Wheat Gristed:- The quantity of wheat gristed by mills during the four weeks ended 28th January, 1950 was 5,036,899 bushels. In addition to the products shown above, 104 tons (2,000 lb.) of wheatmeal for porridge, 2,433 tons (2,000 lb.) of stockmeal, 607 tons (2,000 lb.) of semolina and 110 tons (2,000 lb.) of wheat germ were produced from this quantity of wheat.
