EXPLANATORY NOTES

This statement contains statistics of teacher education in 1971. The statistics include all departmental students, that is, students studying under a State education department scholarship or fellowship. They also include private students enrolled at government and private teachers colleges. Other private students enrolled for teacher education courses at universities, colleges of advanced education, and other tertiary institutions are excluded. This statement also excludes practising and newly qualified teachers undertaking specialist or extension courses lasting one year (there were 890 in 1971), students enrolled for teacher courses at the Australian School of Pacific Administration (114 in 1971), and students at kindergarten teachers colleges (1,069 in 1971).

With the exception of Tasmania, where the Hobart Teachers College has become part of the Tasmanian College of Advanced Education, the scope and definitions of the statistics in this statement are identical with those relating to 1970 statistics which are shown in the Explanatory notes in "Teacher Education 1970" (Reference No. 13.12).

The statistics in this statement are preliminary. Final and more detailed statistics will be published in due course.
