PRODUCTION SUMMARY NO. 2 : CHEMICALS, ETC. DECEMBER 1972



Annual figures are derived from the recorded monthly production and are subject to seasonal adjustment, account has been taken not only of normal seasonal factors but also of "trading-day" effects (arising from the varying numbers of Sundays, Mondays, Tuesdays etc. in the month) and the influence of Easter and Australia Day which may, in successive years, affect figures for different months. Details of the methods used in seasonally adjusting this and other series are given in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators 1972* (Ref. No. 1.10).
