FIELD COUNT STATEMENT NO. 1. - POPULATION : AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY

This statement contains preliminary results of the Census of 30th June, 1966. It shows details of the population of the Australian Capital Territory and the City of Canberra.

The figures for 1966 have been compiled during the taking of the Census by census field personnel, and as such are subject to amendment on completion of processing and subsequent tabulation. However, extensive changes to the details in this statement are not expected.

NOTE. - Statistics of the City of Canberra and its Divisions (Suburbs) for periods prior to 1966 relate to boundaries existing in June 1965. Divisional boundary changes which have been made since June 1965 are an extension of the northern boundary of the Division of Watson and the transfer of the area of Acton south of Lake Burley Griffin to the Division of Yarralumla. Additionally the City of Canberra has been extended to include part of the A.C.T. rural District of Woden to form the new Divisions of Isaacs, Mawson, O'Malley, Phillip and Torrens.

Diplomatic personnel of oversea countries and their families are not included. The number of persons involved is approximately 1,200.

Field Count Statement No. 2, issued simultaneously with this Statement contains details of the population of the Australian external Territories of Nauru, Norfolk Island, Christmas Island and Cocos (Keeling) Islands. It is expected that preliminary statistics of the population of each State and internal Territory of Australia will be issued in September, 1966.
