MAIN FEATURES

Depositors' balances at the end of June 1984 were \$34,328 million. This was \$583 million more than in May 1984 and \$4,322 million more than in June 1983.

In seasonally adjusted terms depositors' balances for June 1984 were \$34,257 million, \$173 million more than in May 1984.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

The figures contained in the following tables have been prepared from returns submitted under the *Banking Act 1959* (voluntarily by State savings banks). These statistics are presented as being for calendar months though only five banks report for the exact calendar month; one bank reports as at the last Monday of each month and seven banks report as at the last Wednesday of each month.

Seasonal adjustment

2. Details of the methods used in seasonally adjusting depositors' balances (Table 2) and other series are given in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators, Australia (1308.0)*.
