NOTE: The last full issue of this Bulletin (Vol. 15, No. 9) giving detailed statistics for the year ended June, 1952 was released on 8th November, 1952.

The estimated production of whole milk in Australia during the month of September, 1952 was 113.4 million gallons, compared with 95.2 million gallons in September, 1951 and 109.1 million gallons in September, 1950. Production for the three months ended September, 1952 totalled 265.6 million gallons compared with 235.8 million gallons for the same period in 1951. It was the highest recorded for these three months in any year since the war. Substantial increases of 16.3 million gallons and 23.2 million gallons occurred in New South Wales and Queensland respectively during this period compared with the three months ended September, 1951. During the same period production in Victoria fell by 0.7 million gallons. Relatively small movements only were recorded in the other States.

The production of factory butter in September, 1952 at 15,129 tons was greater than the output recorded in September, 1951, 11,541 tons. Cheese production in factories was 5,267 tons in September, 1952 compared with 4,653 tons during the corresponding month of 1951 while output of condensed, powdered, etc. milk products (expressed in terms of whole milk equivalent) amounted to 8.6 million gallons in September, 1952 compared with 7.8 million gallons in September, 1951.

Further particulars relating to the production and utilization of whole milk and the production of butter, cheese and condensed, powdered, etc. milk products are given in the following tables, and graphs illustrating trends are also attached.

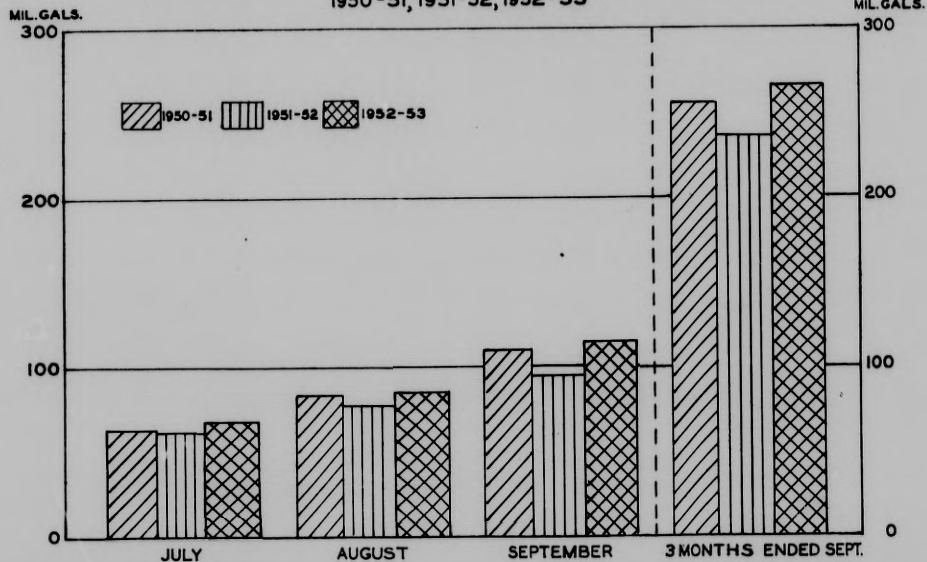
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PRODUCTION OF WHOLE MILK FOR ALL PURPOSES AUSTRALIA
