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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains detailed results compiled from the ABS quarterly building activity survey for the June quarter 1983. Data shown for the September quarter 1981 onwards have been processed using new procedures (see paragraphs 11-17 below). Summary results from June quarter 1983 are published in *Building Activity, Australia (Preliminary)* (8704.0).

2. From the September quarter 1980 a new Building Activity Survey replaced the previous quarterly Building Operations Census. The major features of the new survey were as follows:

- (a) replacement, by a sample survey, of the previous complete enumeration of private sector jobs involving new house construction or alterations and additions valued at \$10,000 or more to houses;
- (b) continuation of the complete quarterly enumeration of jobs involving construction of new dwellings other than private sector houses, construction of new other buildings with an approval value of \$10,000 or more and all alterations and additions with an approval value of \$10,000 or more to buildings other than private sector houses.

3. From the September quarter 1981 two additional changes have been introduced:

- (a) a one-month-lagged framework of approvals is now used as the basis for selection of both house and non-house building jobs (previously only private sector house jobs were selected from a one-month-lagged approvals framework); and
- (b) in general, a building job is now considered to have commenced, for the purposes of the statistical collection, ONLY when the value of work done on that job as reported by the builder is equal to or greater than a pre-determined (threshold) value.

Paragraphs 11 to 17 contain further details of these two additional changes.

4. The major implication of the introduction of the Building Activity Survey has been that the survey provides information on private sector house building activity (including alterations and additions) only at the Australian and State/Territory levels of detail. Finer levels of geographic disaggregation are not available, and it is not possible to classify these data in the same detail as in the past (e.g. materials of construction, average floor area and average value per square metre). This is because of the sampling variability associated with such estimates. To compensate for this loss of detail, output from the Building Approvals monthly collection has been extended, and a monthly series for new dwellings commenced

(based on first inspections of building jobs by local government and other responsible authorities) has been introduced to provide information on a small area basis. No changes have been made in the Building Activity Survey to the data available for building jobs other than private sector house construction.

Scope and coverage

5. The statistics relate to *building structures* and exclude railways, roads, bridges, earth-fill dams and all other non-building construction. Renovations, repairs and maintenance are also excluded. Site preparation works which comprise part of the overall building construction are, however, included in the statistics. Site preparation costs were included in the superseded Building Operations Census only if they could not be separately identified.

6. The major component of the framework for the survey is building approvals. These approvals, and the approvals statistics compiled therefrom, cover:

- (a) permits issued by local government authorities in areas subject to building control by those authorities; and
- (b) contracts let or day labour work approved by Commonwealth, State, semi-government and local government authorities.

In addition, major building activity which takes place in areas not subject to the normal administrative approval processes (e.g. mining leases) is also included.

7. Statistics of building activity are compiled on the basis of returns collected from:

- (a) builders involved in contract or speculative building activity, including alterations and additions work;
- (b) individuals and businesses involved in building activity on their own account; and
- (c) Commonwealth, State, semi-government and local government authorities involved in building activity.

Comparability with previous series

Changes introduced from September quarter 1980

8. Differences in concept between the Building Activity Survey introduced from the September quarter 1980 and the previous Building Operations Census were minor. With the sample survey of private sector house building activity, however, any houses built outside local government authority building control areas (see paragraph 6) could not, except in the circumstances mentioned at the end of paragraph 6, become part of the sample survey framework and, therefore, could not contribute to the results of the Building Activity Survey. The only difference with respect to data about public sector house building activity and data about other dwellings and other buildings related to the treatment of site preparation costs (see paragraph 5 above).

9. More important were the changes in the procedures associated with a more rigorous control of the collection framework which enabled individual building jobs to be more closely monitored through the construction process. This resulted in some increase in the proportion of the actual building activity occurring in a given quarter being included in the statistics for that quarter. This more rigorous control also identified the need to revise the number and value of building jobs previously regarded as under construction as at 1 July 1980. For this reason figures from the September quarter 1980 are not strictly comparable with those for earlier periods and some caution should be exercised in comparing data across the time of the change in methodology. The approvals series (which has not been subject to a break in continuity) may, to some extent, be of assistance in making time series comparisons across mid-1980 for building activity.

10. From the September quarter 1980 to the September quarter 1981 the collection methodology provided for the automatic revision, at the unit record level, of data relating to building activity in a given quarter on the basis of data supplied in the following quarter. However, the extent of these revisions had a more significant impact on the quarterly results, particularly with regard to numbers of dwellings commenced, than had been anticipated.

Changes introduced from September quarter 1981

11. Users of building activity statistics will be aware of the significant revisions which have been occurring in the quarterly series. The Appendix to the June quarter 1981 issue of this publication (8705.0) discusses the reasons for these revisions and the new procedures which were to be adopted by the ABS to minimise the incidence of those revisions. The new procedures have now been introduced and are explained in detail in the following paragraphs. (It should be noted that the procedures in fact implemented differ in some respects from those envisaged in the Appendix referred to above.)

12. As mentioned in paragraph 3, a one-month-lagged approvals framework is now used as the basis for the selection of all building jobs to be included in the quarterly activity survey. Previously only private sector house jobs were subject to a lagged framework. This approach therefore defines the frameworks for the selection of approved jobs for both the sampled and fully enumerated components of the quarterly Building Activity Survey on the same basis. It introduces a lag to statistics for non-house jobs the same as the lag for house building jobs by defining the framework for any given quarter as including all jobs notified as approved up to, but not including, the last month of the reference quarter (i.e. up to the end of August in respect of the September quarter collection). This means, for example, that all jobs which were notified as approved in September 1981 and which actually commenced in that month have, under this approach, been included as commencements in the December quarter 1981 and those notified as approved in December 1981 and which actually commenced in that month have been included as commencements in the March quarter 1982.

13. Adoption of this approach eliminates, as a source of revisions, the situation where new builders undertaking non-house jobs, and who were included in the current quarter's collection (because an approval notification for the job formed part of the current quarter framework) indicated that the job had, in fact, commenced in the previous (or earlier) quarter. Such jobs could not have been included in the previous quarter's statistics if the building activity was being undertaken by builders who had no jobs in the previous quarter's framework and therefore would not have received a questionnaire in that quarter.

14. Adoption of the one-month-lagged framework of approvals also eliminates a significant number of the revisions occurring as a consequence of a proportion of builders not advising details, on the collection form, of some building jobs which were commenced in the reference quarter but had not been included in the collection framework for that quarter (because notification of a building approval had not been received by the ABS).

15. The new procedures will not result in precise measurement of building activity in each reference quarter to the extent that the contribution of both house and non-house jobs notified as approved and on which activity commenced in the last month of each reference quarter will, by definition, be included in the following quarter. The impact of the lagged framework on variables such as work done during the quarter and work yet to be done at the end of the quarter will, for all types of building, be very small.

16. The other processing change introduced from the September quarter 1981 effectively revises the conditions which must be satisfied before a building job is considered by the ABS to have commenced for statistical purposes. Recent investigations undertaken by the ABS have established that in a proportion of cases, the value of work reported as having been done on building jobs was so small as to suggest that the expenditure incurred only represented some administrative expense, or minor materials purchases, in preparation for commencement of work on the building site. Under the revised procedures a building job will only be regarded as having commenced in any given quarter if the value of work done to the end of that quarter is equal to or greater than the following threshold values:

- (a) for house jobs (including alterations and additions to houses), \$2,000
- (b) for other dwelling and other building jobs (including alterations and additions to other dwellings and other buildings), \$5,000

and will be indexed over time to take account of price changes.

17. Notwithstanding the commencement value thresholds, where advice has been received from the relevant authorities that a first inspection has been made on a particular building job, that job will be regarded by the ABS as having commenced even though the value of

work reported by the builder as having been done to the end of the quarter is below the threshold value. Waiving of the threshold in this way has been introduced to recognise as genuine commencements those building jobs which both the builder and the relevant (government) authority report as having commenced during a particular reference period.

Reliability of the estimates

18. Since some of the estimates in this publication are based on information obtained about a sample of approved building jobs they are subject to sampling error; that is, they may differ from the figures that would have been obtained if information for all approved jobs for the relevant period had been included in the survey. A measure of the likely difference is given by the standard error of each. There are about two chances in three that a sample estimate will differ by less than one standard error from the figure that would have been obtained if all approved jobs had been included, and about nineteen chances in twenty that the difference will be less than two standard errors. The standard errors can be expressed as percentages of the estimates, and these are shown in Tables 18 and 19.

19. An example of the use of standard errors is as follows. From Table 2 it can be seen that the estimate of the number of new private sector houses commenced during the quarter ended 30 June 1983 is 19,840. The associated relative standard error is 1.5 per cent (see Table 18). Therefore, there are about two chances in three that the value which would have been obtained if information had been obtained about all approved private house jobs would have been within the range 19,540 to 20,140 and about nineteen chances in twenty that the value would have been within the range 19,240 to 20,440.

20. The imprecision due to sampling variability, which is measured by the standard error, should not be confused with inaccuracies that may occur because of inadequacies in the source of building approval information, imperfections in reporting by respondents, and errors made in the coding and processing of data. Inaccuracies of this kind are referred to as non-sampling error, and may occur in any enumeration whether it be a full count or only a sample. Every effort is made to reduce the non-sampling error to a minimum by the careful design of questionnaires, efforts to obtain responses for all selected jobs, and efficient operating procedures.

Seasonal adjustment

21. Seasonally adjusted building statistics are shown in Table 4. In the seasonally adjusted series, account has been taken of normal seasonal factors and 'trading day' effects (arising from the varying numbers of Sundays, Mondays, Tuesdays etc., in the quarter) and the effect of movement in the date of Easter which may, in successive years, affect figures for different quarters. In this publication the seasonally adjusted approvals series have been revised. The revision is the result of the 1982-83 annual re-analysis, details of which, together with information regarding the methods used in seasonally adjusting these statistics, are given in *Seasonally Adjusted Indicators, Australia* (1308.0).

22. Since seasonally adjusted statistics reflect both irregular and trend movements, an upward or downward movement in a seasonally adjusted series does not necessarily indicate a change of trend. Particular care should therefore be taken in interpreting individual quarter to quarter movements. Each of the component series shown has been seasonally adjusted independently. As a consequence, while the unadjusted components in the original series shown add to the totals, the adjusted components may not add to the adjusted totals.

Definitions

23. Important definitions are as follows:

- (a) *Commenced*—A building job is regarded as having commenced in a particular quarter when the reported value of work done on that job to the end of the quarter is equal to or greater than the following threshold values:
 - (i) for house jobs (including alterations and additions to houses), \$2,000
 - (ii) for other dwelling and other building jobs (including alterations and additions to other dwellings and other buildings), \$5,000

However, where advice has been received from the relevant authority that a first inspection has been made on a particular building job, that job is regarded as having commenced, even though the value of work reported by the builder as having been done to the end of the quarter is below the threshold.

- (b) *Completed*—A building is regarded as having been completed when it is reported as such or has been substantially completed and occupied.
- (c) *Under construction*—A building is regarded as being under construction at the end of a period if it has been commenced but has not been completed, and work on it has not been abandoned.
- (d) *Contractor-built houses*—Those erected under contract, or in anticipation of sale or rental.
- (e) *Houses built by other than contract builders*—Those erected by an owner (other than a recognised building contractor) or under his direction, without the services of a single contractor responsible for the whole job. Houses built by businesses (other than recognised building contractors) are also included in this category.
- (f) *Value of building approved, commenced, or under construction* represents the estimated value of the whole job when completed, excluding the value of the land (and landscaping) on which the job has been carried out. Site preparation costs are included.

- (g) *Value of building completed* represents the actual value of the whole job when completed, including any site preparation costs but excluding the value of land and landscaping.
- (h) *Value of building work done* represents the estimated value of the building work actually carried out during the period on jobs which have been regarded as commenced.
- (i) *Value of building work yet to be done* represents the estimated value of work remaining to be done on building jobs under construction at the end of the period.

Building classification

24. *Private Sector and Public Sector*—A building is classified as 'Private Sector' or 'Public Sector' according to ownership at date of approval.

25. A building is classified according to the function it is intended to serve. A building which is ancillary to other buildings or forms part of a group of related buildings is classified according to the function of the group as a whole.

26. A *Dwelling* is classified as either a 'House' or an 'Other dwelling'.

- (a) A 'House' is a building which has been designed or adapted so that its prime purpose is to be a single self-contained dwelling unit (i.e. includes bathing and cooking facilities), which is completely detached from other buildings, and occupies (except in such cases as dwellings built for employees or families of the owner or lessee of the land) a separate titled block of land.
- (b) An 'Other dwelling' is a self-contained dwelling unit other than a house. These include flats, home units, semi-detached dwellings, villa units, town houses, etc.

Non-self-contained dwelling units such as might be found in motels, hostels, and institutions, are not included as dwellings and the value of this building is included in the appropriate category of other building. Temporary or makeshift dwellings are excluded from building statistics.

27. Examples of the types of individual building jobs included under each main functional heading are shown in the following list:

- (a) *Hotels, etc.*—Includes motels, hostels, boarding houses and guest houses.
- (b) *Shops*—Includes cafes, restaurants, retail markets and showrooms. Shops classified as public sector include government owned shop buildings for leasing.
- (c) *Factories*—Includes abattoirs, brickworks, printing offices and government workshops.

(d) *Offices*—Includes banks, post offices and council chambers.

(e) *Other business premises*—Includes service stations, bus depots, wholesale stores, telephone exchanges, television stations and studios, and warehouses.

(f) *Education*—Includes schools, colleges, kindergartens, reference libraries and universities.

(g) *Religion*—Includes churches, church halls, convents, seminaries and theological colleges.

(h) *Health*—Includes ambulance stations, baby health clinics, convalescent homes, hospitals, nurses' quarters and sanatoria.

(i) *Entertainment and recreation*—Includes clubs, gymnasiums, public halls, squash courts and theatres.

(j) *Miscellaneous*—Includes homes for the aged, law courts, defence buildings, museums, police stations and children's homes.
