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LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS STATISTICAL SUMMARY, QUEENSLAND, 1993

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NOTES

This publication contains a summary of the latest available statistics, at the time of preparation, for legal local government areas (LGAs) of Queensland. The data are presented according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC).

Changes occurred on 1 January 1991 to the area (sq kms) of Brisbane Statistical Division, Moreton Statistical Division, Gold Coast Statistical District, Cairns Statistical District, Townsville Statistical District and Bundaberg Statistical District as a result of statistical local area boundary changes resulting from the Australian Bureau of Statistics review of statistical geography completed in 1990.

The LGA structure has been cross-classified with the statistical division level of the main structure. The use of this cross-classification requires the combination of the Brisbane and Moreton Statistical Divisions, as some LGAs cross the contiguous boundary of these two statistical divisions.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Definitions

Legal local government areas (LGAs), as defined under the *Local Government Act 1936*, are spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils, such as cities (C), towns (T) and shires (S).

2. *Statistical divisions*, which are groupings of whole or part of LGAs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region.

3. *Statistical districts* have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the LGA boundaries.

4. Data for certain series available for statistical districts are shown on pages 38 and 39.

5. Area in square kilometres of LGAs is derived from estimates based on digitised statistical boundaries.

6. Estimated resident populations shown are based on the 1991 Census of Population and Housing counts adjusted for under-enumeration, as measured by a post-enumeration survey, and the estimated number of residents temporarily overseas.

7. Figures shown for births, deaths, infant deaths and natural increase relate to the resident population of the area for which they are shown.

8. Statistics of building work approved are compiled from: (a) permits issued by local government authorities in areas subject to building control by those authorities and (b) contracts let or day labour work authorised by Commonwealth, State, semi-government and local government authorities. Major building activity which takes place in areas not subject to the normal administrative approval processes (e.g. mining leases) is also included. The number of dwelling units created by alterations and additions to existing buildings and through the construction of new other buildings, i.e. buildings other than dwellings, is not included.

9. In connection with manufacturing statistics, the following should be noted.

10. *Location*. A location is a physical unit of an establishment, usually of an unbroken physical area or site. Manufacturing statistics were previously presented at establishment level. An establishment can consist of one or more locations.

11. The agricultural statistics shown in Table 2 exclude those establishments which make only a small contribution

to overall agricultural production. Data are classified by the *Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification (ANZSIC)*.

12. *Acute public hospitals* comprise hospitals under the control of hospitals boards and which are listed as 'recognised' hospitals under the *Health Insurance Act 1973*. Separate establishments providing only outpatient services, which are administered by hospitals boards, are also included. The three Mater public hospitals and the Commonwealth Government repatriation hospital are excluded.

13. Users may also wish to refer to other ABS publications which give data on a small area level. These publications, marked with the symbol 's' are included in the list inside this publication.

14. Current publications produced by the ABS are listed in the *Catalogue of Publications and Products* (1101.0). The ABS also issues the *Publications Advice* (1105.0) on Tuesdays and Fridays which lists publications to be released in the next few days. Both the *Catalogue* and the *Publications Advice* are available from any ABS office.

Other services

15. Information may be available in other forms including floppy disk, compact disc, microfiche, photocopy, computer printout or clerically extracted tabulation. A charge will be made for providing statistics in these forms.

16. As well as the statistics included in this and related publications, the ABS may have other relevant unpublished data available. 17. All publications of the ABS and many overseas statistical publications are held in the ABS Library and these can be made available for reference.

18. ABS publications are available for reference at most university libraries and various public and TAFE libraries throughout Queensland.

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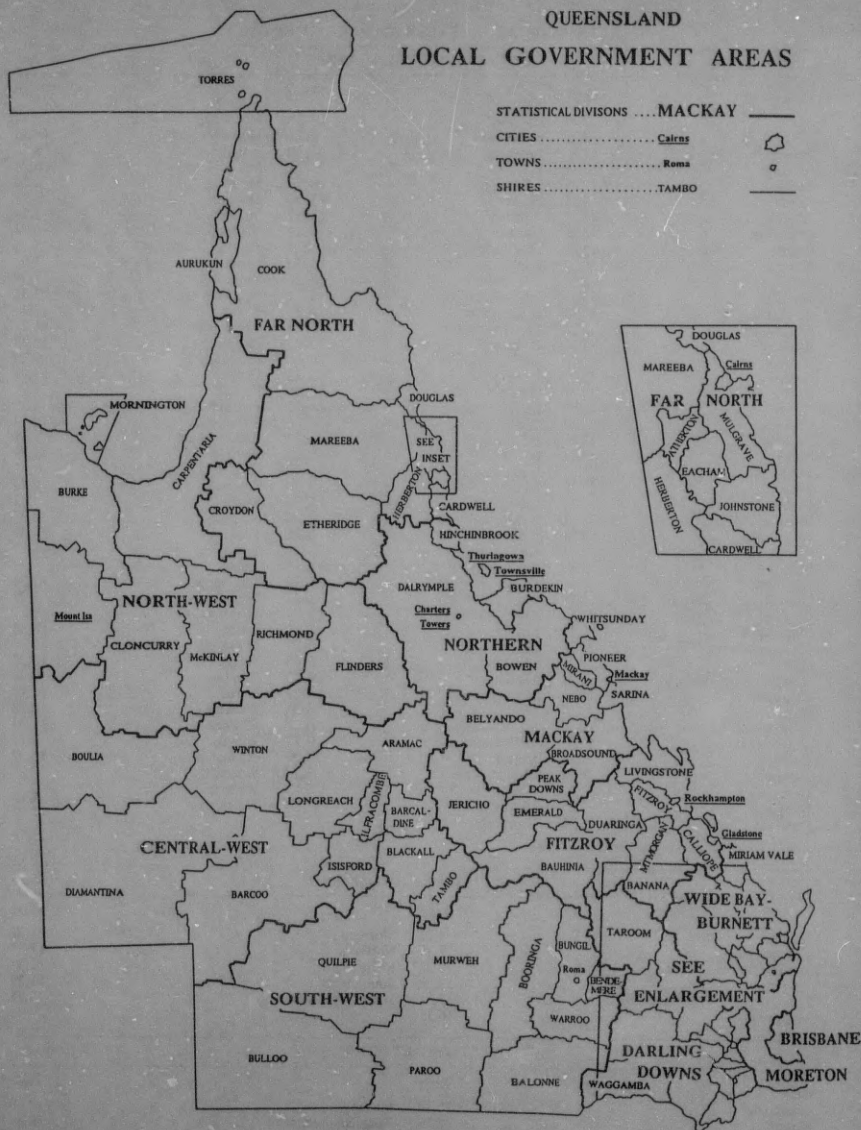
