

COMMONWEALTH BUREAU OF CENSUS AND STATISTICS, CANBERRA, AUSTRALIAPOPULATION COUNT OF CANBERRA AND QUEANBEYAN, 1ST JULY, 1963SUMMARY OF POPULATION AND DWELLINGSCONTENTS

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INTRODUCTION

This bulletin contains an analysis, in summary form, of the population and dwellings of the City of Canberra and the Municipality of Queanbeyan as enumerated at the Population Count conducted in those areas on 1st July, 1963.

In this bulletin the population is classified according to age, conjugal condition, religion, industry, occupational status and usual number of hours worked. Dwellings are classified according to class of dwelling (i.e., private house, flat, etc.) and nature of occupancy.

Each major table herein shows the numbers of males, females and persons or of dwellings according to one particular characteristic (e.g., age or conjugal condition of persons or nature of occupancy of dwellings). A series of cross-tabulations, a list of which is shown at the end of this bulletin, provide a more detailed analysis, and data from these are available from the Commonwealth Statistician, Canberra, on application.

The figures published in this bulletin exclude particulars of diplomatic representatives, their families and staffs resident in Canberra and also their dwellings. The number of persons excluded in this way from the population of Canberra was approximately 1,200 and the number of dwellings excluded 299.

EXPLANATORY NOTES : WORK FORCE

Employed Persons

The questions used in the Householder's Schedule for this Population Count to determine the number of persons in the work force were framed to conform as far as practicable with the recommendations of the Eighth International Conference of Labour Statisticians held in Geneva in 1954. They thus differ in form and in resultant data from the questions used and data derived in the 1961 Australian Census of Population. For the Population Count the basic question was -

"Did the person do any work at all (other than unpaid housework) during last week (that is, from Monday, 24th June, to Sunday, 30th June, 1963) for payment, profit or keep or as an unpaid helper in a family business or farm. Answer either yes or no."

For persons for whom the answer was "yes" a further question asked -

"State the usual number of hours worked per week".

Thus the statistics pertaining to the work force presented in Tables 8 and 9 embrace all persons who did any work at all (other than unpaid housework) during the week 24th to 30th June, 1963 for payment, profit or keep or as an unpaid helper in a family business or farm whether full-time, part-time, for less than usual hours, casually etc.

Unemployed Persons

Unemployed persons are all those who, during the week 24th to 30th June, 1963 did no work at all and -

- (a) did not have a job or business but looked for work; or
- (b) were temporarily laid off without pay for the whole week.

1. Population and Occupied Dwellings in Districts, 1963 : - The following table shows for each district in Canberra and for the Municipality of Queanbeyan, the number of occupied private dwellings and the population recorded therein together with the total number of occupied dwellings and the total population as recorded at the Population Count on 1st July, 1963.

In Canberra, population under 21 years of age represented 44.4 per cent. of the total in 1963 compared with 44.0 per cent. in 1961. In 1963, 52.7 per cent. were aged 21 to 64 years, while in 1961 the percentage was 53.0. Persons aged 65 years and over represented 2.9 per cent. in 1963 and 3.0 per cent. in 1961.

The population of the Municipality of Queanbeyan in each five-year age group at the 1961 Census and the 1963 Population Count is shown in Table 4.

In Queanbeyan, population under 21 years of age represented 44.7 per cent. of the total in 1963 compared with 42.4 per cent. in 1961. In 1963, 50.3 per cent. were aged 21 to 64 years, while in 1961 the percentage was 52.1. Persons aged 65 years and over represented 5.0 per cent. in 1963 and 5.5 per cent. in 1961.

4. Conjugal Condition, 1963. - The conjugal condition of the population of Canberra and Queanbeyan as recorded at the 1963 Population Count is shown in the following table.

At 1st July, 1963, 52.4 per cent. of the total population of Canberra were recorded as being never married (compared with 52.4 per cent. in 1961), 43.8 per cent. as married (43.6 in 1961), 0.9 per cent. as married but permanently separated (0.9 in 1961), 2.3 per cent. as widowed (2.4 in 1961) and 0.6 per cent. as divorced (0.7 in 1961).

In Queanbeyan 50.2 per cent. were recorded as being never married (50.5 in 1961), 44.9 per cent. as married (44.4 in 1961), 0.9 per cent. as married but permanently separated (1.2 in 1961), 3.4 per cent. as widowed (3.4 in 1961) and 0.6 per cent. as divorced (0.5 in 1961).

5. Religions, 1961 and 1963. - The following table sets out particulars of the religions of those persons in the City of Canberra who answered this question (which is not obligatory) at the 1961 Census and the 1963 Population Count. Similar information is shown in Table 7 on page 11 for the Municipality of Queanbeyan.

There were 8,466 persons or 12.0 per cent. of the population of Canberra who gave no reply to this question in 1963. The comparable figures in 1961 were 5,164 or 9.1 per cent.

In Canberra in 1963 adherents to the Roman Catholic Church numbered 22,415, consisting of 8,288 who described themselves as "Roman Catholic" and 14,127 as "Catholic". It is presumed that the great majority of the latter were adherents of the Roman Catholic Church. The Church of England had 22,405 adherents, the Presbyterian Church 6,171, Methodist 3,742, Lutheran 1,806, and Orthodox 1,072.

Of those who stated their religious belief, the greatest numerical increase since 1961 was recorded by Roman Catholic and Catholic (so described). These increased by 4,459 persons, followed by the Church of England with an increase of 3,101 persons, Presbyterian 1,010 and Methodist 516.

Among the denominations with the largest number of adherents the greatest proportional increases since 1961 were recorded by Baptist 27.4 per cent., Roman Catholic and Catholic (so described) 24.8 per cent., Orthodox 21.1 per cent., Presbyterian 19.6 per cent. and Church of England 16.1 per cent.

In Queanbeyan there were 1,268 persons or 12.3 per cent. of the population who gave no reply to this question in 1963. The comparable figures in 1961 were 660 or 7.0 per cent.

The denomination with the largest number of adherents in Queanbeyan was the Roman Catholic Church with 4,358 consisting of 1,897 who described themselves as "Roman Catholic" and 2,461 as "Catholic". The Church of England had 2,853 adherents, the Presbyterian Church 593 and Methodist 485.

6. Occupational Status and Usual Number of Hours Worked per Week, 1963. - Table 8 shows the occupational status of the work force in Canberra and Queanbeyan in conjunction with the usual number of hours worked per week. Because of the different basis of determining the work force used in this Population Count the figures for occupational status and total in work force in this table cannot be compared with the results of the 1961 Census. An explanation of the basis used is shown on page 3.
