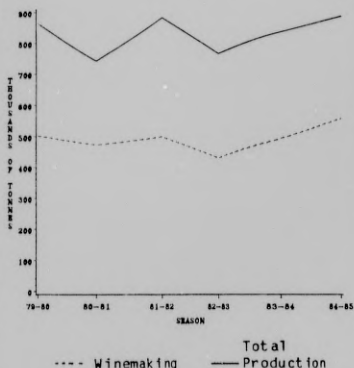
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MAIN FEATURES

ANNUAL GRAPE UTILISATION AUSTRALIA



- The 1984-85 harvest was a record 889,610 tonnes, up 5.8 per cent on 1983-84 and surpassing the previous 1981-82 record by 4,688 tonnes.
- Grapes for winemaking have increased by 12.9 per cent from 495,050 tonnes in 1983-84 to a record 559,041 tonnes. Both New South Wales (132,032 tonnes) and Victoria (96,807 tonnes) showed record yields of grapes used for winemaking, mainly because sultanas were used for winemaking at the expense of drying.
- The area of non-vinifera rootstocks is included for the first time showing Victoria with 1,033 hectares (61.9 per cent) of the Australian total of 1,669 hectares.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication presents information on area of vines and production of grapes for the 1984-85 season, classified by the principal grape varieties. In addition to showing details at the State and Australian levels, statistics are included for the major grape growing regions within each State. Details of production, sales, imports and exports of wine, gross value of production and consumption statistics are also included in this publication.

Scope and coverage

2. Viticultural statistics in this publication are derived from information obtained in a special collection conducted at 30 June 1985 in New South Wales, Victoria, South Australia, Western Australia and Tasmania, of all growers who reported vines in the annual Agricultural Census, conducted throughout Australia at 31 March, which collects data from establishments with agricultural activity. Production of Tasmanian varieties has been included for the first time in this publication. This special collection is not conducted in Queensland or the Territories, but summary data from the Agricultural Census are included in Table 5. Viticultural statistics for Queensland will be collected from 1986.

3. The ABS excludes from the Census those establishments which make only a small contribution to overall agricultural production. Thus, establishments with agricultural activity have been included in the 1984-85 Census if they had, or were expected to have, an estimated value of agricultural operations of \$2,500 or more.

4. To keep the number of questions asked in each Viticulture Collection to a minimum, the ABS only collects information on some topics in certain years. The 1984-85 Viticulture Collection asked for details of 'the area of vines on non-vinifera rootstock'. The botanical genus *Vitis* includes all grapevines. The grapes of commerce - that is wine grapes, drying grapes and table grapes - are further sub-divided into species *vinifera*. Thus, the grape industry in Australia relies exclusively on *Vitis vinifera*. *Vitis vinifera* vines are normally grown on their own roots but in some areas of Australia certain soil pests have made the growing of these vines either uneconomic or impossible. There are some 60 other species of vines in the world besides *Vitis vinifera* and a few of these have been identified as being resistant to the attack of the soil pests mentioned above. These other non-vinifera species are however not suitable for making wine, drying etc. but their pest resistance can be utilised by 'borrowing' their roots. These vines are called 'resistant rootstocks'. The desired commercial variety of *Vitis vinifera* (e.g. Shiraz) can be grafted on to a resistant 'non-vinifera' rootstock and the resultant vine will be able to survive soil pests and still produce Shiraz grapes. (Source: South Australian Department of Agriculture). In 1983-84 data on 'grapevines over 40 years old' were collected. In 1986 'intended plantings' will be asked.

5. Grape variety names shown in this publication are those recommended by the CSIRO and State Departments responsible for agriculture. Alternative names may be used for particular varieties in certain grape growing regions. Because of the difficulty of obtaining reliable reporting for some varieties it has been necessary to group certain varieties together.

Grape growing regions

6. Certain areas within each State have been chosen to provide a meaningful division of that State in terms of presenting data on the several recognised grape growing regions. Maps showing these regions are included with that State's statistics. These regions are described below:

New South Wales:

Hunter Valley comprising the local government areas of Cessnock Greater, Muswellbrook, Scone and Singleton.

Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area comprising the local government areas of Leeton and Griffith.

N.S.W. Sunraysia comprising the local government areas of Wakool, Balranald and Wentworth.

Victoria:

Victorian Sunraysia comprising the local government areas of the City of Mildura and Shire of Mildura.

Kerang-Swan Hill comprising the local government areas of the Cities of Kerang and Swan Hill and the Shires of Kerang and Swan Hill.

South Australia:

The regions adopted in South Australia correspond to the Phylloxera Board's districts which are as follows:

Central District (incl. Kangaroo Island) comprising the district councils of Gumeracha, East Torrens, Onkaparinga, Stirling, Mount Barker, Willunga, Strathalbyn, Port Elliot and Goolwa, Victor Harbor, Yankalilla, Kingscote and Dudley and the Corporations of Adelaide, Brighton, Burnside, Campbelltown, Glenelg, Happy Valley, Henley and Grange, Hindmarsh, Kensington and Norwood, Marion, Mitcham, Munno Para, Noarlunga, Payneham, Port Adelaide, Prospect, Salisbury, St Peters, Tea Tree Gully, Thebarton, Unley, Walkerville, West Torrens, Woodville, Enfield, Elizabeth and the Municipality of Gawler.

Barossa District comprising the district councils of Barossa, Tanunda, Mallala, Light, Kapunda, Angaston, Mount Pleasant, those portions of the district council of Wakefield Plains south of the River Wakefield, the Hundred of Dutton in the district council of Irero and the Hundred of Jellicoe in the district councils of Irero and Ridley.

Waikerie and Lower Murray District comprising the district council of Morgan, Waikerie, Ridley (except for the Hundred of Jellicoe), Mannum, Murray Bridge and Meningie, and the Hundreds of Anna and Skurray in the district council of Irero.

North Murray District comprising the district councils of Barmera, Berri, Paringa, the Municipality of Renmark, and Hundred of Katarapko and the Counties of Young and Hamley not otherwise included.

South Murray District comprising the district councils of Loxton, Browns Well, Karoonda-East, Murray, Peake, Lamerook and Pinnaroo.

Northern District comprising those portions of the district council of Wakefield Plains north of the River Wakefield, the district councils of Riverton, Saddleworth and Auburn, Euunda and Robertstown and the remainder of the State north and west of these areas which is not included in the above five districts.

South-Eastern District comprising the district councils of Coonalpyn Downs, Tatiara and Lacepede and the remainder of the State south and south-east of these areas which is not included in the above districts.

Western Australia:

Swan Shire comprising the local government area of the Shire of Swan.

Tasmania:

In Tasmania vineyards are located in and around Hobart, on the East Coast and north of Launceston.

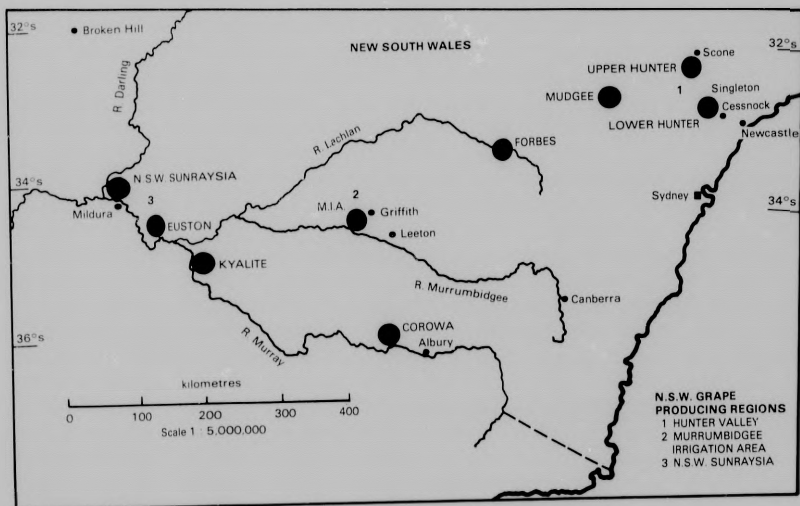
