**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**Introduction**

1. This publication is issued each month as a supplement to the annual *Catalogue of Publications, Australia* (1101.0) of the Australian Bureau of Statistics, which lists current ABS publications and gives brief descriptions (abstracts) of their contents. In addition, a *Publications Advice* (1105.0) is issued each Tuesday and Friday listing publications released on the day of issue and expected releases on the following five days (Canberra Office) or two days (State Offices).

2. Significant occurrences in ABS Publishing are highlighted in the section *Publishing News* which follows the list of publications issued during the month. *Publishing News* contains brief descriptions of the contents of new publications, describes changes in ABS publications and shows other information of interest to users of ABS publications.

**Publication prices**

3. A single price now applies to publications despatched by surface mail both within Australia and overseas, and to counter sales. Airmail rates are available on request.

**Mailing service**

4. Clients who wish to receive publications on a regular basis may use the ABS computerised *Publications Mailing Service*. Further details and order forms are available from any ABS office.

5. Clients who already use this service and who wish to amend their requirements should quote their account number when contacting ABS. The account number is shown at the top left hand corner of the address label used to despatch publications to clients.

6. Renewal notices are sent to all subscribers annually in respect of the subscription year commencing on 1

January. Payment for publications is required in advance and should accompany renewal notices returned to ABS.

**Statistical information service**

7. Each ABS office has an *Information Service* to assist clients. The service is designed to answer inquiries from clients on available official statistics, including statistics not published for economic reasons. Unpublished statistics cover a variety of topics such as population, dwellings, building, imports, exports, shipping, etc., in the form of computer printout, microfiche, magnetic tape, floppy disk or specially prepared tables.

8. In cases where a considerable volume of data has to be specially extracted or where a regular statistical service is required, a charge will be made.

This publication provides statistics on expenditure and human resources devoted to research and experimental development (R&D) carried out in Australia by higher education organisations, classified by socio-economic objective, field of science, type of expenditure, type of activity, source of funds, type of employee and location of effort. Data are also expressed in current and constant (1979-80) prices. Limited data are shown separately for universities and colleges of advanced education. Expenditure relating to energy R&D is classified by energy objective and source of funds.

This publication provides statistics for each state and territory, the number of enterprises, persons employed, wages and salaries, turnover and value added by industry class.
