EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bulletin contains results of the Survey of Retail Establishments and Selected Service Establishments for the Australian Capital Territory taken in respect of the years ended 30 June 1971, 1972 and 1973.

2. Annual Surveys of Retail Establishments and Selected Service Establishments in the Australian Capital Territory have been conducted since 1959-60. Prior to that date statistics of retail trade in the Australian Capital Territory were compiled only when periodic Censuses of Retail Establishments and Selected Service Establishments were conducted throughout Australia.

3. Generally the annual surveys are conducted on a basis consistent with that of the most recent retail census. The most recent Census of Retail Establishments and Selected Service Establishments was taken in respect of the year ended 30 June 1969 and except for minor differences in scope i.e. the exclusion of motion picture theatres and laundry and dry cleaning establishments, and in the amount of detail collected, the 1969-70 and subsequent surveys were conducted on a basis consistent with that of the 1968-69 Retail Census.

4. The 1968-69 Census of Retail Establishments and Selected Service Establishments was conducted for the first time on an integrated basis with the Censuses of Wholesale Trade, Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity and Gas. The integration of these economic censuses meant that for the first time the censuses were being collected on the basis of a common framework of reporting units and data concepts in accordance with a standard industrial classification ("Australian Standard Industrial Classification (Preliminary Edition) 1969 Vol. 1"). For a more detailed description of the Integrated Economic Censuses, reference should be made to Chapter 31 of "Official Year Book of the Commonwealth of Australia", No. 56, 1970.

5. Retail censuses and annual surveys conducted prior to the 1968-69 Retail Census covered the retail activities of all establishments which normally sold goods by retail to the general public from shops, rooms, kiosks and yards irrespective of what their main activity may have been. Because of the standardisation of census units in the integration of economic censuses, the 1968-69 Retail Census and subsequent annual surveys excluded the retail activities of locations whose main activity was not retailing such as some bread factories, wholesaling establishments, etc. However, while a retail establishment is thus one predominantly engaged in retailing, the data supplied for it in this Bulletin i.e. employment and floor space, covers all the activities at the location.

6. The definition of retail trade adopted in the 1968-69 Retail Census and in the subsequent annual Surveys of Retail Establishments and Selected Service Establishments is the same as the definition used in previous retail censuses and annual surveys, i.e. the resale of new and used goods to final consumers for personal and household consumption.

7. Figures for the year 1968-69, corresponding to figures for the years 1970-71, 1971-72 and 1972-73 shown in a number of the tables contained in this bulletin, are included in the bulletins of the 1968-69 Census of Retail Establishments and Selected Service Establishments (Reference Nos 11.16 and 11.18), published separately.

8. Due to the changes which have occurred in the definition of the census unit, the scope of the 1968-69 census and the annual surveys, and in the items of data collected, it is not possible to make direct comparisons between figures obtained from the 1968-69 census and subsequent surveys with those obtained from censuses and surveys conducted prior to the 1968-69 Retail Census. Consequently, details are not shown in this bulletin for censuses conducted prior to the 1968-69 Retail Census.

9. In the 1969-70 Survey, details of selling space and total floor space were obtained for the first time from all retail establishments (excluding bread and milk vendors, motor vehicle dealers, petrol and tyre retailing establishments) and selected service establishments. Details for the year ended 30 June 1971, 1972 and 1973, of selling space and total floor space of these establishments classified by industry class are shown in Table 11.

#### Commodity statistics

10. Commodity items shown in Table 1 of this bulletin are those included on the survey forms as used in the 1970-71, 1971-72 and 1972-73 Survey of Retail Establishments and Selected Service Establishments in the A.C.T. In supplying details of retail sales, businesses were asked to include cash and credit sales made during the year and to show value of sales net of all discounts. If the value of individual commodities sold was not available, businesses were asked to record careful estimates against the appropriate commodities listed on the forms. Retail sales for commodities other than those listed are included as "Goods not included above".

11. Commodities such as basic building materials, builders' hardware and builders' supplies, timber, commercial refrigerators and freezers, agricultural tractors, farm machinery and implements, construction and earth moving equipment, grain feed and fertilisers and agricultural supplies, business machines and equipment, although sold by some retailers and collected on the retail form are not treated as retail sales.

12. The value of operating revenue other than retail sales, classified by item, reported by retail establishments and selected service establishments is shown in Table 2.

#### Area statistics

13. In some tables the retail trade statistics for the Australian Capital Territory are subdivided into three broad sectors: "A.C.T. North" (including Belconnen), "A.C.T. South", "Woden Valley" (including Weston Creek) and these sectors are further subdivided into a number of suburban areas. "A.C.T. North" includes all areas north of the Molonglo River, including Hall and Jervis Bay. "A.C.T. South" includes all areas south of the Molonglo River including Tharwa and Cotter River but excludes Woden Valley and Weston Creek. Where details are shown for suburban areas, the boundaries of the areas specified are in general those delineated in official maps of the Australian Capital Territory. However, separate details are shown for "Manuka" which is officially a part of the Griffith subdivision. The boundaries of "Manuka" are Furneaux Street, Canberra Avenue, Captain Cook Crescent, Franklin Street, Flinders Way and Bougainville Street. "City" comprises the whole of the area contained by Cooyong Street, Barry Drive, Childers Street, University Avenue, Ellery Circuit, McCoy Circuit, Lawson Crescent, Parkes Way, Corranderrk Street and Ballumbir Street.

Definitions

14. Definitions of items included in the bulletin are:

- (i) The number of retail establishments and selected service establishments.

The number of retail establishments and selected service establishments which were operating in the Australian Capital Territory at 30 June.

- (ii) Sales and other operating revenue.

Retail sale of goods and all other operating revenue such as repair and service revenue, hiring of consumer goods, commission, takings from meals and accommodation and hairdressing relating to establishments which operated in the Australian Capital Territory during the year.

- (iii) Persons employed, male, female and total.

Working proprietors at the end of June, employees (including part-time) on the payroll of the last pay period in June and unpaid members of the proprietor's family and other unpaid helpers working at least 15 hours during the last week of June.

- (iv) Selling space.

All selling (store) space at 30 June including all store areas open to customers, including aisles, fitting rooms, restaurants and cafeterias plus on site stock rooms (i.e. those located within the main selling area and on the same level as the selling area). Excluded from selling space are areas of office space, alteration rooms, stock rooms (other than those referred to above), entrance halls, landings, staircases, escalators, lifts, display window space, kitchens, washrooms, store rooms, and staff canteens.

- (v) Total space.

All selling (store) space plus all space available at the establishment including all office space, work rooms, stock rooms (other than those included in selling space), entrance halls, landings, staircases, escalators, lifts, display window space, kitchens, washrooms, store rooms, and staff canteens.

Authority

15. The surveys were conducted under the authority of the Census and Statistics Act 1905-1966 under the terms of which all returns supplied must be treated as strictly confidential, and disclosure of information shown on individual returns is prohibited. Consequently in the tables set out in this bulletin, figures for some categories are either grouped with figures for other categories or withheld from publication in order to avoid disclosure of confidential information.

16. Revisions have been made to some of the figures previously published.

17. The symbol .., where shown in tables, means nil or less than \$500.
