NOTE: Export statistics relate to the month in which export entries are lodged with Customs. They do not necessarily represent commodities actually exported during the month. See paragraphs 7 and 8 below.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication, which replaces Catalogue Nos. 5409.0 (exports part only) and 5411.0, contains annual statistics of Australia's exports classified by the items of the Australian Export Commodity Classification (AECC) (Cat 1203.0) and by country of final destination.

Source of data

2. These statistics are compiled by the Australian Bureau of Statistics from documentation submitted by exporters or their agents to the Australian Customs Service as required by the Customs Act.

Statistical concepts

3. The statistics of exports presented in this publication are recorded on a general trade basis: i.e. total exports include both Australian produce and re-exports. Although items of non-merchandise trade are recorded, they are excluded from exports (see paragraphs 11 to 13).

4. Australian produce is defined as goods, materials or articles, which have been produced, manufactured or partly manufactured in Australia, except goods which were originally imported and have undergone repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

5. Re-exports are defined as goods, materials or articles originally imported which are exported in the same condition in which they were imported or after undergoing repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged. Minor operations include blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting, husking and shelling.

6. The following are excluded from recorded export statistics:

- (a) direct transit trade, i.e. goods being trans-shipped or moved through Australia for purposes of transport only;
- (b) migrants' and passengers' effects exported and parcel post exports of small value, for which Customs entries are not required;

(c) certain materials under inter-governmental agreements for defence and similar projects for which Customs entries are not required;

(d) ships and aircraft engaged in the transport of passengers or goods between Australia and other countries;

(e) the sale of any ship and/or aircraft intended for use on overseas routes;

(f) fish and other sea products landed abroad directly from the high seas by Australian ships;

(g) export consignments where the value of the goods in each transaction is less than \$250.

Statistical period

7. Exports are recorded statistically in the month in which the export entries are lodged with the Australian Customs Service. Regular exporters or their agents may provide details of their export shipments on a periodic rather than an individual shipment basis by submitting weekly or monthly returns. These "periodic returns" must be submitted to the Australian Customs Service within seven days of the end of the period in question covering all shipments during that period. All other exporters are required to report each individual shipment prior to the ship's departure. Approximately 90 percent of monthly export values are recorded on periodic returns. The statistical month for Customs outputs (generally ports other than those at which the main Customs office in each state is located) closes on the 21st of each month, whereas for mainports the statistical month is the calendar month.

8. Because of the way in which exports data are collected and processed approximately 40% of total export trade by value shown for a particular month reflects actual shipments in that month, while approximately 55% reflects actual shipments during the previous month with the remaining 5% by value exported in earlier months. For individual commodities these percentages may vary considerably.

Valuation

9. Goods actually sold to overseas buyers prior to shipment are valued at the free-on-board (f.o.b.) Australian

port of shipment equivalent of the actual price at which the goods were sold. Goods shipped on consignment are valued at the f.o.b. Australian port of shipment equivalent of the current price offering for similar goods of Australian origin in the principal markets of the country to which the goods are dispatched for sale.

10. The recorded value of exports includes the value of the outside package, other than international containers used for containerised cargo.

Exports and non-merchandise trade

11. From July 1985, non-merchandise trade is excluded from export (and import) statistics. This is in accord with UN recommendations and practices adopted by Australia's major trading partners. Statistics prior to July 1985 included in this publication have been adjusted to be comparable with data from July 1985 onwards and, consequently, will not be directly comparable with previous publications.

12. Merchandise exports are defined as all goods which subtract from the stock of material resources in Australia as a result of their movement out of the country.

13. Non-merchandise exports consist primarily of re-exports of goods which were originally imported on a temporary basis or for repair, alteration or renovation. A complete list of commodities comprising non-merchandise trade is shown under Section 9(b) of the AECC.

Commodity classification

14. Exports are classified according to the items of the AECC which, from 1 July 1978, has been based on the Standard International Trade Classification, Revision 2 (SITC Rev 2) (United Nations Statistical Papers, Series M, No. 34, Revision 2, 1975).

15. A detailed description of the commodity items included in this publication is contained in the AECC. Copies of, or extracts from, this classification may be obtained from offices of the ABS in Canberra and in each capital city. A list of abbreviations used throughout this publication is included in Appendix B.

16. An index of export commodities listed in alphabetical order showing commodity classification reference numbers appears in Appendix D of this publication.

Country

17. For the purposes of foreign trade statistics, a country is defined as a geographical entity which trades, or has the potential to trade, with Australia in accordance with Australian Customs provisions. External territories under Australian administration are treated separately whilst self-governing territories and dependent territories under the administration of other countries may be treated as individual countries in Australian foreign trade statistics. A list of countries is shown in Appendix A.

18. For exports, country refers to the country to which the goods were consigned at the time of export. Where the country of consignment is not determined at the time of export, goods are recorded as exported "For Orders" and in those cases where it was found to be impossible to determine the destination, as "Destination Unknown".

Presentation of data

19. In presenting tabular information in this publication, the following rules have been applied:

- (a) statistical item and a description of the goods are shown only where trade was actually recorded under that item;
- (b) quantity (where applicable) and value are shown only where the value is \$1,000 or more before rounding;
- (c) individual country details for a particular commodity are shown only if that country has a value \$10,000 or more;
- (d) where an item description was valid for only a six month period operative dates appear at the end of the description e.g. "to 311283" indicates the item ceased at that date and "fm 010184" indicates the commencement of that item.

Gross weight

20. Gross weight is recorded on export entries in kilograms. A weight is shown for each commodity that is separately identified and it includes the weight of moisture content, wrappings,

crates, boxes and outside packages (other than international containers used for containerised cargo). Gross weight statistics appear in this publication in Table 4 and also in Shipping and Air Cargo Commodity Statistics (SACCS) (9206.0), published quarterly.

Quantity data

21. Quantities shown are generally expressed in terms of the normal unit of quantity used in the appropriate industry and as specified in the AECC. When the unit of quantity is a weight measurement net weight is recorded. Quantities are not tabulated in respect of statistical items for which there is no appropriate unit of quantity (e.g. a statistical item which covers a number of commodities that cannot be recorded under a single unit of quantity).

Treatment of confidential data

22. To ensure that information about the activities of particular businesses is not disclosed, it is necessary to restrict the release of statistics of certain commodities. These restrictions do not affect total export figures but they can affect statistics at all levels of the AECC.

23. Reference to table footnotes and Appendix C should assist in the interpretation of these differences. Further information regarding the treatment of confidential data is contained in the ABS information paper Confidentiality and the Release of Foreign Trade and Shipping Statistics (5486.0).

OTHER INFORMATION AVAILABLE

24. Special returns service: Subscribers to this service can receive foreign trade statistics at a particular commodity level on computer produced printout or via the electronic mail service TELESTATS. These statistics are available in one or more of a limited number of formats, for a charge consistent with the level of detail required. This service is recommended where up to fifty specific commodity items are required on a regular basis. More details concerning the special returns service are contained in the information paper Foreign Trade Statistics: Special Returns Service (5480.0).

25. Microfiche service: Foreign trade statistics are also available on microfiche in a variety of tabular formats. Each tabular format covers all commodities exported or imported at

various levels of aggregation. This service is recommended where the subscriber wishes to obtain foreign trade details for a large number of commodities. Details of this service are contained in the ABS information paper Foreign Trade and Shipping Statistics: Microfiche Service (5483.0).

26. Magnetic tape service: Statistics for imports, exports and import clearances are available on 9-track magnetic tape approximately 4 weeks after the end of the reference period. This service is recommended where the subscriber wishes to obtain trade data at the most detailed level. Documentation regarding the content and structure of these tapes is contained in the ABS information paper, Foreign Trade and Shipping Statistics: Magnetic Tape Service (5484.0).

27. To meet subscribers' needs special returns, microfiche and data on magnetic tape are available on a monthly, quarterly or less frequent basis. Payment in advance is required for each of these services.

In Table 5, all commodities subject to any level of confidentiality restriction will be EXCLUDED from their usual item and shown under the confidential item code 989.99.99 for each country.
