NO. 53 : SUMMARY OF POPULATION AND DWELLINGS FOR TROPICAL AUSTRALIA.

This Summary contains an analysis of the population and dwellings of Tropical Australia as enumerated at the Census of 30th June, 1954, together with comparisons with the 1947 Census.

Tropical Australia lies to the north of the Tropic of Capricorn (latitude $23^{\circ}30'S.$), and has an area of 1,149,320 square miles, comprising almost 39 per cent. of the total area of Australia, but containing at 30th June, 1954 only 320,706 persons or 3.6 per cent. of its total population (excluding full-blood aboriginals). It includes 359,000 square miles or 54 per cent. of Queensland, 364,000 square miles (37 per cent.) of Western Australia, and 426,320 square miles (81 per cent.) of the Northern Territory.

Of the total population of Tropical Australia at the Census of 30th June, 1954, 300,445 persons were in Queensland, 6,805 in Western Australia and 13,456 in the Northern Territory. Males numbered 174,508, and females 146,198.

In this Summary the population is classified according to age, conjugal condition, birthplace, period of residence in Australia (of persons born outside Australia), nationality, religion, industry and occupational status, and dwellings are classified according to class of dwelling (private house, flat, etc.).

For the purpose of the Census a "dwelling" is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only part of a building.

All tables are exclusive of full-blood aboriginals or of dwellings occupied solely by them.

For 1947 it relates only to incorporated cities and towns and the town of Darwin, and comparisons cannot therefore be provided between the two Censuses.

"Rural" relates in each case to the remainder of the State or Territory.

"Migratory" relates to persons on ships, or who were travelling on long-distance trains or aircraft.

INDUSTRY. - The following table shows the main groups of industry in which the working population of Tropical Australia was engaged at 30th June, 1947 and 1954.

NOTE. - The Classification of Industries used for the 1954 Census differed in a number of instances from that used for the 1947 Census. The more significant of these instances are listed below, and the industry groups affected are indicated in the table by asterisks.

(i) SHIP AND BOAT BUILDING AND MARINE ENGINEERING in 1947 was included in the "Founding, Engineering and Metalworking" sub-group, whereas in 1954 it has been included in the sub-group "Manufacture, Assembly and Repair of Ships, Vehicles, Parts and Accessories".

(ii) "ELECTRICITY" in 1947 was divided into Production and Supply (included in this table with "Other Manufacturing") and Construction and Maintenance (included with the "Building and Construction" group); (iii) GAS in 1947 was included in the "Gas and Electricity" sub-group of the "Manufacturing" group (included in this table with "Other Manufacturing"); (iv) WATER SUPPLY AND SEWERAGE SERVICES in 1947 was included with "Building and Construction"; (v) SANITATION, INFESTION AND DISPOSAL OF REFUSE in 1947 was included with the "Personal Services, etc." sub-group of "Amusement, Hotels, Cafes, Personal Services, etc." In 1954, item (ii), except for Construction, and items (iii), (iv) and (v) have all been included in the "Electricity, Gas, Water and Sanitary Services (Production, Supply and Maintenance)" group. (vi) MOTOR ENGINEERING in 1947 was included in the "Transport and Storage" group, whereas in 1954 it has been included with the "Manufacture, Assembly and Repair of Ships, Vehicles, Parts and Accessories" sub-group. (vii) MOTOR GARAGES AND SERVICE STATIONS in 1947 was included in "Transport and Storage", whereas in 1954 it has been included in the "Retail Trade" sub-group of the "Commerce" group. (viii) CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF TELEGRAPH AND TELEPHONE LINES in 1947 was included in "Building and Construction", whereas in 1954 it has been included in the "Communication" group.

"Occupied dwellings" are classified into private and other dwellings.

"Private dwellings" comprise private houses (including sheds, huts, garages, etc. used for dwelling purposes), shares of private houses, flats and rooms, apartments, etc. In previous Censuses dwellings returned on the Schedules as sheds, huts, garages, etc. were included with private houses. In the Census of 1954, these dwellings are shown in tabulations as a separate group wherever practicable, but are linked with private houses to preserve continuity with past Census results.

"Share of Private House" is a portion of a shared private house which is occupied separately and for which portion a separate Householder's Schedule was furnished.

"Flat" is part of a house or other building which can be completely closed off and which includes both cooking and bathing facilities.

"Other" private dwelling is an apartment, room(s), etc., which is part of a building, but is not a self-contained unit.

"Dwellings other than Private" include Hotels, Boarding Houses, Lodging Houses, Hostels, Hospitals, Educational, Religious and Charitable Institutions, Defence and Penal Establishments, etc.
