TOURIST ACCOMMODATION, QUEENSLAND, SEPTEMBER QUARTER 1988

Analysis of Ungraded Hotel and Motel Establishments

Capacity, occupancy and takings data are dissected by star grading in Table 4 of the publication, ABS Catalogue No. 8635.3, for establishments meeting ABS Accommodation Survey scope criteria as hotels and motels with facilities.

Star grading is based on the classification system used by the Royal Automobile Club of Queensland (RACQ) as a member of the Australian Automobile Association.

In September quarter 1988, there were 1,092 Queensland hotels and motels with facilities which comprised 13 five star

establishments, 26 four star, 275 three star, 467 two star, 49 one star, 26 (ungraded) Great Barrier Reef island establishments and 236 other ungraded establishments.

Because of the significant number of other ungraded establishments (22 per cent), a dissection of these establishments by RACQ classification status and by average takings from accommodation per room night is presented below as an irregular supplement.

Main Features

Accommodation Capacity Available

For predominantly short-term *licensed hotels, motels etc. with facilities*, accommodation capacity available in September quarter 1988 increased by 3.9 per cent to 33,546 rooms and by 3.3 per cent to 100,935 bed spaces compared with the 32,285 rooms providing 97,681 bed spaces available in June quarter 1988.

For *self-contained units, flats and houses* within the scope of the survey, accommodation capacity available was measured as 14,770 units, flats and houses providing 58,691 bed spaces in September quarter 1988 compared with 14,294 units, flats and houses providing 57,060 bed spaces in June quarter 1988.

Total caravan park capacity available increased by 1.5 per cent to 54,863 sites in September quarter 1988 compared with the 54,028 sites available in the previous quarter.

Occupancy

Licensed hotels, motels etc. with facilities. Room nights sold during September quarter 1988 increased by 27.6 per cent compared with sales in September quarter 1987. Room nights sold during the year ended September 1988 were 18.6 per cent more than during the year ended September 1987. The September quarter 1988 room occupancy rate increased to 74.4 per cent, compared with

65.4 per cent for September quarter 1987, even though the number of guest rooms available increased by 12.0 per cent during this period.

Self-contained units, flats and houses. Unit nights during September quarter 1988 were measured at 1,071,391, an increase of 14.1 per cent from the 938,873 unit nights in September quarter 1987. The unit occupancy rate in September quarter 1988 was 79.5 per cent compared with 78.2 per cent in September quarter 1987. The number of units available increased by 13.2 per cent during this period.

Short-term caravan parks. Site nights sold during September quarter 1988 increased by 5.9 per cent compared with sales in September quarter 1987. The site occupancy rate for September quarter 1988 was 45.3 per cent, compared with 43.8 per cent for September quarter 1987. The number of sites available increased by 2.5 per cent during this period.

Long-term caravan parks. Site nights sold during September quarter 1988 increased by 13.8 per cent compared with sales in September quarter 1987. The

site occupancy rate for September quarter 1988 was 63.2 per cent compared with 56.7 per cent for September quarter 1987. The number of sites available increased by 2.2 per cent during this period.

Effect of World Expo 88

The September quarter 1988 statistics confirm the significant impact of World Expo 88 on the Queensland tourist accommodation market which was also evident in June quarter 1988.

Brisbane City recorded the highest room occupancy rate of 96.8 per cent for hotels and motels in Queensland during September quarter 1988, followed by Gold Coast City with 88.5 per cent room occupancy. Most regions from Gladstone northwards, however, recorded increases in room nights sold but decreases in average room occupancy rates in September quarter 1988 compared with those in September quarter 1987. Since the opening of World Expo 88 in Brisbane on 30 April 1988, Brisbane City has recorded room occupancy rates for hotels and motels of 93.5 per cent during May 1988, 95.8 per cent in June 1988 rising to 97.0 per cent in September 1988.

Explanatory Notes

Scope and Coverage

Tourist accommodation establishments currently included in the survey are:

- (a) (i) *Hotels with facilities, licensed to operate a public bar, and*
- (ii) *Motels, licensed and unlicensed, private hotels and guest houses with facilities (not licensed to operate a public bar)*

which

- predominantly provide short-term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) available to the general public, and
- provide a bath (or shower) and toilet in most guest rooms and
- have breakfast available for guests;

- (b) *Holiday flats, units and houses*

which

- are available to the general public for short-term accommodation (i.e. periods of less than 2 months),
- are operated by owners or managers who have sole letting rights to at least five flats, units or houses or by real estate agents for short-term letting where the majority of such flats, units or houses are self-contained in terms of cooking, bath (or shower) and toilet facilities and
- do not have breakfast available for guests and

- (c) (i) *Short-term caravan parks (predominantly occupied by guests staying less than 2 months) and*
- (ii) *Long-term caravan parks (predominantly occupied by guests staying for 2 months or more)*

- which provide powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.

2. The data are compiled from a complete enumeration of all of the above in-scope accommodation types. Coverage may vary over time due to establishments opening, closing and renovating. Regular coverage checks can also cause the reclassification of existing establishments due to changes in facilities. These factors should be taken into consideration when interpreting data movements.

3. Data collected and published for licensed hotels, motels etc. and caravan parks include both long-term and short-term guests at these establishments.

4. Occupancy data collected and published for holiday flats, units and houses available for short-term accommodation include short-term owner occupation as well as paying guest occupation.

5. Long-term caravan parks have been included in the survey because they provide a significant number of sites for short-term accommodation. Separate data are shown in Tables 7 and 8 for sites occupied by long-term guests at caravan parks.

Definitions

6. *Number of establishments* refers, for hotels, motels and caravan parks, to the number of those establishments within the scope of the survey which operated during the survey period. Included are those establishments which operated for any part of the quarter or which closed temporarily for the quarter for seasonal reasons. Establishments comprising more than one type of accommodation activity (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are generally treated as two separate establishments.

7. *Number of letting entities* refers, for self-contained holiday flats, units and houses, to the number of owners, managers or real estate agents within the scope of the survey who operated during the survey period.

8. *Self-contained units* attached to hotels or motels are classified as hotel or motel rooms and are not included in statistics on self-contained flats, units and houses. Similarly,

Definitions (continued)

self-contained cabins etc. attached to caravan parks are generally included as part of total park capacity. (See paragraphs 9.7 and 9.8 below.)

9. Capacity

9.1 *Guest rooms* refers to the maximum number of rooms, units, suites etc. available for accommodating paying guests at hotels, motels etc. with facilities during the survey period.

9.2 *Holiday flats, units and houses* refers to the maximum number of self-contained flats, units and houses within the scope of the survey available for short-term accommodation during the survey period.

9.3 *Bed spaces* refers to the maximum number of bed spaces (excluding cots) available to accommodate paying guests at hotels, motels etc. with facilities and at self-contained flats, units and houses during the survey period. Three-quarter beds are classified as single beds; double beds are counted as two bed spaces.

9.4 *On-site vans* refers to the number of caravans owned or leased and located on powered sites at caravan parks which were available for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

9.5 *Powered sites* refers to the maximum number of sites with provision for connection to electric power supply which were available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period. Included are powered sites occupied by on-site vans.

9.6 *Unpowered sites* refers to the maximum number of sites with no provision for connection to electric power supply which were available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

9.7 *Cabins, flats etc.* refers to the maximum number of cabins, flats, units and villas which were available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

9.8 *Total caravan park capacity* refers to the maximum number of on-site vans, other powered sites, unpowered sites and cabins, flats etc. available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

10. Occupancy

10.1 *Room nights* refers, for hotels, motels etc. with facilities, to the total number of nights a guest room was occupied by a paying guest during the survey period.

10.2 *Unit nights* refers to the total number of nights a self-contained holiday flat, unit or house was occupied during the survey period.

10.3 *Guest nights* refers, for hotels, motels etc. with facilities, to the total number of nights a paying guest stayed during the survey period.

10.4 *Site nights* refers, for caravan parks, to the total number of nights a powered/unpowered site, cabin, flat etc. was occupied by a paying guest during the survey period.

10.5 *Sites occupied by long-term residents* refers, for caravan parks, to the total number of sites occupied by long-term residents (i.e. guests who have stayed continuously for 2 months or more) at the end of the survey period.

11. Occupancy rates

11.1 *Room occupancy rate* refers, for hotels, motels etc. with facilities, to the proportion of guest rooms occupied to the number of guest rooms available during the survey period expressed as a percentage.

11.2 *Bed occupancy rate* refers, for hotels, motels etc. with facilities, to the proportion of bed spaces occupied to the number of bed spaces available during the survey period expressed as a percentage.

11.3 *Unit occupancy rate* refers to the proportion of self-contained holiday flats, units and houses occupied to the number available during the survey period expressed as a percentage.

11.4 *Site occupancy rate* refers, for caravan parks, to the proportion of site nights to total caravan park capacity available during the survey period expressed as a percentage. Unoccupied vans, cabins etc. are treated as vacant sites.

12. *Guest arrivals* refers, for hotels, motels etc. with facilities, to the total number of paying guests counted on the first night they stayed at the accommodation establishment during the survey period.

13. *Unit lettings* refers, for self-contained holiday flats, units and houses, to the total number of times a flat, unit or house was occupied by a new tenant, counted on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant during the survey period.

14. *Average length of stay*, expressed in number of days, can be derived

(a) for hotels, motels etc. with facilities, by dividing the number of guest nights by the number of guest arrivals for the survey period and

(b) for self-contained holiday flats, units and houses, by dividing the number of unit nights by the number of unit lettings for the survey period.

15. *Takings from accommodation* refers to total revenue received from provision of accommodation for the respective types of accommodation within the scope of the survey as described in paragraph 1. above. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of or after the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.

16. *Star grading* refers to the grading of hotels, motels etc. with facilities and is based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the RACV-RAASA members publication *Australian National Tourguide*, or the individual tour guides produced by members of the AAA.

17. *Employment*. Details of numbers of persons working at accommodation establishments (including those working on other than accommodation activities) have not been included in this publication. However, data are available on request from the ABS.

Australian Standard Geographical Classification

18. The data are presented according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 4.

19. *Statistical local areas (SLAs)* are the smallest types of spatial units in the ASGC for which tourist accommodation data are presented. They correspond either to legal local government areas (LGAs) as defined under the *Local Government Act 1936-1988* or to suburbs in certain urban legal LGAs. Some legal LGAs are split into two or more parts, with each part forming a separate SLA. In all instances LGA data can be derived by aggregating SLAs. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In aggregate SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.

Explanatory Notes (continued)

Australian Standard Geographical Classification (continued)

20. *Statistical subdivisions* (SSDs) consist of one or more SLAs.

21. *Statistical divisions*, which consist of one or more SSDs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan and Redcliffe, the Shire of Redland and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture, Moreton and Pine Rivers.

22. *Statistical districts* have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the legal LGA boundaries.

23. *City of Brisbane*. The *City Core* comprises the Suburbs of Bowen Hills, City, Dutton Park, Fortitude Valley, Herston, Highgate Hill, Kangaroo Point, Kelvin Grove, Milton, New Farm, Newstead, Paddington, Red Hill, South Brisbane, Spring Hill, West End and Woolloongabba.

24. *Sunshine Coast Statistical District* comprises the more urban coastal portions of Caloundra City and Maroochy and Noosa Shires. The figures for establishments in this district are also included in the totals for their respective LGAs, the Moreton Statistical Division and Queensland.

25. *Great Barrier Reef island establishments*. This category is comprised of establishments on the coastal islands from Heron in the south to Lizard in the north. The figures for these establishments are included in their respective statistical divisions and in the Queensland total.

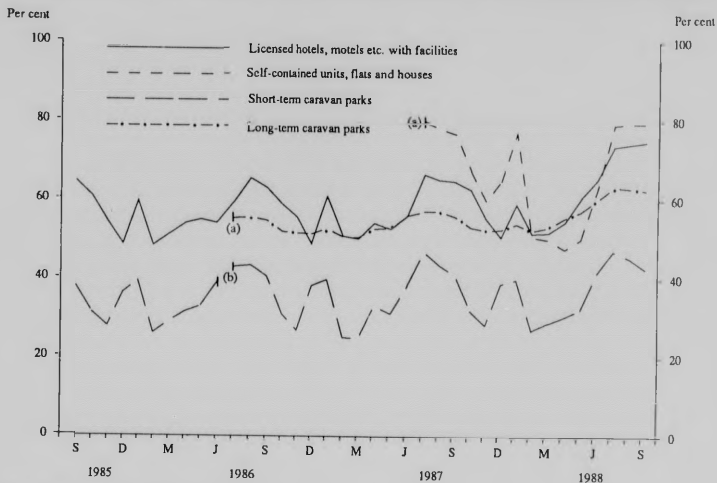

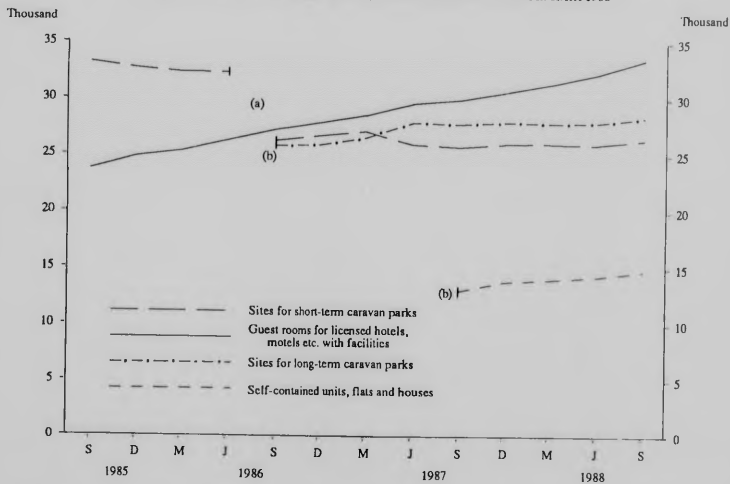

(a) New series. (b) Break in series due to change in classification.

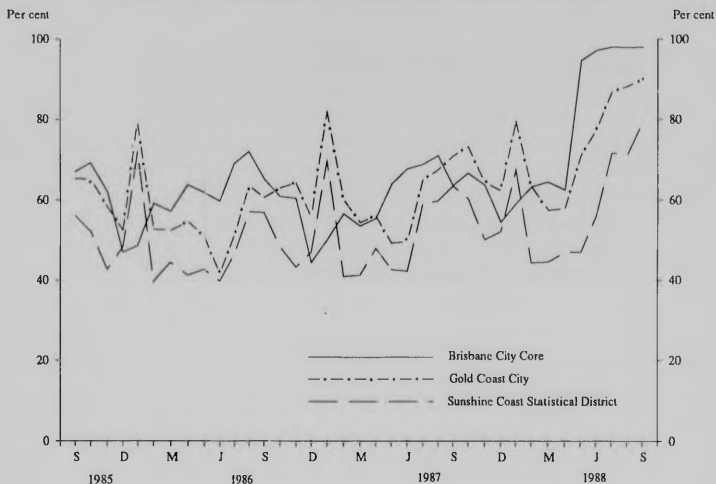
DIAGRAM 2 - CAPACITY, QUEENSLAND, SEPTEMBER 1985 TO SEPTEMBER 1988

GREAT BARRIER REEF ISLANDS, TOWNSVILLE CITY AND CAIRNS CITY

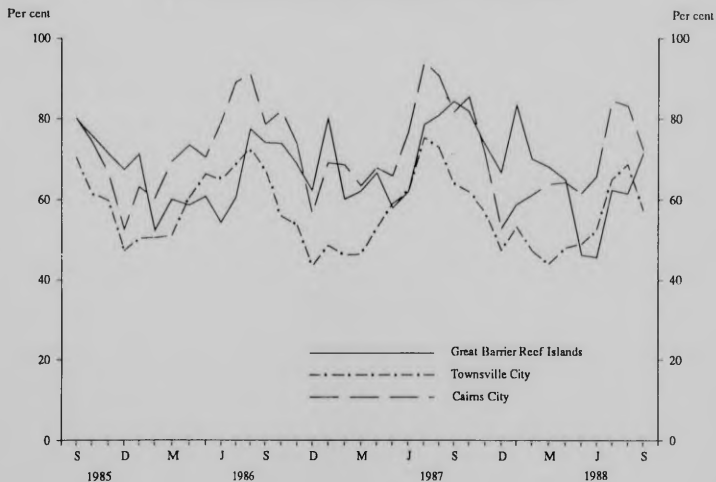

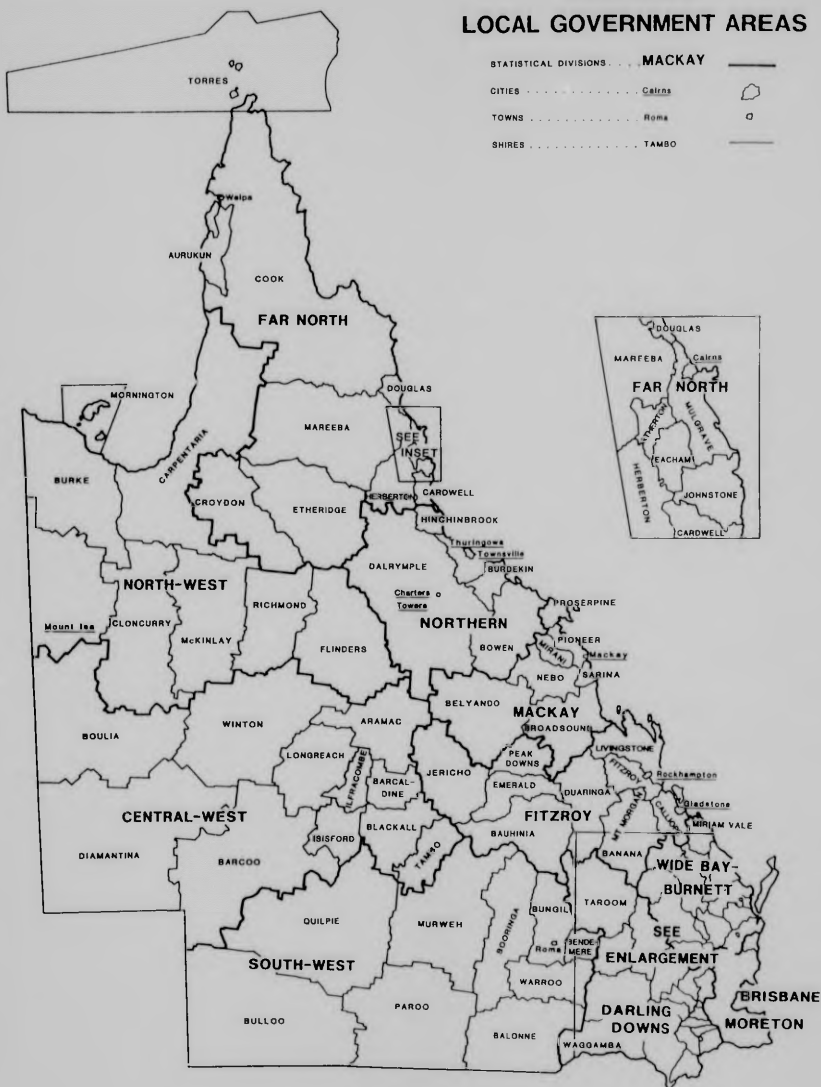

QUEENSLAND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS



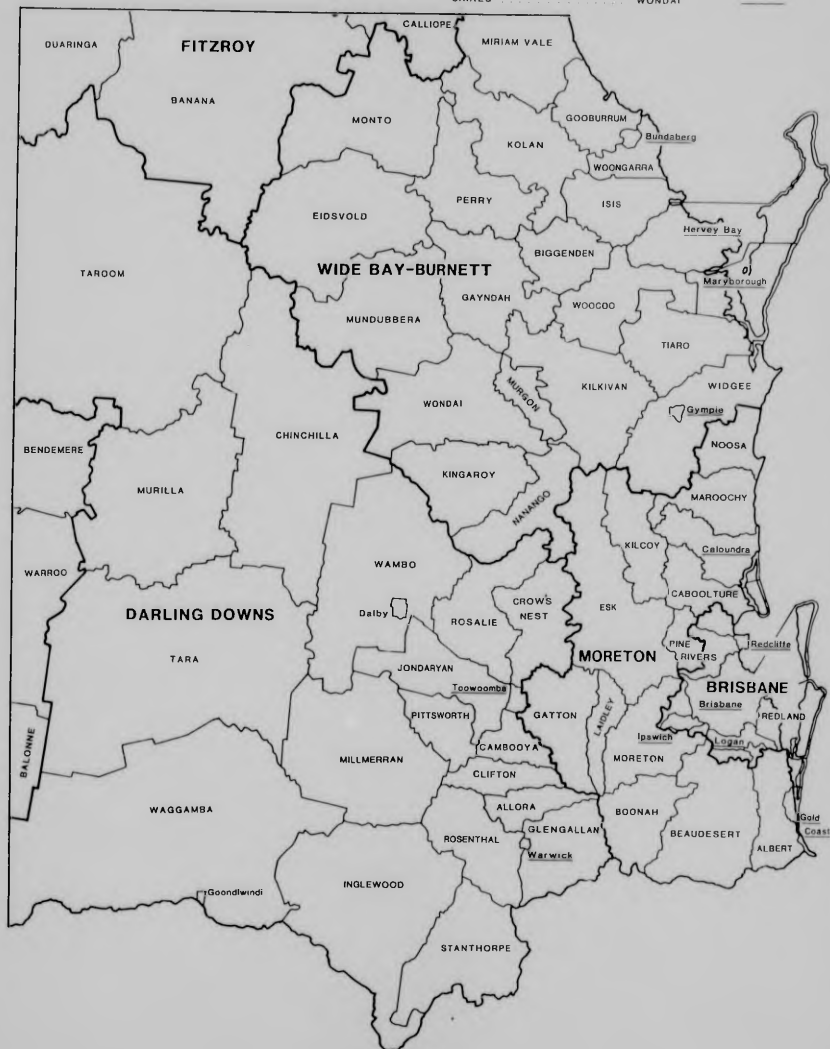
