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FACTORY STATISTICS : AUSTRALIA, 1963-64

The statistics shown in this statement relate to factories, workshops and mills in which four or more persons are employed or power other than hand is used.

Preliminary totals of the principal statistics relating to the operations of Australian factories in the year ended June, 1964 are shown below in comparison with the four preceding years.

Compared with the previous year, the average number of persons employed in factories increased by 42,630 or 3.65 per cent.; the total amount of salaries and wages paid by £102.7 million or 8.39 per cent.; whilst the value of production increased by £237.2 million or 9.89 per cent., and the value of output by £577.5 million or 10.06 per cent.
