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OVERSEAS ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES SEPTEMBER QUARTER 1976

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains statistics of overseas arrivals in and departures from Australia during the quarter ended September 1976, together with statistics for earlier periods. Less detailed statistics are published each month in bulletin 4.3.

Source of the statistics

2. Persons arriving in or departing from Australia are required to complete prescribed questionnaires in the form of Incoming and Outgoing Passenger Cards. These cards provide information to the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs for administrative purposes and serve as the main source of statistics of overseas arrivals and departures. In accordance with the *Census and Statistics Act 1905-1973*, information relating to individuals, individual flights or ships and individual carriers which is contained in these cards or other documents is treated as confidential by the Bureau.

Scope

3. The statistics exclude air crew and ships' crew, transit passengers who pass through Australia but are not cleared for entry, and passengers on pleasure cruises commencing and finishing in Australia aboard ships not then engaged on regular voyages. Summary information about transit sea passengers and cruise passengers is, however, included in Appendix A.

Seasonally adjusted series

4. Seasonally adjusted figures of total and short-term arrivals and departures are shown in Tables 5 and 14. Details of the methods employed in seasonally adjusting these series are given in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators 1976* (Reference No. 1.10).

Comparability

5. From 1 January 1974 new passenger cards and processing arrangements were introduced. This has affected comparability, in certain instances, with statistics from earlier periods. The more important differences are described below.

Category of traveller

6. In 1973 and earlier years, category of traveller was determined from the answers to a series of questions on the cards. The new cards, however, invite the passenger to select his or her own category and this selection is accepted provided it is consistent with other information on the card. Assisted settlers are identified as such by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs, which also compiles statistics relating to assisted migration schemes and other matters within its administrative functions.

Permanent movement

7. Permanent movement consists of settlers arriving and Australian residents departing permanently. Settlers are sub-divided into assisted and other settlers. Residents departing permanently are sub-divided into former settlers, (persons who state on departure that they had come to Australia intending to settle), and other residents departing permanently.

8. Before 1974, former settlers were not classified as such unless they had spent at least twelve months in Australia, but this distinction has been removed. In addition, the outgoing passenger card has been designed to reduce the possibility of temporary residents or visitors departing classifying themselves in error as former settlers and the statistics are now expected to be more accurate. This category does not include Australian-born children of former settlers.

Long-term and short-term movement

9. Long-term movement is defined as comprising visitors arriving and Australian residents departing temporarily with the intention to stay, in Australia or abroad, respectively, for twelve months or more, together with the departure of visitors and the return of Australian residents who had stayed, in Australia or abroad, for twelve months or more. Travellers whose intended or actual period of stay is less than twelve months are classified as short-term.

10. A significant number of travellers state exactly 12 months or one year as their intended period of stay. Until the end of 1973, these had been classified as long-term. Many of them stay for less than that period and on their departure from, or return to, Australia are therefore classified as short-term. Travellers who report their actual or intended period of stay as being one year are now randomly allocated to long-term or short-term in proportion to the number of returning travellers who report their actual length of stay as up to one month more or one month less than a year. A proportion of those who fail to state their period of stay is also allocated to long-term. A further change in definition concerns Australian residents who were previously regarded as long-term only if their intended or actual length of stay in any one country abroad was twelve months or more. Their classification is now governed by their intended or actual period of absence from Australia.

Country of embarkation or disembarkation

11. Country of embarkation or disembarkation refers to the country in which the traveller boards the actual ship or flight which brings him to Australia, or alights from the actual ship or flight which takes him from Australia. Travellers may answer this incorrectly, perhaps naming the country in which their journey commenced or will end, notwithstanding any changes of flight or ship en route. Before 1974 it was possible to

check their replies against a passenger manifest, but the requirements for airlines to present such manifests have been waived and this check is no longer possible.

State of clearance

12. From the beginning of 1974, State of clearance has replaced State of embarkation or disembarkation, and refers to the State in which a passenger is cleared by Customs and Immigration authorities. Embarkation or disembarkation and clearance are often in the same State but not necessarily so.

13. Passengers are counted in the period in which date of clearance falls. This is not necessarily the date of embarkation or disembarkation.

State or country of residence

14. State of residence or country of residence formerly referred to the Australian State or the country abroad in which the traveller had last lived for twelve months or more. The qualification no longer applies and the terms now refer to the State or country in which the traveller regards himself as living or as last having lived. State of intended residence is derived from the intended address given by settlers and Australian residents returning after a journey abroad. Particularly in the case of the former, this information does not necessarily relate to the State in which a traveller will eventually establish a permanent residence. This must be borne in mind in interpreting the statistics.

Reason for journey

15. The categories of reason for journey have been expanded as follows:

16. Another category for residents departing temporarily, "student vacation", is primarily intended to identify overseas students studying in Australia who are returning to their own countries on vacation, but who may have classified themselves in error as Australian residents. In the tables residents departing who classify

themselves as on "student vacation" are included in "holiday".

17. Because of the introduction of the additional categories, certain statistics relating to 1974 and later periods are not strictly comparable with those shown for earlier years. For example, travellers who would have been included in the pre-1974 category "business" may now appear under any one of at least four headings: "business", "attending convention", "accompanying business traveller" or "employment", i.e. the category "business" in 1974 and after is not directly comparable with the category "business" in earlier years. Similar comments apply particularly to the category "holiday".

Country of birth, residence or citizenship

18. From 1974, statistics on these items are available for a much increased range of countries, but the information has certain limitations. For instance, it is not possible to make a reliable distinction between Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland, nor to separately identify England, Scotland and Wales. Similarly "Korea" could refer to North or South Korea and "Germany" to the Federal Republic or to the Democratic Republic.

State of stay and country of stay for short-term travellers

19. Until 1974 no information was available about the Australian State or the overseas country where short-term travellers spent most time. Visitors are now asked on arrival for their intended address and on departure for the name of the State in which they spent most time. Accordingly, for arrivals, little reliance can be placed on the statistics. Information about the state of stay of visitors departing is considered more accurate. Australian residents travelling overseas are asked on departure for the name of the country in which they intend to spend most time, and on their return for the name of the country in which they spent most time.

Occupation

20. Statistics of the usual occupation of travellers have been expanded, primarily to obtain a more detailed classification of professional occupations. However, it should be noted that descriptions of occupations given by travellers are necessarily brief and cannot be confirmed by reference to industry or educational qualifications.

Sampling

21. Statistics of characteristics of short-term travellers from April 1971 to September 1972 are estimates derived from a fifty per cent sample of cards classified as short-term movement. From October 1972 to November 1973 the sample comprised one third of such cards, and in December 1973 it comprised one quarter. In January 1974 the stratified sample described below was introduced.

Fully enumerated strata -

- . All passengers by sea
- . All permanent movement
- . All travellers with a duration of stay of more than one year or not stated.

Sampled strata -

- All passengers by air with a duration of stay equal to or less than one year, sub-stratified as follows :

22. Since statistics of the short-term movement are estimates based on a sample and subject to sampling errors, the estimates are likely to differ from those that would be obtained from a full enumeration. A measure of the difference which may be expected is given by the "standard error" of the estimate. There are approximately 2 chances in 3 that the difference will be less than 1 standard error, and 19 chances in 20 that it will be less than 2 standard errors. It is impracticable to publish estimates of standard errors for all figures in individual tables. However, tables of standard errors which give a rough indication of the magnitude of the standard error associated with any estimate of a particular size are given as Appendix B to this publication.

23. Table 1 of the Appendix shows approximate standard errors for statistics of short-term movement prior to January 1974. Note that since the same sampling fraction applied to all short-term travellers in a particular month, it is unnecessary to distinguish in Table 1 between different categories of short-term travellers. Table 2 shows approximate standard errors from January 1974 onwards. Because from that date the sampling fractions differ for different categories of the short-term movement, three sets of errors are presented corresponding to different categories.

24. Although statistics of permanent and long-term movement are based on completely enumerated records, they are nevertheless partly estimated. A small number of travellers are classified as short-term at the point of selection but are reclassified subsequently to the permanent or long-term movement in the course of editing. The statistics are subject therefore to very small sampling errors.

Corrections and imputations

25. The imprecision due to sampling errors should not be confused with errors due to imperfections in reporting, which may occur in any data collection,

whether sampled or not. Every effort is made to minimise such errors, both through careful design of the passenger cards and through checks on the information once it is received. During the edit process some items are corrected where they conflict with other known information. Missing replies to certain items such as age, sex and country of birth are also imputed by reference to other related items.

26. Errors of this kind differ from discrepancies arising from the fact that certain information reflects the passengers' intentions at the time the cards were completed. These intentions are of course subject to change. The items particularly affected by such discrepancies are the distinction between permanent and temporary movement and, in the latter case, length of intended stay; country of intended stay; State of intended address; and reason for journey.

Related and additional statistics

27. The Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs compiles statistics relating to assisted migration schemes and other matters within its administrative functions and publishes *Australian Immigration - Quarterly Statistical Summary* and the annual *Australian Immigration - Consolidated Statistics*. Statistics of overseas arrivals and departures are contained in other ABS publications and these are listed in *Publications of the Australian Bureau of Statistics* (Reference No. 1.8) which is available free of charge from any ABS office. Related statistics are also available from certain surveys, such as those published by the Australian Department of Transport.

28. The tables in this and other publications necessarily contain only a small part of the cross-classification of items which are or can be produced. Also, items such as country and occupation are necessarily summarised from more detailed classifications. Further details can be obtained by writing to the Bureau or ringing the number shown at the beginning of this bulletin.

Presentation

29. Classifications of some data items have been extended from January 1974 and some tables in this publication have been expanded.

Rounding

30. After sampling, weights are assigned to sampled records to three decimal places, to increase the accuracy of estimation. During estimation all figures are rounded to the nearest integer. Any discrepancies between totals and sums of components of tables are due to rounding.
