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CENSUS OF THE COMMONWEALTH, 30TH JUNE, 1954.

No. 36 : MATERIAL OF OUTER WALLS OF OCCUPIED PRIVATE DWELLINGS : AUSTRALIA.

This statement shows the numbers of occupied private houses, shares of private houses, flats, other private dwellings and total private dwellings in each State and Territory of Australia, according to material of outer walls, at the Census of 30th June, 1954.

Summaries No. 31, Classes of Occupied Dwellings, and No. 33, Nature of Occupancy of Occupied Private Dwellings, have already been issued, and similar statements for other characteristics of dwellings of the population (i.e. rooms, inmates, etc.) will be issued as the information becomes available.

For the purpose of the Census, a "dwelling" is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only part of a building. "Private House" includes sheds, huts, garages, etc. used for dwelling purposes. "Share of Private House" is a portion of a shared private house which is occupied separately and for which portion a separate Householder's Schedule was furnished. A "flat" is part of a house or other building which can be completely closed off and which includes both cooking and bathing facilities. "Other" private dwelling is an apartment, room(s), etc., which is part of a building, but is not a self-contained unit.

All figures shown herein are exclusive of dwellings occupied solely by full-blood aboriginals.

Compared with the numbers at the 1947 Census occupied private dwellings built of wood increased by 17.53 per cent.; brick by 20.85 per cent.; fibro-cement by 150.10 per cent.; concrete by 76.53 per cent. Stone, iron, and calico, canvas and hessian decreased by 0.16, 11.70 and 50.10 per cent. respectively.

At the 1954 Census wooden dwellings comprised 44.37 per cent. of the total occupied private dwellings, brick, 33.52 per cent., fibro-cement, 12.65 per cent., and stone, 3.74 per cent. Corresponding proportions for 1947 were: wooden, 47.22 per cent., brick, 34.69 per cent., fibro-cement, 6.28 per cent., and stone, 4.68 per cent.
