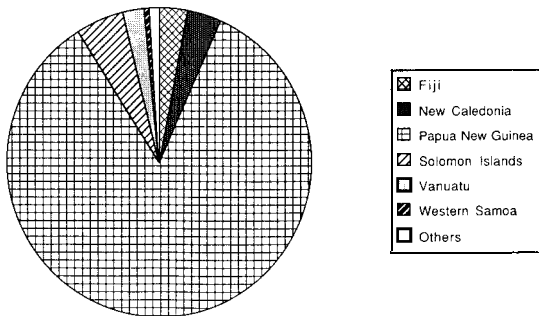

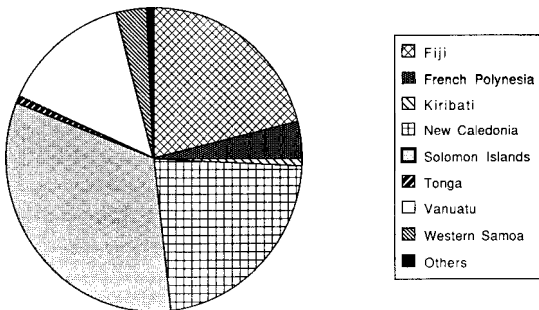

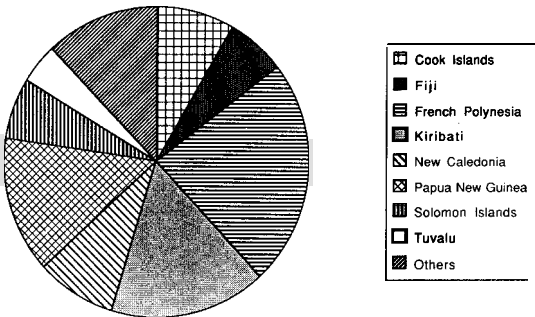
Land area in the Pacific



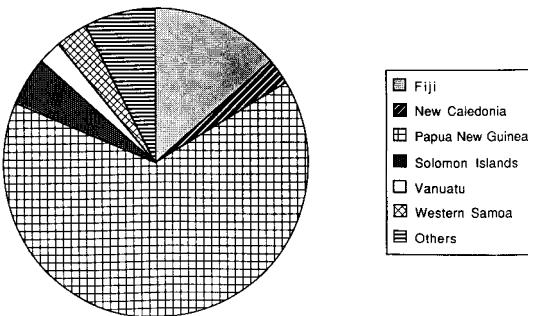
Land area in the Pacific — excluding Papua New Guinea

Population in the Pacific — excluding Papua New Guinea

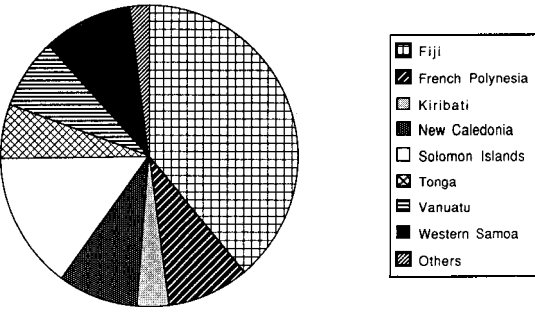

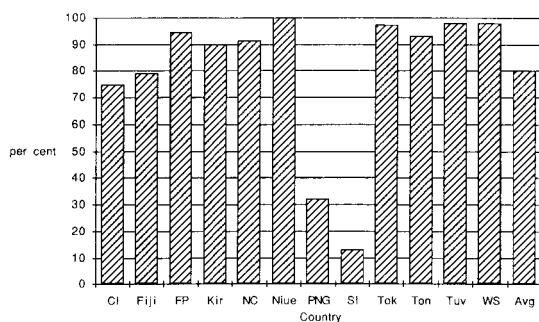

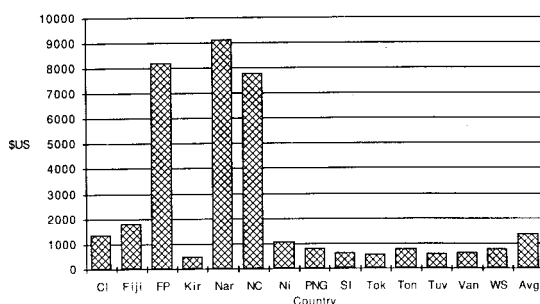

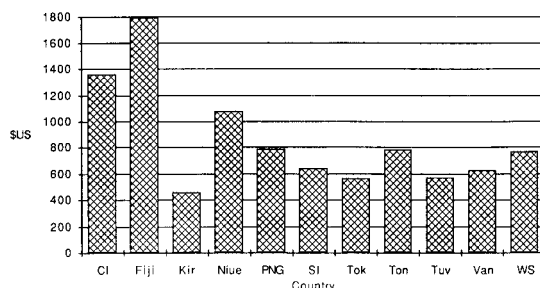

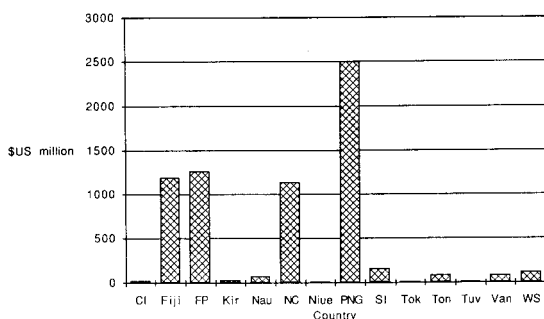
Gross National Product (GNP) per capita, 1983 (\$US)

Gross National Product, 1983 — excluding Fiji, French Polynesia, New Caledonia and Papua New Guinea (\$US million)

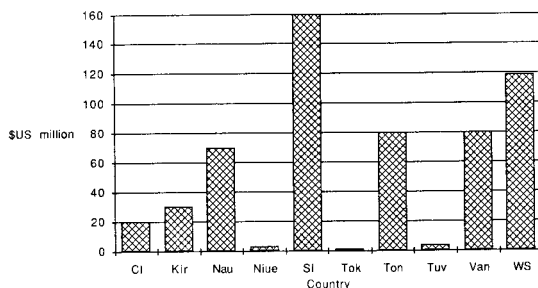

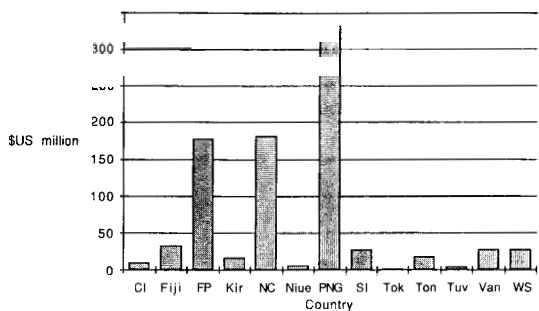

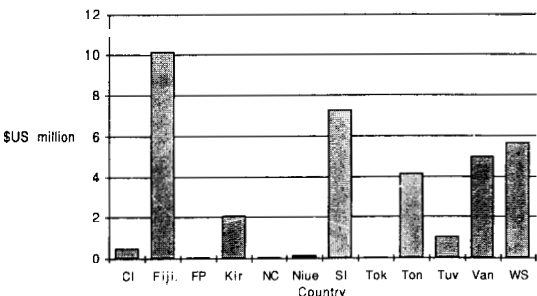

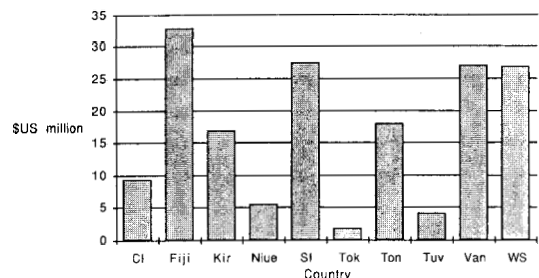
Total aid flows, 1983 (\$US million)



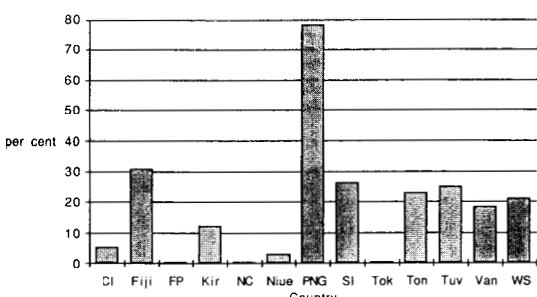
Australian bilateral aid, 1983 — excluding Papua New Guinea (\$US million)



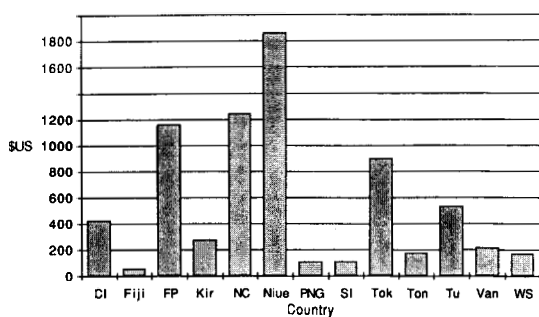
Total aid flows, 1983 — excluding Papua New Guinea, New Caledonia and French Polynesia (\$US million)



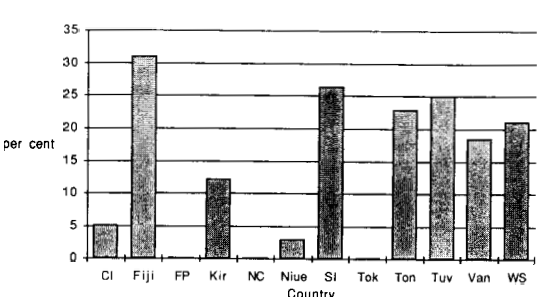
Bilateral Australian aid as a percentage of total aid flows 1983

Australian bilateral aid, 1983 (\$US million)

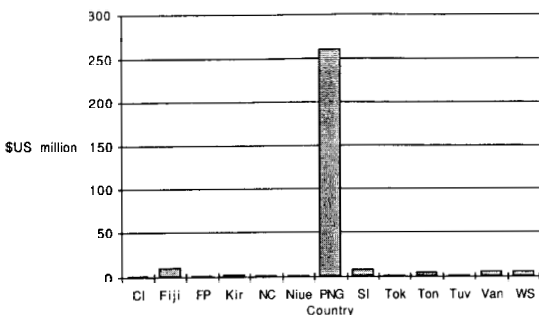

Distribution of Australian aid, 1983/84 (\$A million)

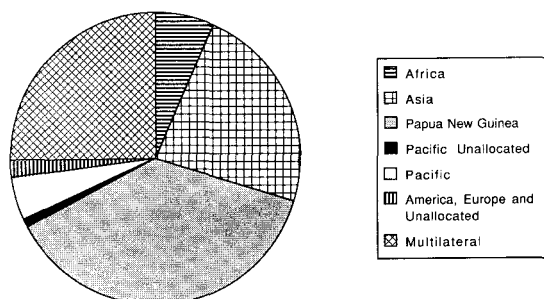

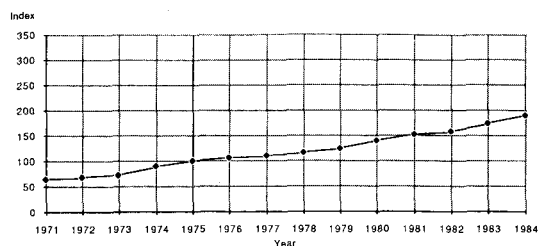

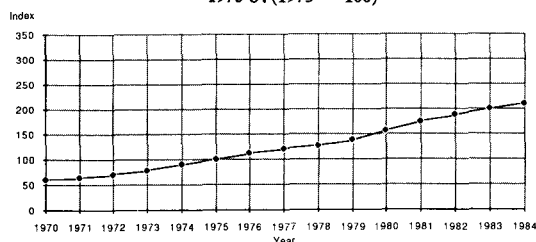

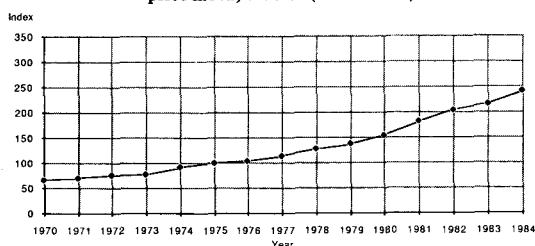
Papua New Guinea: Movements in the consumer price index, 1971-84 (1975 = 100)



Fiji: Movements in the consumer price index, 1970-84 (1975 = 100)



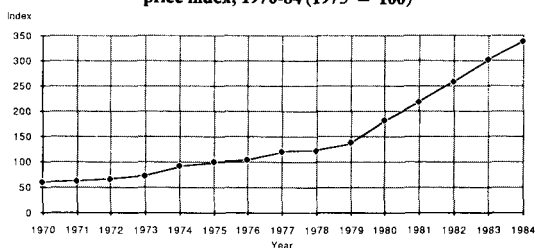
Solomon Islands: Movements in the consumer price index, 1970-84 (1975 = 100)



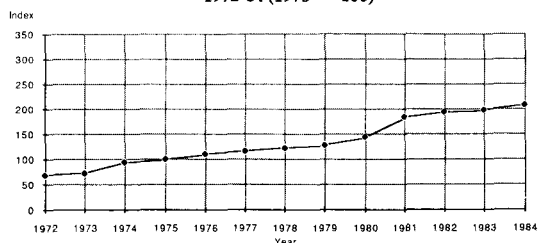

Tonga: Movements in the consumer price index, 1970-83 (1975 = 100)

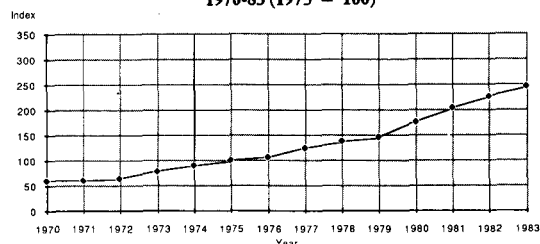

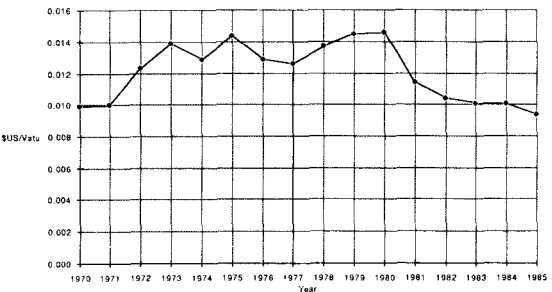

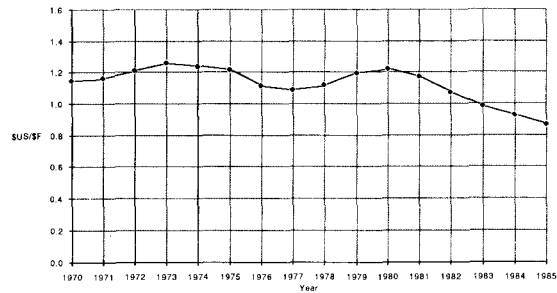
Exchange rate, Papua New Guinea, 1970-85



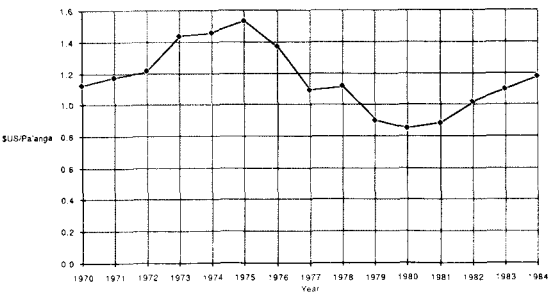
Exchange rate, Vanuatu, 1970-85



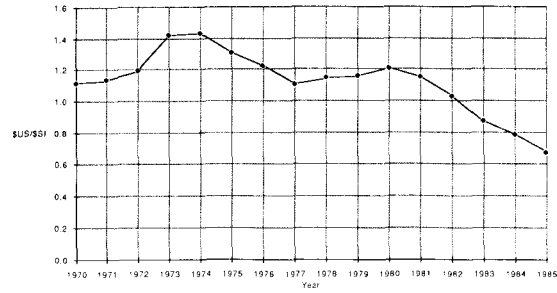
Exchange rate, Fiji, 1970-85



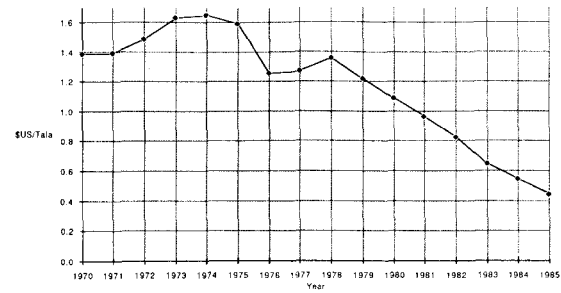
Exchange rate, Tonga, 1970-84

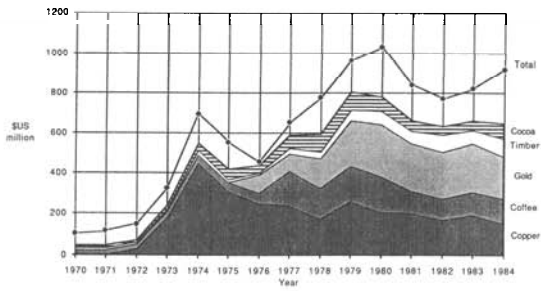

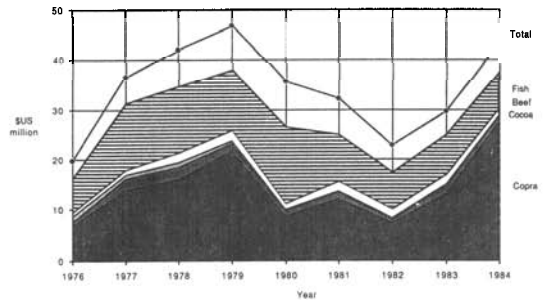

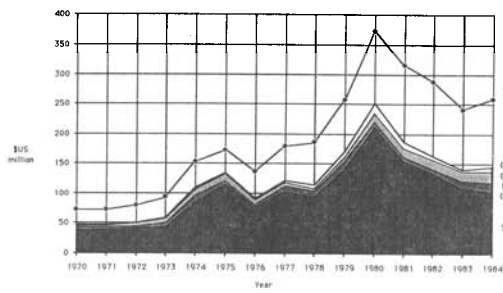
Papua New Guinea: Exports by value, 1970-84



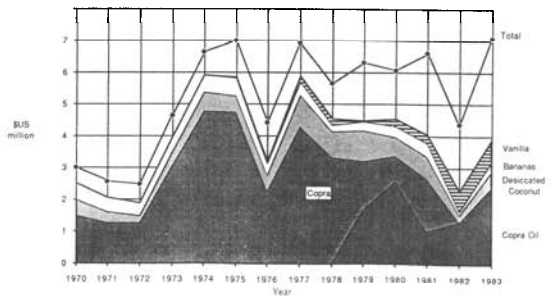
Vanuatu: Exports by value, 1976-84



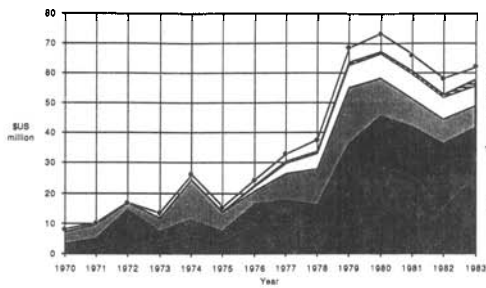
Fiji: Exports by value, 1970-84
