

TOURIST ACCOMMODATION, VICTORIA JUNE QUARTER 1990

MAIN FEATURES

The Easter holiday period fell in April in 1990, whereas in 1989 it fell in March.

HOTELS, MOTELS ETC

Room Occupancy

The June quarter 1990 room occupancy rate in Victoria was 49.8 per cent. This was the lowest rate in the last 3 years.

The Melbourne (56.6 per cent) and Wimmera (42.1 per cent) Statistical Divisions also experienced their lowest rates in the last 3 years.

Only the Northern Mallee and North Eastern Statistical Divisions experienced increased occupancy rates (8.8 per cent and 3.9 per cent respectively), compared with the March quarter 1990.

For the June quarter 1990, star gradings 1 to 5 in Victoria all experienced decreases in occupancy rates compared with the same quarter last year. However, ungraded establishments experienced an increase in occupancy rates over the same period. Most of these ungraded establishments are located outside the Melbourne Statistical Division.

Guest Arrivals

Guest arrivals in Victoria for the June quarter 1990 were 1,087,830. This was the lowest number of arrivals since the September quarter 1988 (916,362).

Takings

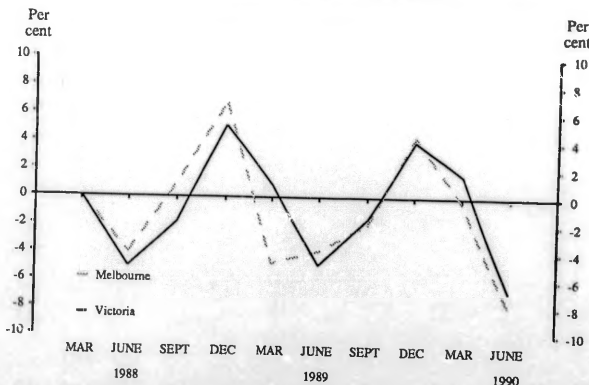
Takings for all hotels, motels etc. for the quarter were \$92.2m, an increase of 6.2 per cent on the June quarter 1989 (\$86.8m).

Over the same period of time the Consumer Price Index for Melbourne (all groups) increased 7.8 per cent. The expenditure class Holiday Travel and Accommodation increased by 9.4 per cent.

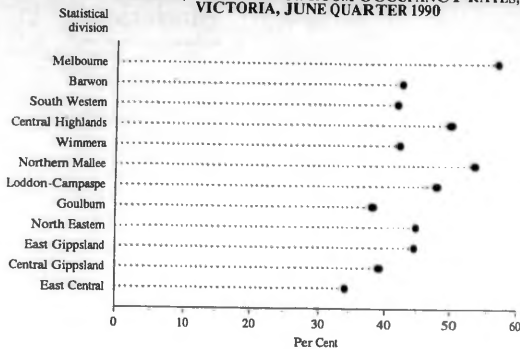
CARAVAN PARKS

The site occupancy rate for short term caravan parks in Victoria increased from 27.5 per cent in the June quarter 1989 to 32.4 per cent in the June quarter 1990.

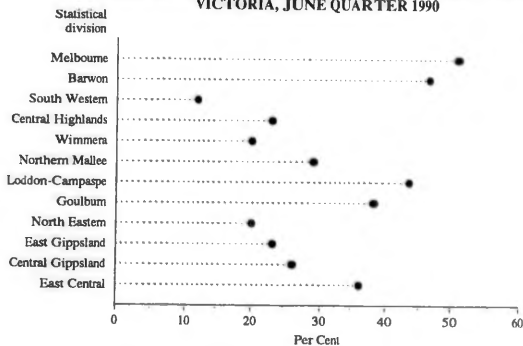
HOTELS, MOTELS, ETC. VICTORIA: ROOM OCCUPANCY RATES
Percentage change from preceding quarter



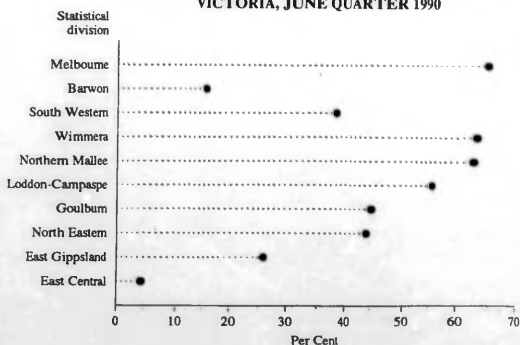
HOTELS, MOTELS ETC.: ROOM OCCUPANCY RATES, VICTORIA, JUNE QUARTER 1990

MOTELS, ETC. IN SELECTED STATISTICAL DIVISIONS**

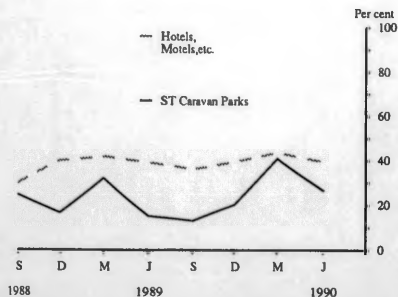

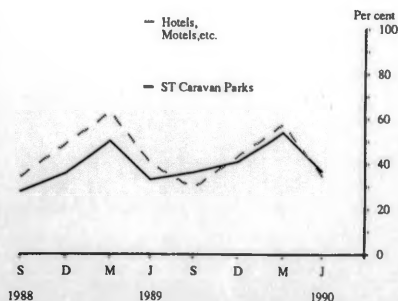

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains results, for Victoria, of the quarterly survey of tourist accommodation establishments.

Scope and coverage

2. A tourist accommodation establishment is defined, for the purpose of the survey, as an establishment which predominantly provides short-term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) available to the general public. The definition includes all caravan parks (whether predominantly providing short-term or long-term accommodation).

3. Tourist accommodation establishments currently included in the survey are:

Licensed hotel with facilities. An accommodation establishment which is licensed to operate a public bar, provides a bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms, and has breakfast available for guests;

Motel, licensed or unlicensed, private hotel or guest house with facilities. An accommodation establishment which provides a bath or shower and toilet in most guest rooms and has breakfast available for guests. This category also includes motels that are licensed to serve liquor with or without meals, following proclamation of the Liquor Control Act 1987 on 3 May 1988.

Caravan park. An accommodation establishment which provides powered sites for caravans, and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests. A *short-term caravan park* is one which is predominantly occupied by short-term guests (i.e. guests staying for less than 2 months). A *long-term caravan park* is one predominantly occupied by long-term guests (i.e. guests staying for 2 months or more) and

Holiday flats, units and houses (excluding establishments predominantly operated on a time-share basis). Accommodation establishments which are operated by owners or managers who have sole letting rights to at least 5 flats, units or houses, or by real estate agents for short-term letting, are mainly self-contained in terms of cooking, bath (or shower) and toilet facilities but does not have breakfast available for guests.

Note that data collected and published for each type of establishment include both long-term and short-term guests at these establishments.

4. Because of the limitations of the information available for updating lists of tourist accommodation establishments, some delay may occur between the opening of an establishment and its inclusion in the survey. The effect of these delays on published occupancy rates is generally considered to be insignificant.

Definitions

5. *Number of establishments* refers to the number of tourist accommodation establishments within the scope of the survey which operated during the survey period. Included are those establishments which operated for any part of the quarter or which closed temporarily for the quarter because of seasonal reasons. Establishments comprising more than one type of accommodation activity referred to in paragraph 3 above (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two separate establishments.

6. *Number of letting entities* refers to the number of owners, managers or real estate agents of holiday flats, units and houses within the scope of the survey who operated during the survey period.

7. *Guest rooms* refers to the maximum number of rooms, units, suites, etc., available for accommodating paying guests at hotels and motels with facilities during the survey period.

8. *Bed spaces* refers to the maximum number of bed spaces (excluding cots) available to accommodate paying guests at hotels and motels with facilities during the survey period. Three-quarter beds are classified as single beds; double beds are counted as two bed spaces.

9. *Guest arrivals* refers to the total number of paying guests counted on the first night they stayed at the accommodation establishment during the survey period.

10. *Room nights* refers to the total number of nights each guest room is occupied by a paying guest during the survey period.

11. *Guest nights* refers to the total number of nights each paying guest stayed during the survey period.

12. *Room occupancy rate* refers to the proportion of guest rooms occupied expressed as a percentage of the number of guest rooms available during the survey period.

13. *Bed occupancy rate* refers to the proportion of bed spaces occupied expressed as a percentage of the number of bed spaces available during the survey period.

14. *Average length of stay* refers to the number of guest nights divided by the number of guest arrivals.
15. *Units* refers to the maximum number of holiday flats, units and houses available for short-term accommodation.
16. *Unit nights* refers to the total number of nights each holiday flat, unit or house is occupied during the survey period.
17. *Unit occupancy rate* refers to the proportion of units occupied expressed as a percentage of the total units available during the survey period.
18. *Unit lettings* refers to the total number of times a holiday flat, unit or house was occupied by a new tenant, counted only on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant.
19. *Powered sites* refers to the maximum number of sites with provision for connection to electric power supply which are available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period. Included are powered sites occupied by on-site vans.
20. *Unpowered sites* refers to the maximum number of sites with no provision for connection to electric power supply which are available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.
21. *Cabins, flats, etc.*, refers to the maximum number of cabins, flats, units and villas which are available at caravan parks for accommodating paying guests during the survey period.
22. *Site nights* refers to the total number of nights each powered/unpowered site, cabin, flat, etc., is occupied during the survey period.
23. *Sites occupied by long-term guests* refers to the total number of sites occupied by long-term guests (i.e. guests who have stayed continuously for 2 months or more) at the end of the survey period.
24. *Site occupancy rate* refers to the proportion of site nights expressed as a percentage of the total caravan park capacity available during the survey period. From the September quarter 1988, the treatment of sites permanently reserved for privately owned vans has changed. Previously, usage of these sites was recorded only when they were occupied. As these sites are not available to either the public or caravan park operators for accommodation, they are recorded as permanently occupied. Care should be taken when comparing site occupancy rates from the September quarter 1988 with previous quarters.
25. *Takings from accommodation* refers to revenue received from the provision of short-term and long-term accommodation at tourist accommodation establishments. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after, the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.
26. *Star grading* refers to the grading of hotels and motels with facilities and is based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the AAA publication *Australian National Tourguide*, or the individual tour guides produced by members of the AAA.
- For the purposes of classifying establishments to a star grading in this publication, 'half' gradings are ignored (e.g. a two and half star grading has been shown as two).
- Ungraded.* The "ungraded" category includes establishments that have not yet been graded by the AAA, and those that do not meet the minimum standard required to receive a star grading.
27. *Employment.* Details of the numbers of persons working at tourist accommodation establishments (including those working on other than accommodation activities) have not been included in this publication. However, data are available upon request from the ABS.
- Australian Standard Geographical Classification**
28. This publication contains establishments classified and data presented according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) edition 8. The following variations from the standard format of the detailed main structure of ASGC are used:
- (a) Statistical local areas, statistical subdivisions and statistical divisions are not shown in tables for which they have only minimal or no contributory statistics or where the data are confidential; and
 - (b) Off-shore and migratory areas are excluded.

Statistical Local Areas (SLAs)

29. These spatial units are the smallest type in the ASGC for which tourist accommodation data are presented. These geographic areas are in most cases either identical to, or have been aggregated to, the previously published whole legal Local Government Areas (legal LGAs). In other cases they are identical to each unincorporated area. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State of Victoria without gaps or overlaps. There are instances where legal LGAs in Victoria overlap statistical division or sub-division boundaries. These legal LGAs are then split into two SLAs - Part A and Part B.

Statistical Divisions (SDs)

30. These consist of one or more statistical subdivisions. These divisions are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.

Victoria has been divided into 12 statistical divisions since 1974. These statistical divisions correspond with regions adopted by the Victorian Government in October 1981 except in the case of the Metropolitan region and because of consequential effects, the Central Highlands and Loddon-Campaspe regions. The Victorian Government's Metropolitan region comprises the Melbourne and East Central Statistical Divisions, and the Shires of Bacchus Marsh and Gisborne.

Related publications

31. Publications for Australia, and each State and Territory, are released by the respective Offices of the ABS. Past quarters' tourist accommodation statistics are available in earlier publications commencing with the September quarter 1975.

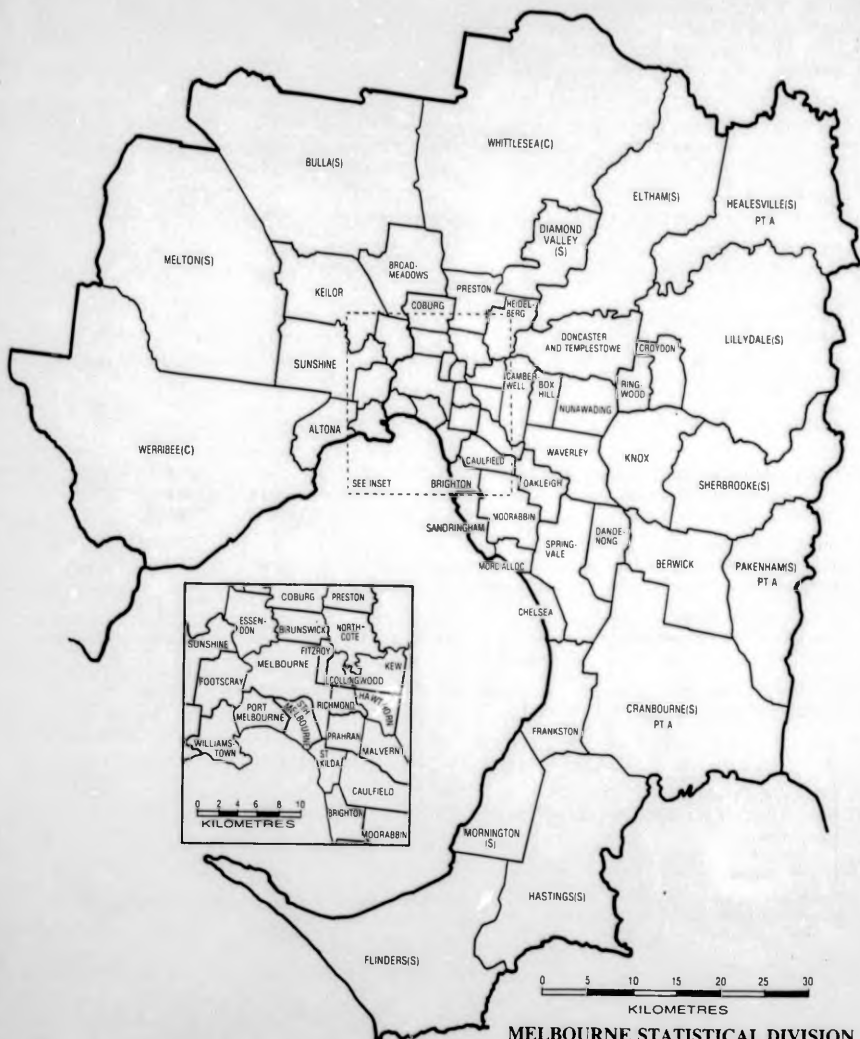

ABS TOURISM STATISTICS

Data on the "tourist industry" is provided by the ABS from a number of different sources and collections. Some of the sources may be termed as "tourism specific", in that the collection is designed specifically to provide data on one or more aspects of the tourist industry. Other sources are "tourism related" and provide information on a number of industries (including tourism).

TOURISM SPECIFIC COLLECTIONS

1. Domestic Travel and Tourism Survey (Cat.No. 9216.0)

This survey was last conducted in 1983. It provides data on domestic travel and geographic characteristics of people identified as travellers. The data is available at the national, state and regional levels.

2. Service Industries Survey

The 1986-87 survey covered businesses in tourism and related tourism services.

3. Overseas Arrivals and Departures

(Cat.No's. 3401.0, 3402.0, and 3404.0)

The data is available on a monthly, quarterly and annual basis. In addition to the number of overseas arrivals and departures, data is also available on type of traveller, country of embarkation, intended length of stay and Australian state of stay.

TOURISM RELATED COLLECTIONS

1. Household Expenditure Survey (Cat.No. 6553.0)

This survey includes state level expenditure by Australians on overseas holidays and Australian holidays. At the national level expenditure information can be provided on fares and accommodation.

2. Building Approvals (Cat.No. 8731.2)

Information available includes number of approvals by type of building (eg. hotels, shops, factories, entertainment and recreational) and \$ value (in value groupings).

3. State and Local Government Finance

The ABS collects very detailed information on State and local government expenditure. This source provides an insight into expenditure on the following areas of interest:

Tourism and area promotion
Creative and performing arts

National Parks and Wildlife
Recreational facilities and services

4. Consumer Price Index (Cat.No. 6401.0)

The CPI includes information on price movement by state for such items as holiday travel, accommodation and transportation.

5. Retail Trade (Cat.No. 8501.0)

This publication provides monthly \$ turnover data for retail industries and a number of selected services included in the "Hospitality Sector"; ie hotels & licensed clubs and cafes & restaurants.
