PRODUCTION SUMMARY NO. 9 : ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES (a)
AUSTRALIA : JULY 1975

All annual figures are derived from the recorded monthly production and are subject to revision. This summary contains seasonally adjusted statistics of refrigerators on page 2. In the seasonal adjustment, account has been taken not only of normal seasonal factors but also of "trading day" effects (arising from the varying numbers of Sundays, Mondays, Tuesdays, etc. in the month) and the influence of Easter and Australia Day which may, in successive years, affect figures for different months. Details of the methods used in seasonally adjusting this and other series are given in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators*, 1975 (Ref. No. 1.10), issued in July 1975.
