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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication shows financial and other statistics for the year ended 30 June 1984 for individual local authorities constituted under the "Local Government Act 1936-1985" and the "City of Brisbane Act 1924-1984".

The Brisbane City Council is governed by the "Local Government Act 1936-1985" only where its own "City of Brisbane Act 1924-1984" is silent or where an ordinance has not been issued altering the application of the Local Government Act to the Brisbane City Council.

The figures shown in this publication, except for area and estimated population, have been compiled from annual returns and annual financial statements supplied by each local authority to the Local Government Grants Commission and to the ABS.

The powers of local authorities include the levying of taxation in the form of rates, based on the unimproved value of land, and the borrowing of money to enable them to perform their functions. Chief among these are the provision and maintenance of roads, footpaths, and community facilities (e.g. health services and recreational and cultural facilities). Most authorities also operate trading activities, the most common being water supply and sewerage services. A small number of authorities are also involved in gas, electricity, and

transport services. Although the services provided by local authorities are financed primarily from rates, charges, and loan raisings, financial assistance is also received from the Commonwealth and State Governments in the form of grants and subsidies.

Comparability

The statistics shown in this publication have been prepared using a uniform local government accounting approach, presenting details of receipts and disbursements of funds maintained by each authority. Wherever possible, steps have been taken to eliminate the effects of inter-fund transfers in an attempt to present details of net revenue and expenditure patterns of each authority.

Local authority areas, comprising 17 cities shown (C), 4 towns (T), and 113 shires are grouped into statistical divisions. At 30 June 1984, the Brisbane Statistical Division comprised the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan, and Redcliffe, the Shire of Redland, and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture, Moreton, and Pine Rivers. The remaining portions of these shires were in the Moreton Statistical Division. As it is not practicable to classify local government finance statistics within the relevant parts of those shires, complete shire details are shown in this publication and the two statistical divisions are combined.

EXPLANATORY NOTES (continued)Comparability (continued)

On occasions, the non-financial details reported by some local authorities may not be strictly comparable from year to year or between authorities. In recent years such differences have appeared mostly in the statistics shown in Table 12, Length of Roads Normally Open to Traffic, because of re-alignments, changes in the classification of surface types, and revisions to lengths reported by authorities resulting from a detailed definitional check conducted by the Local Government Grants Commission of Queensland.

The financial tables shown in this publication are compiled in accordance with the concepts employed in Standardised Local Government Finance Statistics implemented by the ABS from 1979-80. Further details on these concepts are available on request.

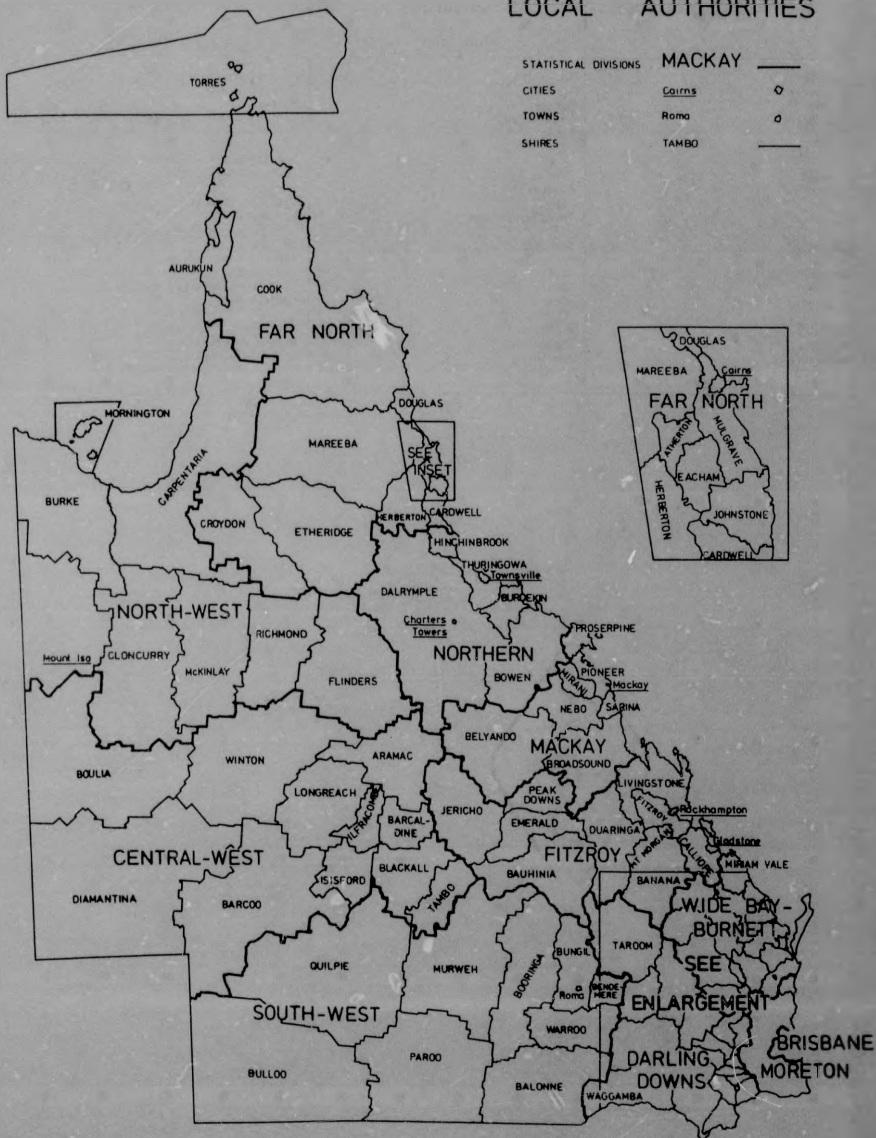
