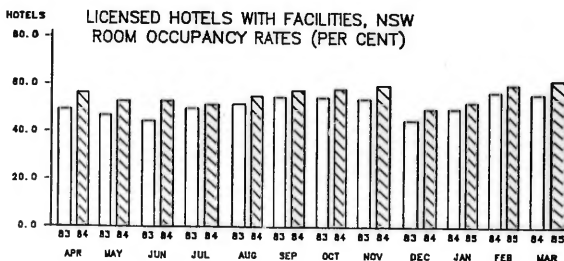

OCCUPANCY RATES TOTAL FOR N.S.W.

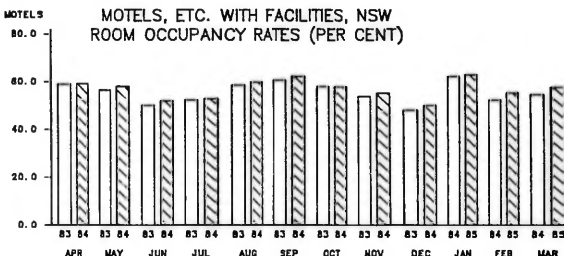
MAIN FEATURES

FOR NEW SOUTH WALES AS A WHOLE:

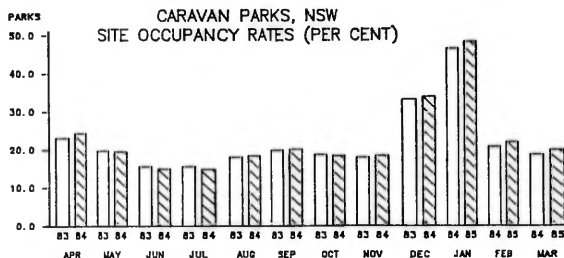
1. The March quarter 1985 room occupancy rate for licensed hotels with facilities (58.1%) has increased by 7.2% compared with March quarter 1984 (54.2%) and by 4.0% compared with December quarter 1984 (55.9%).



2. The March quarter 1985 room occupancy rate for motels etc with facilities (59.0%) has increased by 4.0% compared with March quarter 1984 (56.7%) and by 8.0% compared with December quarter 1984 (54.6%).



3. The March quarter 1985, site occupancy rate for caravan parks (30.3%) has increased by 5.2% compared with March quarter 1984 (28.8%) and by 27.9% compared with December quarter 1984 (23.7%).



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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This bulletin presents results for New South Wales of the quarterly surveys of tourist accommodation establishments. The period covered by the latest survey is the three months ended March 1985.

Scope and coverage

2. For the purposes of these surveys, a tourist accommodation establishment is defined as an establishment which provides predominantly short term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) available to the general public.

3. The scope of the survey may vary from time to time depending upon the needs of users of the statistics and on the ABS resources available to undertake the surveys. The types of establishments currently included in the survey are :

(a) Licensed hotel with facilities. A tourist accommodation establishment which

is licensed to operate a public bar, provides bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms, and has breakfast available for guests.

(b) Licensed or unlicensed motel, private hotel or guest house, with facilities. A tourist accommodation establishment which provides bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms and has breakfast available for guests but is not licensed to operate a public bar. This category also includes motels that are licensed to serve liquor with meals.

(c) Caravan park. A tourist accommodation establishment which provides powered sites for caravans and has toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.

4. Because of the limitations of information available for updating lists of tourist accommodation establishments, some delay may occur between the opening of an establishment and its inclusion in these

surveys. The effect of these delays on published occupancy rates are generally considered to be insignificant.

5. Statistical Areas of New South Wales. For the purpose of presenting the principal series of official statistics for New South Wales, local government areas are aggregated into statistical divisions, sub-divisions and districts. This publication contains statistics for the statistical divisions and for selected statistical districts and the appendices contain a map of these statistical areas and a list of their constituent local government areas. Details of the delineation of these statistical areas are provided in the Explanatory Notes to the publication Handbook of Local Statistics (1304.1). In Tables 3 and 5 data are shown for local government areas; local government areas are not listed in these tables when data for them are confidential or "nil".

6. Number of establishments refers to the number of tourist accommodation establishments within the scope of the surveys which operated during the survey period. Establishments comprising more than one type of accommodation activity referred to in paragraph 3 above (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two separate establishments. Included are those establishments which operated for any part of the quarter or which closed temporarily for the quarter because of seasonal reasons.

7. Guest rooms refers to the maximum number of rooms, units, suites, etc. available for accommodating paying guests at hotels and motels with facilities during the survey period.

8. Bed spaces refers to the maximum number of beds available (excluding cots) to accommodate guests at hotels and motels with facilities during the survey period. Three-quarter beds are classified as single beds; double beds are counted as two bed spaces.

9. Powered sites refers to the maximum number of sites with provision for connection to electric power supply which are available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period. Included are powered sites occupied by on-site vans.

10. Unpowered sites refers to the maximum number of sites with no provision for connection to electric power supply, which are available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

11. Cabins, flats, etc. refers to the maximum number of cabins, flats, units and villas available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

12. Total caravan park capacity refers to the maximum number of on-site vans, other powered sites, unpowered sites and cabins, flats, etc. available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.

13. Room nights (for licensed hotels, motels, etc) refers to the total number of times a room, unit or suite is occupied by a paying guest during the month or quarter.

14. Guest nights (for licensed hotels, motels, etc) refers to the total number of times a paying guest (including children occupying beds) stays at the establishment during the month or quarter.

15. Site nights (for caravan parks) refers to every time an onsite van or cabin is occupied by a paying guest or a private caravan or tent is occupied.

16. Room occupancy rate refers to the proportion of guest rooms occupied in hotels and motels with facilities to the number of guest rooms available during the survey period expressed as a percentage.

17. Bed occupancy rate refers to the proportion of bed spaces occupied by guests in hotels and motels with facilities to the number of bed spaces available during the

survey period expressed as a percentage.

18. Site occupancy rate refers to the proportion of powered and unpowered sites, cabins, flats, etc. occupied by guests in caravan parks to the total caravan park capacity available during the survey period expressed as a percentage. Unoccupied on-site vans are treated as vacant sites.

19. Takings from accommodation refers to revenue received from the provision of short term and long term accommodation at the tourist accommodation establishment. Where meals and accommodation were a combined charge an estimate of takings from meals was excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month represent the takings received during that month. In the case of some establishments payments may be made in advance of, or may be received after the provision of accommodation to guests and therefore the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.

20. Employment. Details of the numbers of persons working at tourist accommodation establishments (including those working on other than accommodation activities) have not been included in this publication. However, data are available upon request from the ABS.

Public school vacations in N.S.W.

21. The occupancy of tourist accommodation establishments is affected by school vacations. Public school vacations in New South Wales for the quarterly and monthly periods covered in this publication are:

17 December 1983 to 30 January 1984
14 December 1984 to 28 January 1985

Calculation of Room and Bed Occupancy Rates

22. To calculate occupancy rates for local government areas:

(a) multiply the number of guest rooms or bed spaces by the number of days in the period to give the maximum possible number of room nights or guest nights for the period, then

(b) divide the actual number of room nights or guest nights by the maximum possible number of room nights or guest nights in the period, and express the result as a percentage to give the room or bed occupancy rate.

OCCUPANCY RATES FOR SELECTED STATISTICAL DIVISIONS IN NSW

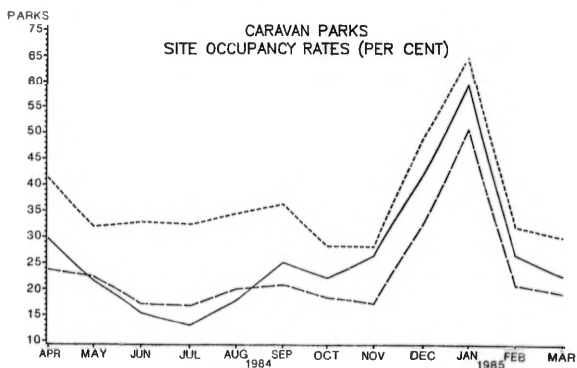
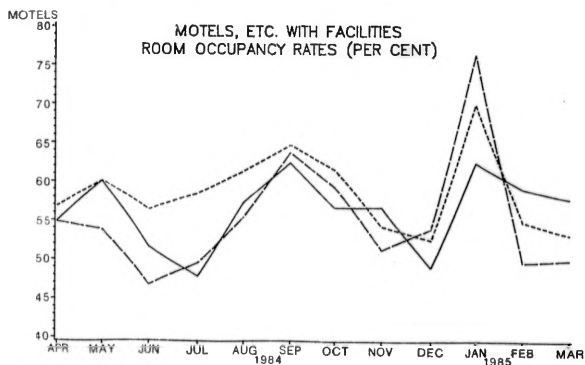
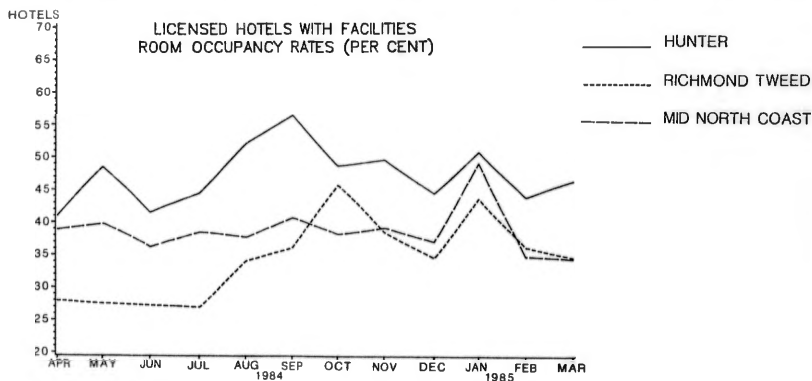
