of the Wholesale Price (Basic Materials and Foodstuffs) Index from 1936-37 to the present time.

2. A list of the commodities and other information concerning the index is set out in Labour Report No. 50, 1962 and 1963.

3. Commodities in the index are priced in their primary or basic form wherever possible and as nearly as may be at the point where they first make effective impact on the Australian price structure. The prices of imported goods, for instance, are on an ex-bond or into factory basis.

4. The prices used have, in the main, been obtained directly from manufacturers and merchants. With a few important exceptions, they are from Melbourne sources.

5. The index is constructed on the aggregative fixed weights formula. The weights are based on estimates of the average annual consumption of the commodities in Australia during the period 1928-29 to 1934-35. Work is proceeding on the preparation of new series of wholesale price index numbers. Meanwhile, the present series continue to be compiled on their existing basis, which has become increasingly affected by changes in usage, changes of category as between "imported" and "home produced" for some commodities, and changes in industrial structure.

6. Table 1 below shows for each index the percentage change of the index number for the month of February, 1966, from the preceding month (January, 1966) and from the corresponding month of the previous year (February, 1965). It also shows the percentage change of the average of the index numbers for the eight months ended February, 1966, from the average of the index numbers for the eight months ended February, 1965.
