PREFACE

Commencing with the forty-seventh issue, the Finance Bulletin was published in two parts, issues up to and including No. 52, 1960-61, comprising Part I covering Public and Private Finance and Part II, Commonwealth Taxation. Henceforward, in order to expedite the publication of the increasing amount of statistics available on the various major sections of Australian finance, the subjects dealt with by the former two Parts will be distributed among the following separate bulletins:—

Commonwealth Finance;

State, Territories and Local Government Authorities' Finance and Government Securities;

Banking and Currency;

Insurance and Other Private Finance;

Commonwealth Taxation.

This bulletin corresponds approximately to Section I, Commonwealth Finance of the former Part I.—*Public and Private Finance* and follows directly after issue No. 52, 1960-61. It covers statistics for the years 1958-59 to 1962-63 of the Commonwealth Public Account (Consolidated Revenue, Loan and Trust Funds) and includes also a summary of Government Securities on behalf of the Commonwealth and States at the end of June in the years 1959 to 1963. Appendices I-V contain summarized information on the Australian Note Issue and Coinage, Banking, Commonwealth Income Tax and Social Services Contribution, Commonwealth Age, Invalid, etc., Pensions, Child Endowment, Maternity Allowances, War and Service Pensions, Unemployment, etc., Benefits, and Population.

Current information on subjects dealt with in this bulletin are contained in the *Quarterly Summary of Australian Statistics*, the *Monthly Review of Business Statistics*, the *Digest of Current Economic Statistics* (monthly) and in the monthly mimeographed bulletins *Australian Banking Statistics* and *Australian Savings Bank Statistics* (also preliminary statements). An annual mimeographed statement *Commonwealth, State and Territory Taxation Collections* is issued as soon as the relevant information can be prepared.

I am especially indebted to Mr. I. R. Buttsworth, B.A., B.Sc., Supervisor of the Public Finance Branch and other officers of this Branch for the care and attention bestowed on the compilation of this Bulletin and the preparation of the material for the Printer.
