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TRADE OF AUSTRALIA WITH THE UNITED KINGDOM

YEAR ENDED JUNE, 1963

General. This statement relates to Australia's trade with the United Kingdom during the year ended 30th June, 1963 and, for purposes of comparison, shows some details for earlier years. The value of Outside Packages which is included in all tables in this statement is recorded as a separate item in class XX of imports and with the value of respective commodities in the tables of exports.

Figures for 1962-63 are preliminary and are subject to revision
