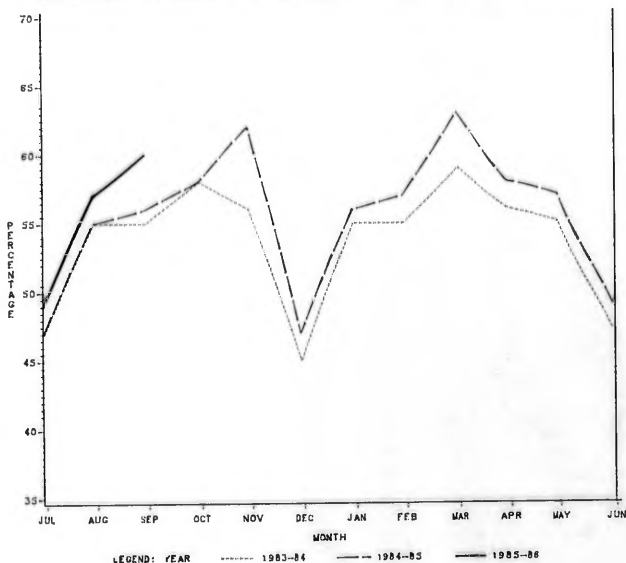

. The September quarter 1985 accommodation takings were \$17.1m for licensed hotels with facilities, \$30.3m for motels etc. and \$5.0m for caravan parks. In comparison, the June quarter 1985 accommodation takings were \$15.4m for licensed hotels with facilities, \$27.7m for motels etc. and \$5.5m for caravan parks and in the September quarter 1984 the accommodation takings were \$13.8m, \$26.6m and \$4.5m respectively.

. The site occupancy rate in caravan parks in the September quarter 1985 was the same as in the September quarter 1984 (10 per cent).

Introduction

This publication contains results, for Victoria, of the quarterly surveys of tourist accommodation establishments. The period covered by the latest survey is the 3 months ended 30 September 1985. In order to safeguard confidentiality the selected tourist areas for hotels, motels, etc., are not always the same as those for caravan parks.

2. Data classified by establishment size is available from September quarter 1980.

Tourist accommodation establishments

3. There is no generally accepted definition of a 'tourist accommodation establishment', but for the purpose of the surveys, a tourist accommodation establishment has been defined as an establishment which provides accommodation of a predominantly short-term nature (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) available to the general public. Note that data is collected and published for both long-term and short-term guests at these establishments.

Scope and coverage

4. The scope of the survey may vary from time to time depending upon the needs of users of the statistics and on the ABS resources available to undertake the surveys. The type of establishments currently included in the surveys are:

Hotel, licensed with facilities. A tourist accommodation establishment which is licensed to operate a public bar, provides bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms, and has breakfast available for guests;

Motel, licensed or unlicensed, private hotel, or guest house with facilities. A tourist accommodation establishment which provides bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms and has breakfast available for guests but is not licensed to operate a public bar. This category also includes motels that are licensed to serve liquor with meals; and

Caravan park. A tourist accommodation establishment which provides powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower, and laundry facilities for guests.

5. Because of the limitations of information available for updating lists of tourist accommodation establishments, some delay may occur between the opening of an establishment and its inclusion in this survey.

The effect of these delays on published occupancy rates are generally considered to be insignificant.

Definitions

6. Number of establishments refers to the number of tourist accommodation establishments within the scope of the survey which operated during the survey period. Establishments comprising more than one type of accommodation activity (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two separate establishments. Included are those establishments which operated for any part of the quarter or which closed temporarily for the quarter because of seasonal reasons.

Size of establishment refers to the size of the accommodation capacity of tourist accommodation establishments included in the survey. For hotels and motels with facilities the size of establishments is based on the number of guest rooms, for caravan parks it is based on the total caravan park capacity.

Guest rooms refers to the maximum number of rooms, units, suites, etc. available for accommodating paying guests at hotels and motels with facilities.

Bed spaces refers to the maximum number of guests that could be accommodated in beds normally in place (excluding cots) at hotels and motels with facilities during the survey period. Three-quarter beds are classified as single beds, double beds are counted as 2 bed spaces.

Powered sites refers to the maximum number of sites with provision for connection to electric power supply which are available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests. Included are powered sites occupied by on-site vans.

Unpowered sites refers to the maximum number of sites with no provision for connection to electric power supply, which are available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests.

Cabins, flats, etc. refers to the maximum number of cabins, flats, units, and villas available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests.

Total caravan park capacity refers to the maximum number of on-site vans, other powered sites, unpowered sites, and cabins, flats, etc. available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests.

Room occupancy rate refers to the proportion of guest rooms occupied in hotels and motels with facilities to the number of guest rooms available during the survey period, expressed as a percentage.

Bed occupancy rate refers to the proportion of bed spaces occupied in hotels and motels with facilities to the number of bed spaces available during the survey period, expressed as a percentage.

Site occupancy rate refers to the proportion of powered and unpowered sites, cabins, flats, etc. occupied by guests in caravan parks to the total caravan park capacity available during the survey period, expressed as a percentage. Unoccupied on-site vans, cabins, flats, etc. are treated as vacant sites.

Takings from accommodation refers to revenue received from the provision of short-term and long-term accommodation at the tourist accommodation establishment. Where meals and accommodation are a combined charge an estimate of takings from meals is excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month represent the takings received during that month. In the case of some establishments, payments may be made in advance of, or may be received after the provision of, accommodation to guests. Therefore the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.

Employment. Details of the number of persons working in tourist accommodation establishments (including those working on other than accommodation activities) have not been published since the March quarter 1979. However, data is available upon request.

Statistical divisions

7. Victoria has been divided into 12 statistical divisions since 1974. This involves the splitting of three local government areas. The Shires of Cranbourne, Healesville and Pakenham are partly in the Melbourne Statistical Division and partly in the East Central Statistical Division.

From July 1981 the Shire of Rosedale, which was formerly split between the Central Gippsland and East Gippsland Statistical Divisions, has been wholly allocated to the Central Gippsland Statistical Division.

These statistical divisions correspond with the regions adopted by the Victorian Government in October 1981 except in the cases of the Metropolitan region and, because of consequential effects, the Central Highlands and Loddon-Campaspe regions. The Victorian Government's Metropolitan region comprises the Melbourne and East Central Statistical Divisions, and the Shires of Bacchus Marsh and Gisborne.

Statistical districts

8. Statistical districts generally contain an urban centre with a population of 25,000 or more. Their boundaries, like those of capital city statistical divisions, are delineated to contain the anticipated urban development of the centre for a period of at least twenty years. These fixed boundaries delineate areas which for general statistical purposes are free from the problems imposed by the moving boundaries of the majority of urban centres. For a description of boundaries of the six statistical districts in Victoria, see the map at the end of this publication.

Related publications

9. Publications for Australia, and each State and Territory, are released by the respective Offices of the ABS. Past quarters' tourist accommodation statistics are available in earlier publications commencing with the September quarter 1975. Some unpublished statistics for small areas within States (e.g. local government areas or combinations of local government areas) are also available upon request.

10. Current publications produced by the ABS are listed in the Catalogue of Publications, Australia (1101.0) which is available free of charge from any ABS Office.

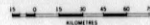

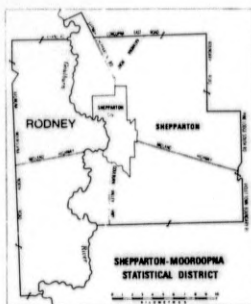
